

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

















**FABRIC REQUIREMENTS** 

39743-1 Black 1/4 yard 39744-1 Black 1/4 yard 39745-1 Black 1/4 yard 35370E-1 White 3 yards Backing 4 yards

39743-2 White 1/4 yard 39744-2 White 1/4 yard 39745-2 White 1/4 yard 35370E-2 Black 1/8 yard

Binding: 35370E-2 Black 1/2 yard

#### Before You Begin:

- Read through all directions first
- All seam allowances are a scant 1/4"
- RST stands for "Right Sides Together"
- WOF stands for "Width of Fabric"
- Fabric requirement assumes 40" between selvages
- Extra fabric will be required if using directional prints

#### **Cutting Instructions (Blocks):**

Large Ampersands Black 39743-1

Cut (3) 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles.

Large Ampersands White 39743-2

Cut (3) 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles.

Medium Ampersands Black 39744-1

Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Medium Ampersands White 39744-2

Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Small Quotations Black 39745-1

Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Small Quotations White 39745-2

Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Black 35370E-2

Cut (6) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Optic White 35370E-1

Cut (6) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.



#### **Cutting Instructions (Sashing):**

Optic White 35370E-1

- Cut (5) 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" rectangles.
- Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles.

#### Piecing The Blocks:

#### Block A

These are your rectangles measuring 6 1/2" x 10 1/2"

You will have (3) of *Big Ampersands* Black, and (3) of *Big Ampersands* White.

#### **Cutting Instructions (Borders):**

Optic White 35370E-1

- Cut (1) 22 1/2" x 36 1/2" rectangle.
- Cut (1) 22 1/2" x 34 1/2" rectangle.
- Cut (1) 10 1/2" x 36 1/2" rectangle.
- Cut (1) 10 1/2" x 34 1/2" rectangle.





#### Block B

Start with (1) Black 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle and (4) *Medium Ampersands* White 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.

Sew (2) Medium Ampersands rectangles to the right and left sides one at a time RST, being sure to press.

Sew the (2) remaining *Medium Ampersands* rectangles to the top and bottom RST, being sure to press the finished block.

Repeat the steps above making a total of (3)

Medium Ampersands White blocks, (3)


Medium Ampersands Black blocks, (3) Small

Quotations White blocks, and (3) Small

Quotations Black blocks.














#### Laying Out Your Blocks, Adding Sashing & Sewing Rows:

- · Using the diagram below, lay out your Blocks A and B accordingly.
- Add the 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Optic White sashing in between. Sew, and Press.
- Once your rows are finished, then add the 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" Optic White sashing in between.
- Be sure this finished unit is pressed nice and flat.







#### **Adding Borders:**

- Sew the 10 1/2" x 34 1/2" border to the 10 1/2" x 36 1/2" border, along the short side. This will create your left side border.
- Sew the 22 1/2" x 34 1/2" border to the 22 1/2" x 36 1/2" border, along the short side. This will create your right side border.
- Sew the left and right borders onto the pieced top, press and carefully square up your quilt top.

#### Finishing The Quilt:

- Due to the size of the quilt, you will need to piece the back. Please be sure to leave a minimum of 4" excess on all sides for ease of quilting.
- · Press your quilt top and backing, so they are wrinkle-free and flat.
- · Layer your quilt top, batting and backing.
- Baste.
- Quilt as desired.
- · Bind the quilt using your favorite method.
