# ABC Play Quilt

A		42120-X Multi	4-1/4	(8) 7-1/2" squares <b>Backing:</b> (2) 61" x 42" strips, sew together and trim to 61" x 68"
B		42123-4 Yellow	1-7/8	(1) Template letter A* (1) Template letter B* (1) Template letter C* (4) 2-1/2" x 40" strips (2) 2-1/2" x 21" strips (2) 2-1/2" x 10" strips <b>Binding:</b> (1) 28" square for bias binding, cut 2-1/2" wide strips on the bias.
C		42121-2 White	1/2	(8) 7-1/2" squares
D		42123-2 White	1/2	(8) 7-1/2" squares
E		42121-1 Turquoise	1/2	(8) 7-1/2" squares

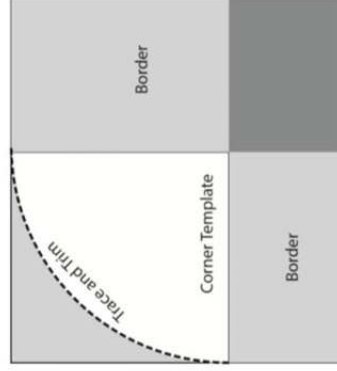
\* Note: Applique templates are not reversed. So lay template on right side of fabric and cut on outline (You do not need to add 1/4" for seam allowances because you will not be turning under the edges but instead, leaving them raw).



# ABC Play Quilt

## INSTRUCTIONS

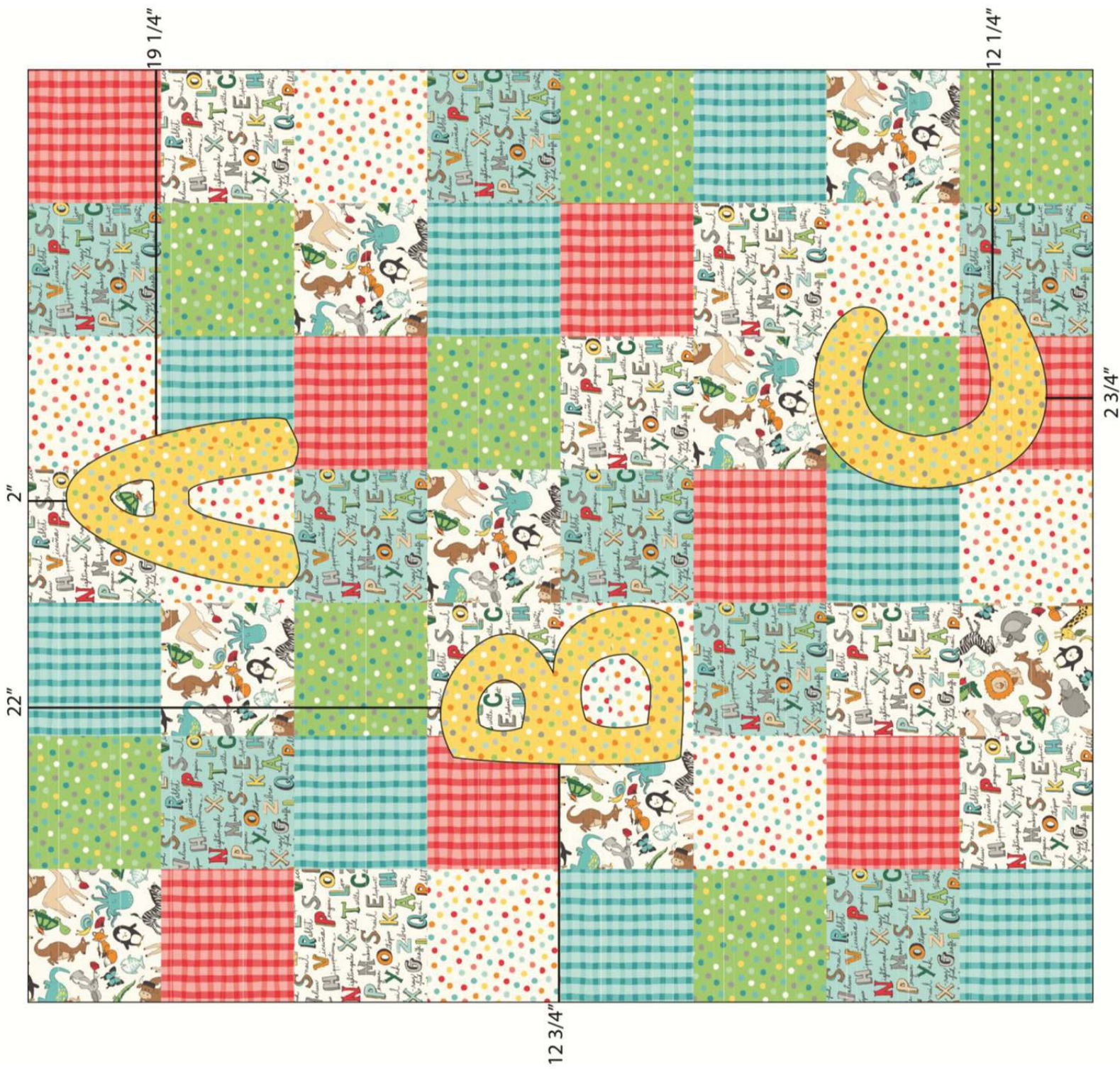
1. Take all of the 7-1/2" squares and sew them together into (8) rows with (7) blocks each. Refer to the layout diagram for the fabric placement in each row. Sew the rows together in the quilt top.
2. Pin the A, B, and C appliques to the quilt top following the measurements in the layout diagram, or create your own layout. Applique the letters to the quilt top using a blanket stitch.\*
3. Sew (1) A 2-1/2" x 21" strip to (1) A 2-1/2" x 40" strip to make (1) A 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" border. Repeat to make (2) 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders. Repeat with the A 2-1/2" x 10" and remaining A 2-1/2" x 40" strips to make (2) A 2-1/2" x 49-1/2" borders.
4. Sew the 49-1/2" A borders to the top and bottom of the quilt, then sew the 60-1/2" A borders to the sides. Using the Corner Template provided, mark and trim the corners of the quilt.




5. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.
6. Join the A 2-1/2" bias strips to make a continuous bias binding. Sew the binding around the quilt top, easing at the corners. Turn the binding to the back and secure in place by hand or machine. Label and enjoy!





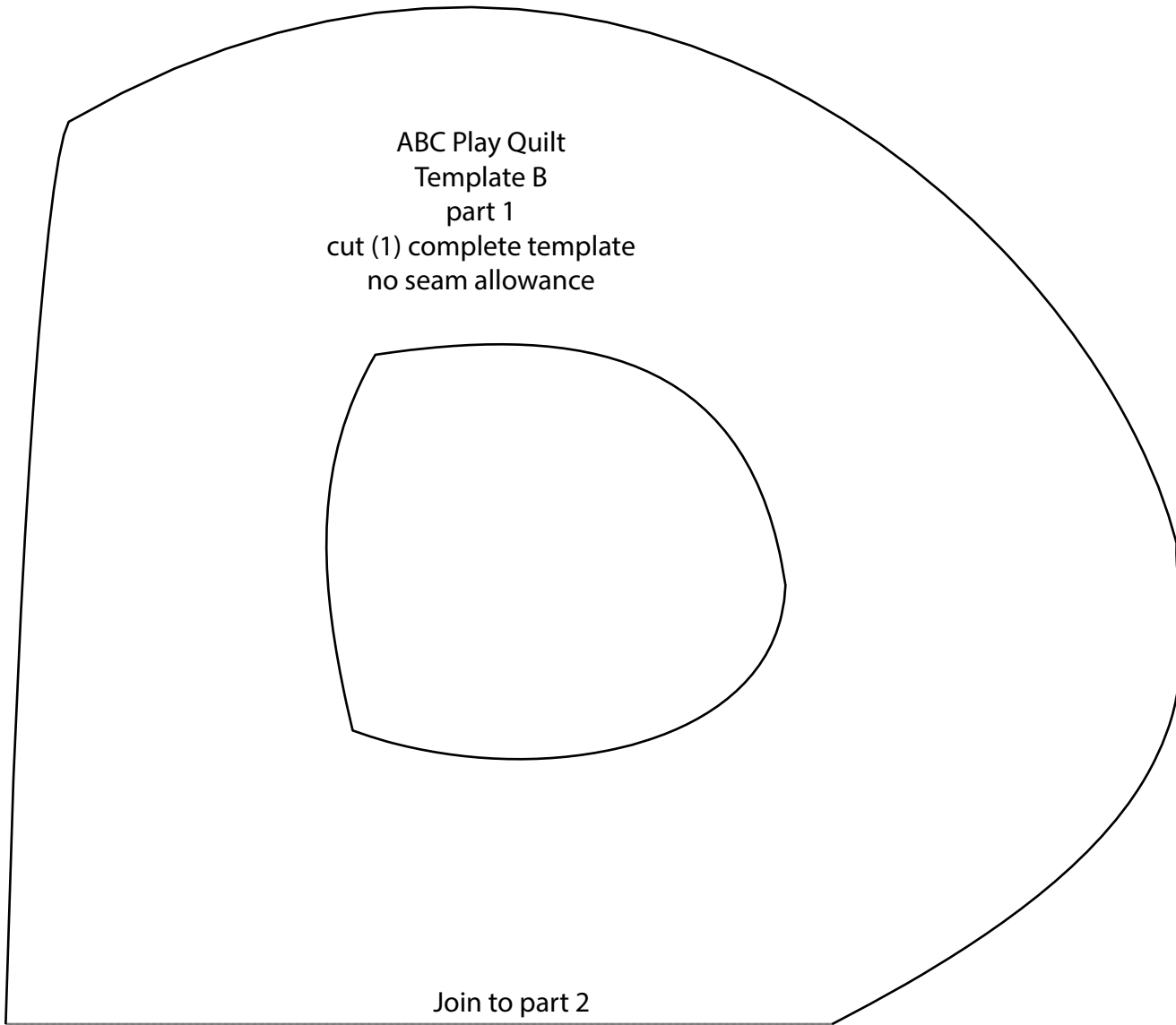

Corner Template

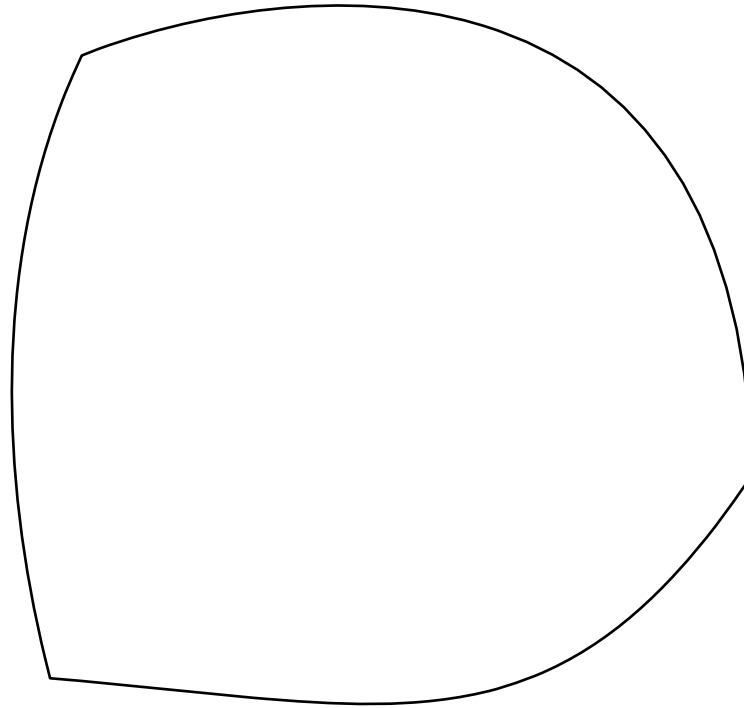

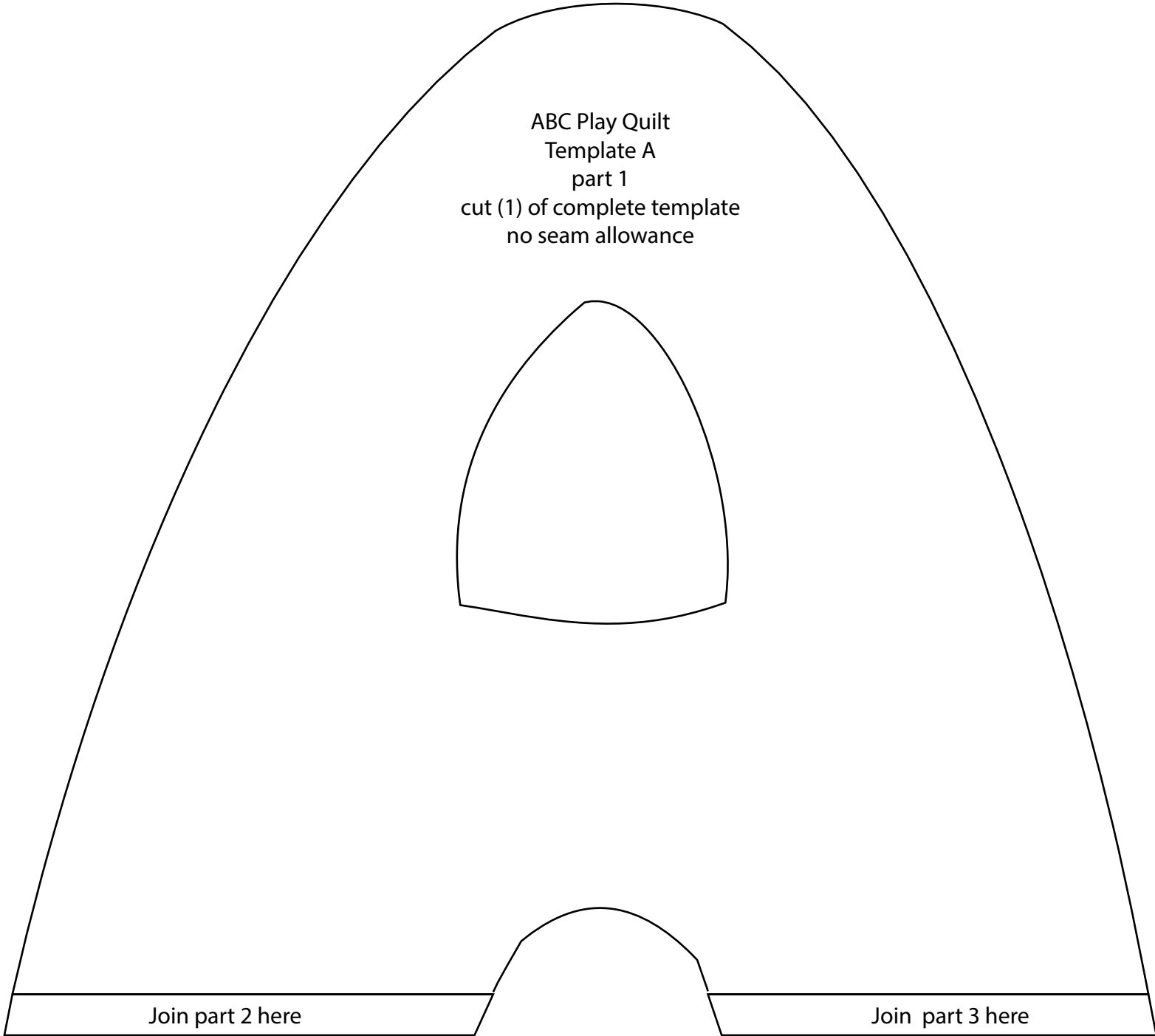
