




### **STAR POINT UNITS**

**1. Diamonds:** Using an acrylic ruler, cut the right end of (1) **H** 3-3/4" strip at a 45° angle, as shown in diagram below. From remaining **H** strip cut 3-3/4" wide diamonds, laying your ruler along the cut edge. Repeat step to make **B**, **D** and **F** 5-3/8" diamonds. Set aside.




Note: Handle **B**, **D**, **F** and **H** diamonds carefully as they now have bias edges. It is very helpful to mark a dot on each corner of the diamond where 1/4" seam allowances intersect.



**2. Star Point Section:** Lay out (3) diamonds into rows of three as shown in diagram. *Note proper rotation of diamonds.* Sew rows together to make Star Point Section.

Mark a dot on each corner where 1/4" seam allowances intersect.

Make (4) Star Points.



### **Star Point Block**

For following step refer to your favorite quilting source for Y-seams.

**3.** Using a Y-seam, sew together (2) Star Point Sections and (1) **G** 21-1/4" triangle as shown in diagram to make an angled unit. *Note proper rotation of Star Point unit.* Do not sew into the 1/4" seam allowance at marked dots. Press seam open.

Note **G** fabric is directional. Make sure the print is right side up (or horizontal in direction for each side of the quilt so that you can read the words horizontally.

Make (4) Star Point Blocks. Set aside.




#### TEMPLATE KEY



## **APPLIQUE BLOCK** Refer to your favorite quilting source for a preferred appliqué method.

**4.** Referring to Template Key, draw or mark a 14" margin to (1) **G** 16" square, fold square twice diagonally to mark center. Place your applique pieces working from back to front, flower center circles should be placed last. Keep applique designs inside the 14" margin. Stitch appliqué in place. Square block to 14-1/2". Make (4) **G** Blocks.

**6.** Mark dots at all 4 corners at the ¼" seam allowance.



### Star Halves

**5.** Sew together (2) Star Point Blocks, as shown in diagram. Add (1) **G** Appliqué Block to Star Point Pairs. Do not sew into the 1/4" seam allowance at marked dots. Press seams open. *Note direction of G fabric.* 

Make (2) Star Halves.

### QUILT ASSEMBLY Refer to Quilt Diagram on page 4.

**6.** Stitching between marked dots, sew together the Star Halves, as shown in QUILT DIAGRAM. Press seam open. Set (1) **G** Appliqué Block to each open corner of quilt center, *note proper rotation of* **G** *block.* Press seams open. Quilt Center should measure 48-1/2" square including seam allowances.

**7. Border A:** Sew (1) **A**  $1-1/2'' \times 48-1/2''$  strip to both sides of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) **A**  $1-1/2'' \times 50-1/2''$  strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

For following step refer to your favorite quilting source for Mitered Borders.

**8. Border C:** Mark the center of (4) **C** 6-1/2" x 65" LOF strips. Sew strips to sides of quilt center, matching centers, ending stitching 1/4" from each corner. Miter the corners, trim and press miter seams open. Press to **C** border.


### QUILT DIAGRAM
