




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Estimated Fabric Requirements:

7∕₃ yard – 43233-1 Blue ⁵/₈ yard – 43232-5 Grey ⅓ yard – 43231-1 Blue 1 ⅓ yards – 43234-6 Royal ⅓ yard – 43234-5 Grey ²∕₃ yard – 43234-7 Green 1 ¹/₈ yards – 43234-2 Red 1⁄4 yard – 40171-2 Artisan Black ²/₃ yard – 43234-4 Navy 4 ¼ yards – 43232-4 Navy

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A: Ships – Blue

• Cut four 6 1/2" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strips. Sew the strips together end to end with matching seams and cut two $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $63 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric B: Planets – Grey

• Cut four 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with matching seams and cut two 4 ¹/₂" x 63 ¹/₂" strips.

Fabric C: Aliens – Blue

• Cut four 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with matching seams and cut two 6 ¹/₂" x 63 ¹/₂" strips.



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Cutting Instructions - Continued:

Fabric D: Stars – Royal

- Cut ten 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with matching seams and cut six $2" \times 63 \frac{1}{2}"$ strips.
- Cut two 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six 2" x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut eighteen Template 1 triangles.
- Cut eighteen Template 2 triangles.

Fabric E: Stars – Grey

- Cut two 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
- Cut eighteen Template 1 triangles.
- Cut eighteen Template 2 triangles.

Fabric F: Stars – Green

- Cut seven 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with matching seams and cut four 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut two 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into fifteen 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.

Fabric G: Stars – Red

- Cut seven 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with matching seams and cut four 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut two 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with matching seams and cut two 2" x 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with matching seams and cut two 2" x 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric H: Artisan Black

• Cut two 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

Fabric I: Stars – Navy

• Cut eight 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

Backing: Planets – Navy


• Cut two 74" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 74" x 84" for the pieced back.




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Block Assembly:

- 1. Place one Fabric E-Template 1 triangle on top of one Fabric D-Template 1 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 1). Sew the two triangles together along the right side. Press the triangle open to make one Unit 1 block (Fig. 2). Repeat to make eighteen Unit 1 blocks total.
- 2. Place one Fabric E-Template 2 triangle on top of one Fabric D-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 3). Sew the two triangles together along the left side. Press the triangle open to make one Unit 2 block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make eighteen Unit 2 blocks total.




- 3. Sew one 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric H strip to each end of one 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric F strip. Sew one 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric G strip to each end of the new strip to make one Unit 3 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make three Unit 3 strips total.
- 4. Sew one 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric H strip to each end of one 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric G strip. Sew one 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric F strip to each end of the new strip to make one Unit 4 strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make six Unit 4 strips total.



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- 5. Follow Figure 7 and sew two Unit 1 blocks, two 3 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric E strips, two Unit 2 blocks and one Unit 3 strip together to make one Block One. Repeat to make three Block Ones total.
- 6. Follow Figure 8 and sew two Unit 1 blocks, two 3 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric E strips, two Unit 2 blocks and one Unit 4 strip together to make one Block Two. Repeat to make Six Block Twos total.



Quilt Assembly – Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top:

- 7. Sew one Block One, one 2" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip, one Block Two, one 2" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip and one Block Two together. Sew one 2" x 63 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the new strip to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Four and Seven.
- 8. Sew one 1 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of one 6 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric C strip lengthwise. Sew one 4 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric B strip to the bottom of the new strip to make Row Two.
- 9. Sew one 1 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of one 6 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric A strip to make Row Three. Repeat to make Row Five.
- 10. Sew one 1 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of one 6 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric C strip lengthwise. Sew one 4 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric B strip to the top of the new strip to make Row Six.
- 11. Sew the seven rows together, in numerical order (pay attention to the orientation of Row Seven), to make the Center Block.
- 12. Sew one 2" x 73 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew one 2" x 66 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 13. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 14. Sew the eight 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
- 15. Bind as desired.
