## 3-Step Quilt

Cutting Notes: Mark and store your cutting pieces, as this will make matching fabrics easier when piecing begins. Be sure to read the entire pattern before you begin. Please refer to Cutting Diagram on Page 2 first, before making any cuts.

## Piecing Instructions

1. Row 1: Lay out (7) $5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles as shown in Quilt Assembly Diagram on Page 3. Sew rectangles short end to short end to create Row 1. Press all seams in the same direction.
2. Following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, repeat Step 1 to create Rows 2 - 15. Press seams in opposite directions in each row to make sewing rows together easier.
3. Sew Rows 1-15 together to complete quilt. You'll want to quilt it using your most preferred and enjoyable method! I quilted a $1 / 4$ " to the left and right of every seam, making a super simple grid - in my opinion it lets the flanel be the rockstar! Quilt should measure $631 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 751 / 2$ " unfinished.

Pro Tip: Put that walking foot on and increase your stitch length to 3.5 or 4 when quilting these thick layers. Your stitches will be b-ea-utiful!

Now, make your quilt sandwich with batting, bind this baby, and get it on your bed for ultimate snuggling possibilities!
