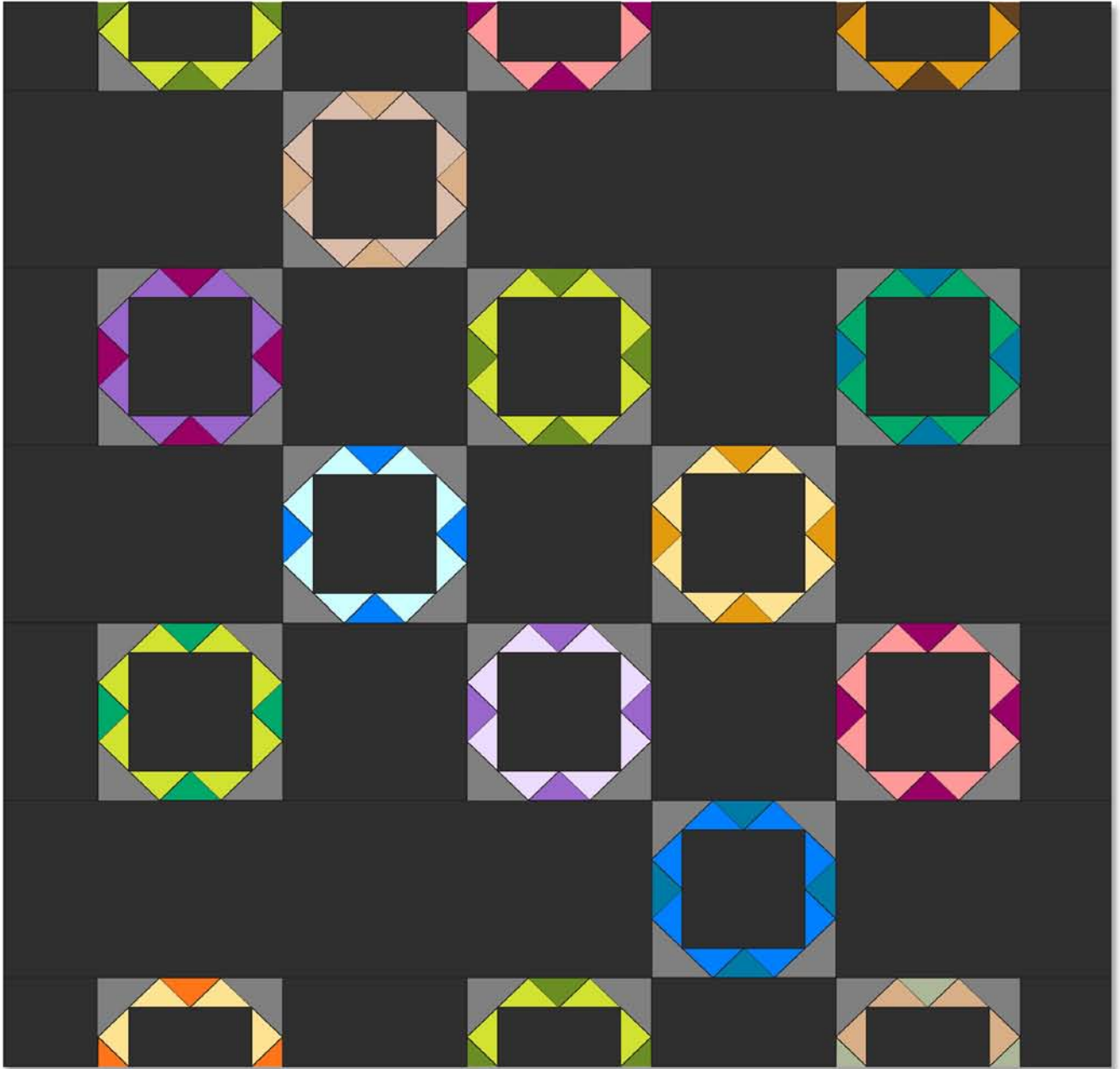

Fabric Requirements

- 1/3 yard 40171-1 Charcoal White for blocks
- 2 1/4 yards 40171-2 Black Grey for background
- 1/2 yard 40171-8 Green Yellow for binding and blocks
- 3 1/2 yards 40171-24 Navy White for backing
- 1/8 yard of each remaining Artisan Cotton color for blocks
- 62"x 62" piece of batting

Cutting

From the Black Grey cut:

4 rectangles, 9"x 13 1/2"

2 rectangles, 9"x 29 3/4"

5 squares, 9"

8 rectangles, 4 3/4"x 9"

6 rectangles, 3 1/4"x 6 1/4"

10 squares, 6 1/4"

4 squares, 4 3/4"

From the Charcoal White cut:

13 squares, 5 1/4"; sub cut on both diagonals to make 52 Quarter Square Triangles (QST)

From the Green Yellow cut:

12 squares, 2 7/8"

6 strips, 2 1/4" for binding

From the Blue Red cut:

3 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 6 Half Square Triangles (HST) (discard 1)

1 square, 2 3/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 2 HST

From the Red Yellow cut:

