(48) 1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles. (24) 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles. FOR BINDING: (6) 2 ¾" x WOF strips.




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BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

(Designer Note: Blocks are pieced using the courthouse steps method. Sew the rectangles onto the center square in the order written. The quilt features blocks in Colorways 1 - 5. Diagrams indicate piecing methods using Colorway 1, then a written guide and diagrams show accurate fabric placement for each additional colorway.)

- **1.** Create Block Colorway 1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" **Fabric A** rectangle to the top and bottom of (1) 6 ½" **Fabric B** square. Press outward.
- **2.** Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" **Fabric A** rectangle to either side of the unit from Step 1. Press outward. The block should measure 8 ½" x 8 ½" unfinished at this step.
- **3.** Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" **Fabric G** rectangle to the top and bottom of the unit from Step 2. Press outward.
- **4.** Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric G** rectangle to either side of the unit from Step 3. Press outward to complete the block. Block Colorway 1 should measure 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- **5.** Repeat to create (8) Block Colorway 1.



6. Repeat the assembly methods described above to create Block Colorways 2 - 5. Use the fabric combinations and quantities listed below and the diagrams shown.

a. Colorway 2: Create (8)

- Fabric C 6 ½" square.
- Fabric H 1 ½" x 6 ½" and 1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles.
- Fabric A 1 ½" x 8 ½" and 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles.

b. Colorway 3: Create (4)

- Fabric F 6 ½" square.
- **Fabric A** 1 ½" x 6 ½" and 1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles.
- **Fabric E** 1 ½" x 8 ½" and 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles.

c. Colorway 4: Create (4)

- Fabric D 6 ½" square.
- **Fabric H** 1 ½" x 6 ½" and 1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles.
- Fabric A 1 ½" x 8 ½" and 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles.

d. Colorway 5: Create (1)

- **Fabric C** 6 ½" square.
- **Fabric H** 1 ½" x 6 ½" and 1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles.
- Fabric I 1 ½" x 8 ½" and 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles.



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QUILT ASSEMBLY:

- **7.** Lay out the blocks in a 5 x 5 grid as shown in the diagram below. Note the placement of Colorways 1 5. Sew the blocks into horizontal rows first, alternating the direction in which you press the seams in each row.
- **8.** Sew horizontal block rows together to complete the quilt top center. The quilt top center should measure 50 %" x 50 %" unfinished.
- 9. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric A Side Border strip onto either side of the guilt top center. Press outward.
- **10.** Sew (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** Top/Bottom Border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top center. Press outward to complete quilt assembly. The quilt should measure 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



FINISHING THE QUILT:

- 11. Sandwich quilt with batting and backing. Baste quilt layers together using your preferred method.
- 12. Quilt as desired.
- 13. Bind quilt using (6) Fabric A 2 ¼" strips.
