Before You Begin

Read through all directions first

All seam allowances are a scant 1/4"

RST stands for "Right Sides Together"

WOF stands for "Width of Fabric"

Fabric requirement assumes 40" between selvages

Extra fabric will be required if using directional prints

Cutting Instructions (Blocks):

Large Ampersands Black 39743-1

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Large Ampersands White 39743-2

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"rectangles.

Medium Ampersands Black 39744-1

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Medium Ampersands White 39744-2

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Small Quotations Black 39745-1

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Small Quotations White 39745-2

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Black 35370E-2

- Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
- Cut (1) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square.

Raspberry 36124S-4

Cut (4) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Optic White 35370E-1

- Cut (8) 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" rectangles.
- Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles.

Cutting Instructions (Borders):

Optic White 35370E-1

- Cut (4) 6 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips.
- Cut (2) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.
- Cut (2) 6 1/2" x 18 1/2" strips.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS VERSION A (PINK)

Cutting Instructions (Blocks):

Large Ampersands Black 39743-1

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Large Ampersands White 39743-2

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2"rectangles.

Medium Ampersands Black 39744-1

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Medium Ampersands White 39744-2

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Small Quotations Black 39745-1

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Small Quotations White 39745-2

Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Black 35370E-2

Cut (1) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square.

Raspberry 36124S-4

Cut (24) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Cutting Instructions (Sashing):

Raspberry 36124S-4

- Cut (8) 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" rectangles.
- Cut (16) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles.

Cutting Instructions (Borders):

Raspberry 36124S-4

- Cut (4) 6 1/2" x 40 1/2" strips.
- Cut (2) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.
- Cut (2) 6 1/2" x 18 1/2" strips.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS VERSION B (GREEN)

Same as above, except replace Rapsberry 36124S-4 with Green Tea 36124S-7

Piecing The Blocks:

Block

Start with (1) Black 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle and (4) *Medium Ampersands* White 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Sew (2) Medium Ampersands rectangles to the right and left sides one at a time RST, being sure to press.

Sew the (2) remaining *Medium Ampersands* rectangles to the top and bottom RST, being sure to press the finished block.

Repeat the steps above to make four blocks of the six variations shown to the right.



**FOR Version A and Version B, insert pink and green as block centers, respectively.


Laying Out Your Blocks, Adding Sashing & Sewing Rows:

- Begin by making a Quadrant at a time, using the diagram below to ensure your blocks are placed correctly.
- Sew your blocks together a row at a time, adding the 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Optic White sashing in between.
- Once the two rows of Quadrant 1 are complete, add (1) 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" Optic White sashing in between your row. Sew, and Press, completing your Quadrant.
- Follow the steps above to make Quadrants 2, 3 and 4. Lay the finished units as shown in the diagram.
- Taking (1) 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" Optic White sashing strip and sew it in between Quadrant 1 and 2.
- Repeat the step above, adding the sashing strip in between Quadrant 3 and 4.
- Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" Optic White sashing strip to the Black 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square.
 Press.
- Sew the remaining sashing strip to the other side of the Black square. Press.
- Sew the top unit (Quadrant 1 & 2) to the bottom unit (Quadrant 3 & 4), adding the long sashing strip you created above in between.

Adding Borders:

- Take (1) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" square and (1) 6 1/2" x 40 1/2" length and sew them RST along the short side. This will create your left side border.
- · Repeat the above step, one more time to create the right side border.
- Sew the left and right borders onto the pieced top, press.
- Take (1) 6 1/2" x 18 1/2" rectangle and (1) 6 1/2" x 40 1/2" length and sew them RST along the short side. This will create either your top border.
- Repeat the above step one more time to create the bottom border.
- Sew the top and bottom borders onto the pieced top, press and carefully square up your quilt top.



Finishing The Quilt:

- Due to the size of the quilt, you will need to piece the back. Please be sure to leave a minimum of 4" excess on all sides for ease of quilting.
- · Press your quilt top and backing, so they are wrinkle-free and flat.
- · Layer your quilt top, batting and backing.
- Baste.
- · Quilt as desired.
- · Bind the quilt using your favorite method.