1 square, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 2 HST (discard 1)

1 square, 2 3/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 2 HST

From the Blue Aqua cut:

6 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 12 HST

From the Green Blue cut:

6 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 12 HST

From the Blue Orchid cut:

6 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 12 HST

From the Red White cut:

6 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 12 HST

From the Yellow White cut:

6 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 12 HST

From the Aqua White cut:

4 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 8 HST

From the Orchid White cut:

4 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 8 HST

From the Tan Beige cut:

4 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 8 HST

From the Navy White cut:

4 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 8 HST

From the Black Copper cut:

1 square, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 2 HST (discard 1)

1 square, 2 3/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 2 HST

From the Tan Copper cut:

3 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 6 HST (discard 1)

1 square, 2 3/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 2 HST

From the Yellow Copper cut:

4 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 8 HST

From the Green Copper cut:

3 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 6 HST

2 square, 2 3/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 4 HST

From the Turquoise Copper cut:

2 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 4 HST

From the Aqua Blue cut:

2 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 4 HST

From the Red Royal cut:

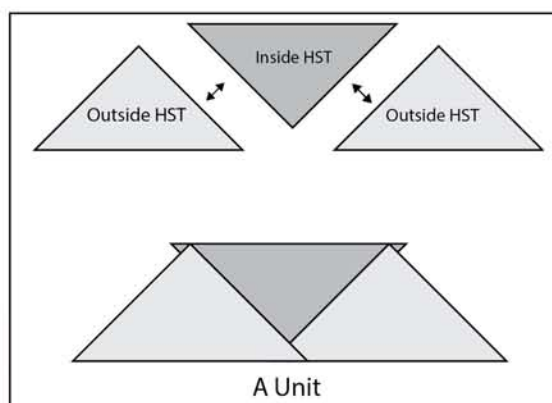
2 squares, 2 7/8"; sub cut on the diagonal to make 4 HST

Instructions

For this project, press all the seams open.

- Following the diagram and chart below, sew the 2 7/8" HST together into the A Units. Press, and then set aside the A Units of the same color pairing together.

Outside HST Color	Inside HST Color	A Units Total
Green Yellow	Green Blue	4
Green Yellow	Green Copper	6
Green Blue	Turquoise Copper	4
Red White	Blue Red	5
Blue Aqua	Aqua Blue	4
Aqua White	Blue Aqua	4
Blue Orchid	Red Royal	4
Orchid White	Blue Orchid	4
Yellow White	Yellow Copper	4
Yellow White	Red Yellow	1
Yellow Copper	Black Copper	1
Tan Beige	Tan Copper	4
Peach Turquoise	Tan Copper	1



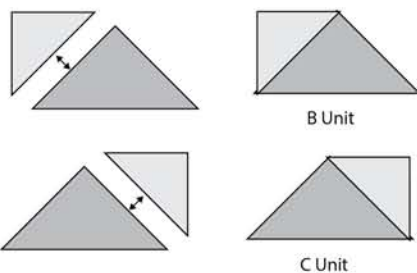

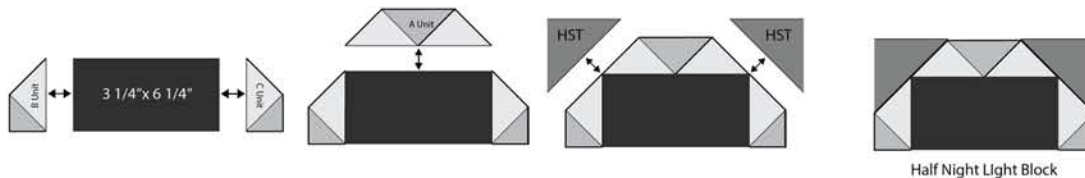

2. Following the diagram and chart below, sew the remaining $2 \frac{7}{8}$ " HST and the $2 \frac{3}{8}$ " HST together into the B Units. Press, and then set the B Units aside with the A units of the same color pairing.

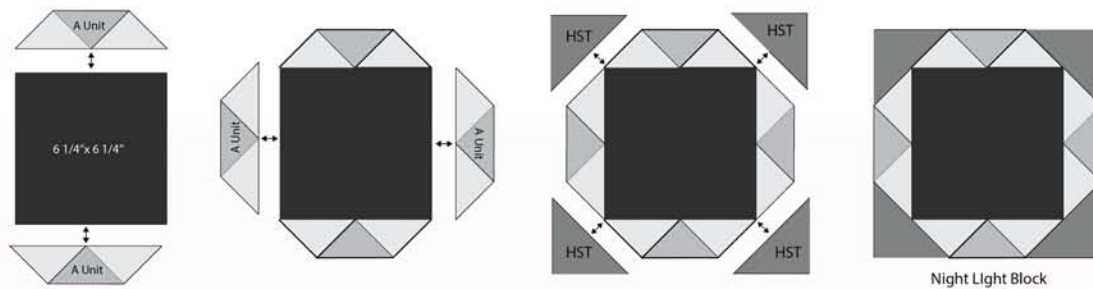
Outside HST Color	Inside HST Color	B Units Total	C Units Total
Green Yellow	Green Copper	2	2
Red White	Blue Red	1	1
Yellow White	Red Yellow	1	1
Yellow Copper	Black Copper	1	1
Peach Turquoise	Tan Copper	1	1



3. Take a matching B and C Unit and sew them to the sides of a Black Charcoal $3 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{4}$ " rectangle as shown. Press, and then sew a matching A Unit to the top. Press. Take two Charcoal White HST and sew them to the outside corners. Press, trim and square to $4 \frac{3}{4}$ " x 9". Repeat for all the B and C Units to make 6 Half Night Light Blocks.



