## ADDITIONAL REOUIREMENTS

Thread to match fabrics
Basic sewing supplies
Template plastic
Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

## BLOCKS

Note: Mark the center of the curved edges by folding the piece in half and finger pressing the fold.

1. Align the center of the inner curve of (1) B Template 1 and the curved edge of (1) $\mathbf{D}$ Template 2 and then pin the centers together. Pin the ends of the seamlines together. Ease the curves along the seamline and pin about every $3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$.
2. Carefully and slowly sew along the seamline. Press the seam toward Template 1.


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3. Following steps 1-2, sew (1) P Template 2, (1) M Template 2 and (1) J Template 2 to Template 1 to make a square. Block 1 should measure $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square including the seam allowance. Make 2.
4. Following steps 1-3, make blocks 2-15 using the fabrics shown. Make the number of blocks indicated.


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5. Following the Quilt Layout, arrange the blocks in (5) rows of (5) blocks each. Sew (1) Template 2 to blocks along outer edges of the quilt using the colors shown.
6. Sew the blocks in each row together. Sew the rows together matching seams.


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using C 2-1/4" strips.

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## TEMPLATES

Make 2 copies of Template 1. Cut out both templates. Cut along the center line of (1) template removing the shaded area.

Match the center lines overlapping the shaded area. Glue or tape the pieces together.
