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Super simple paper piecing makes this wonky, wacky, wonderful quilt fun to make. Make all the blocks and then have fun laying them out just as you want. The picture on the front is just a suggestion! You should have some knowledge of how to paper piece in order to make this quilt or use the alternative method.

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#### Making the Block (Paper Piecing)—

- Make 63 copies of the foundation pattern.
- Sew the blocks, adding the fabrics as numbered on the block.
- Make 10 Blocks each of the pink and blue florals.
- Make 4 Blocks each of the grey and black dots.
- Make 5 Blocks each of all the other colors.
- Rotating each block so they get Wonky, lay out the blocks as shown in the picture, or choose your own layout.
- Sew the rows together.
- Measure the center of the quilt through the center from side to side and top to bottom.
- Trim the side borders to fit and attach to the quilt.
- Trim the top and bottom borders to fit and attach to the quilt.
- Make a sandwich of the top, batting, and binding.
- Quilt as desired.
- Enjoy!!


#### Making the Block (Alternative Method)—

- Make a template of plastic from the foundation pattern.
- Carefully mark the center portion of the block on the template.
- Sew the blocks by sewing the rectangles you have cut from the colored fabrics.
- Make 10 Blocks each of the pink and blue florals.
- Make 4 Blocks each of the grey and black dots.
- Make 5 Blocks each of all the other colors.
- After sewing the block centers, trim to 6" square.
- Sew the grey rectangles around the edges.
- Using the template, trim the blocks. Be sure to get the centers lined up before trimming or the "wonkys" won't match!
- Rotating each block so they get Wonky, lay out the blocks as shown in the picture, or choose your own layout.
- Sew the rows together.
- Measure the center of the quilt through the center from side to side and top to bottom.
- Trim the side borders to fit and attach to the quilt.
- Trim the top and bottom borders to fit and attach to the quilt.
- Make a sandwich of the top, batting, and binding.
- Quilt as desired.
- Enjoy!!





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## Make 63 copies.

The cut size of the block should be 7" to finish 6 1/2". Check the first copy to see that the size is correct before making all the copies!