4. Take a set of four matching A Units and sew them to a Black Charcoal 9" square as shown. Press. Take 4 of the Charcoal White $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " QST and sew it to the outside corners as shown to make one Night Light Block. Repeat for the remaining A Units to make 10 Night Light Blocks total.



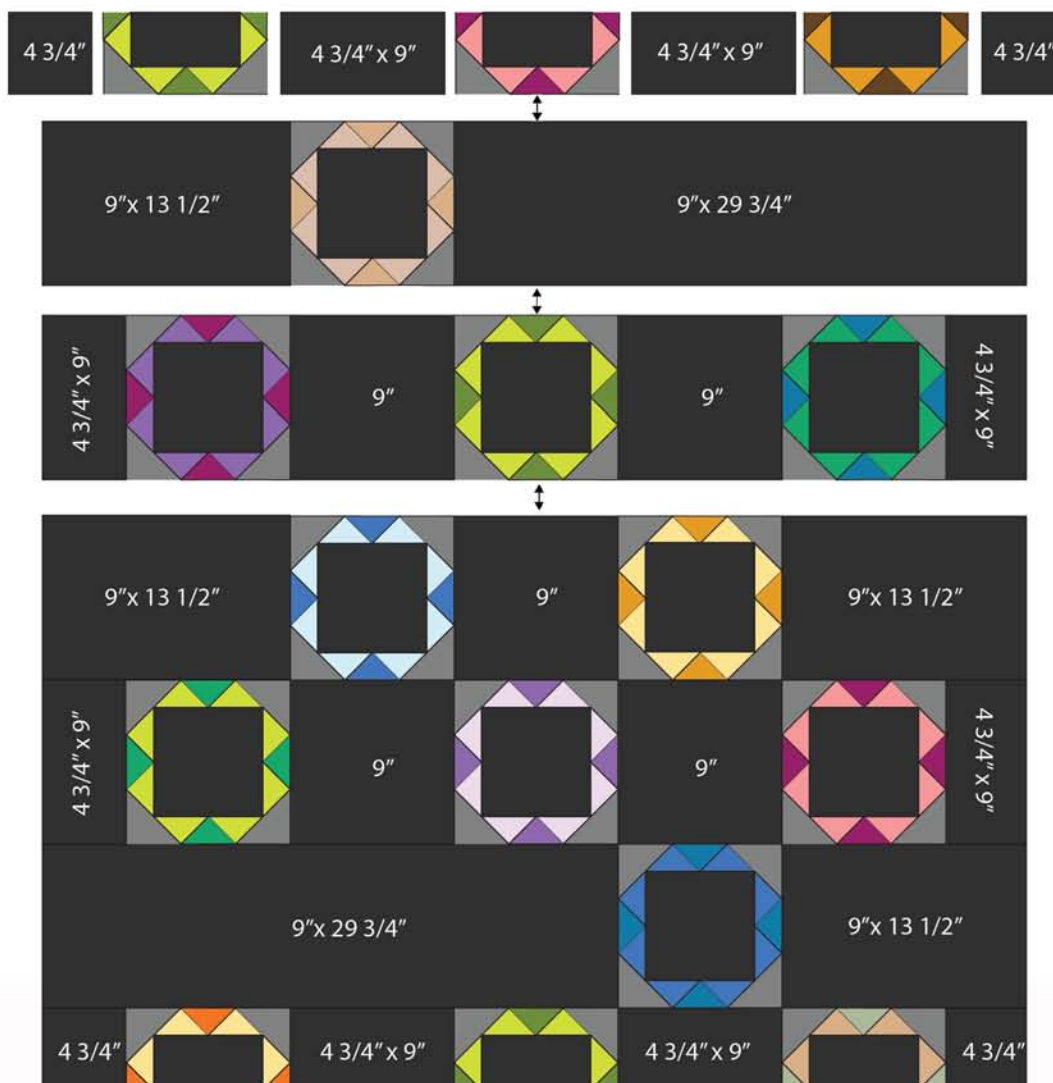

5. Using the diagram below, sew all the blocks and remaining Black Charcoal pieces together to make the quilt top, paying close attention to the orientation of the color blocks to make the quilt exactly as shown.

6. Piece the Navy White together into a backing square measuring about 63"x 63". Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the Green Yellow 2 1/4" wide binding strips, sew around the quilt top. Turn the binding to the back and secure in place by hand or machine. Label and enjoy!



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
