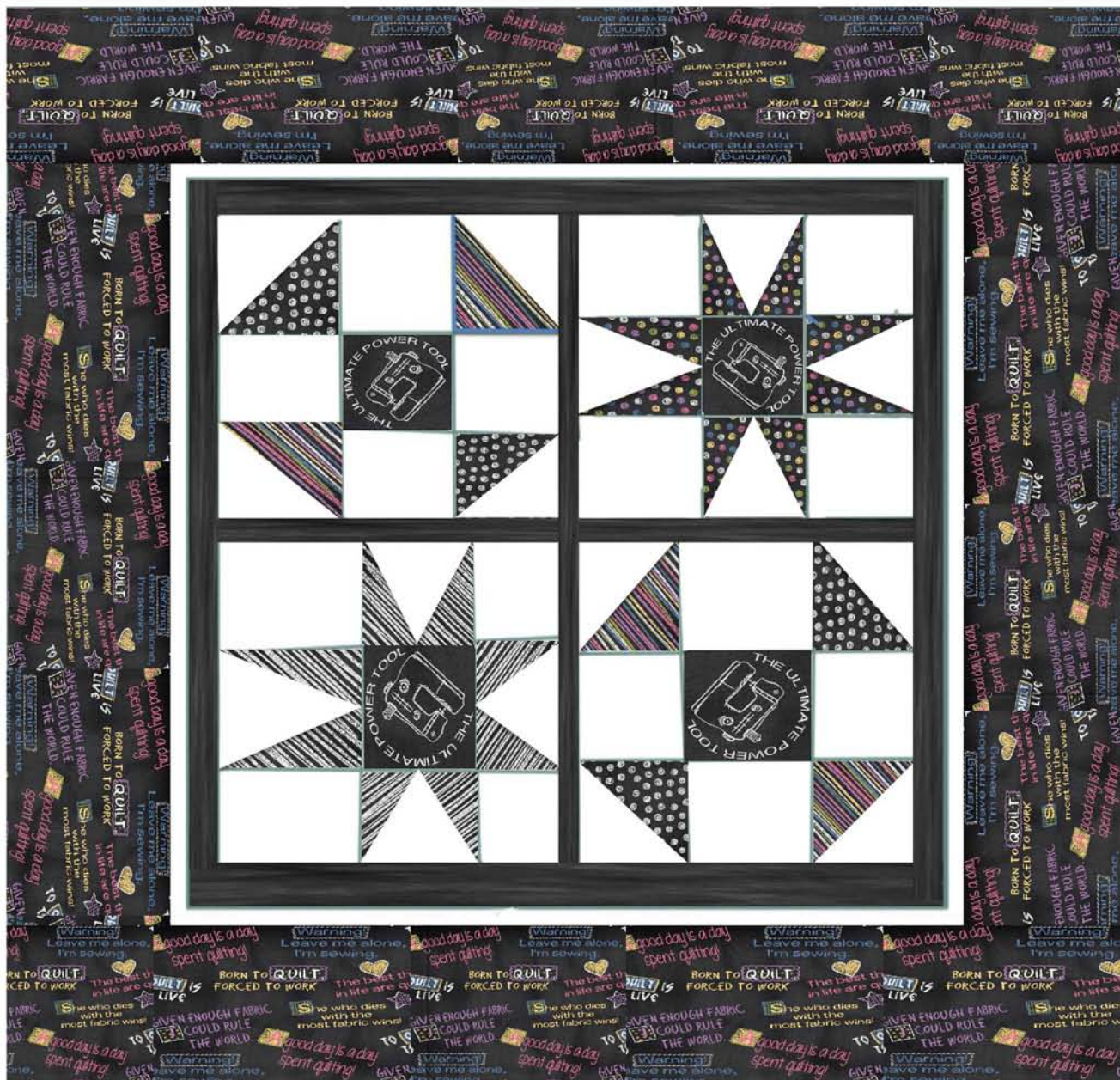

Materials:

Note: Materials are based on the 40" wide fabric width. Cutting dimensions include a ¼ " seam allowance. These two blocks are made in a liberated style that results in a bit of wonky piecing.

- 39592-X Stripes, multi-colored - Fat eighth
- 39592-1 Stripes, black and white - Fat eighth
- 39015A-1 Black chalkboard solid -1/2 yard
- 39590-1 Sewing machine pattern, all-over - 1/8 yard
- 39591-1 Dots, all-over - Fat eighth
- 39591-X Dots, multi-colored - Fat eighth
- 39589-X Quilting slogans, main pattern - 1 yard
- White Background - ¾ yard
- 39015A-1 Black chalkboard solid -1/2 yard (binding)
- Backing - 3 yards
- Batting - 50"x 50"

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Cutting Instructions:

Shoo Fly and Star Blocks:

White Background – cut 4 - 4" WOF then sub cut into 32x 4" squares

39590-1 Sewing machine pattern Fussy-cut (4) 4 inch square sewing machine blocks for the centers of each block.

39592-1 Stripes, black and white – cut 4 - 5" squares then cut in half diagonally.

39591-X Dots, multi-colored – cut 4 - 5" squares then cut them in half diagonally

39592-X Stripes, multi-colored – Cut 2 - 5" squares then cut both in half diagonally

39591-1 Dots, black and white – Cut 2 - 5" squares then cut both in half diagonally

Borders:

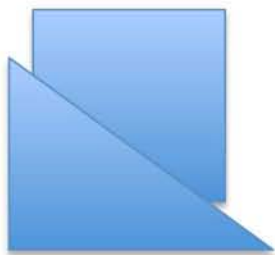
Wide Border – (39589-X Quilting slogans, main pattern) Cut 4 - 7.5" WOF (Width of fabric)

White Border – Cut 4 - 1.5" WOF

Black border and sashing (39015A-1 Black chalkboard solid) Cut 4 - 2" WOF

Piecing the blocks

Both of these blocks are basically simple 9 patch blocks, but 4 of the segments are a bit fancy.



Lay one of the triangle pieces over a corner of a white background square. Make sure when stitched down and pressed that there is overlap.

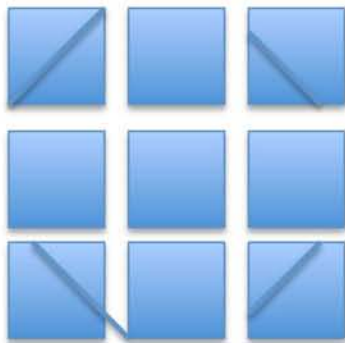


Trim excess to size of background square. Make 4 of these blocks per shoo fly and assemble like you would a 9 patch with the fussy cut sewing machine in the center.

Trim each block down to 11 inches.

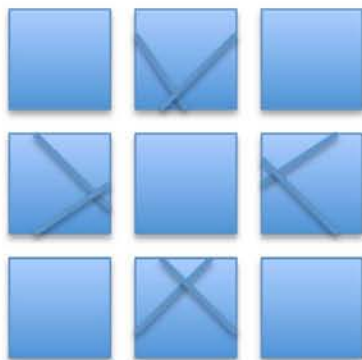

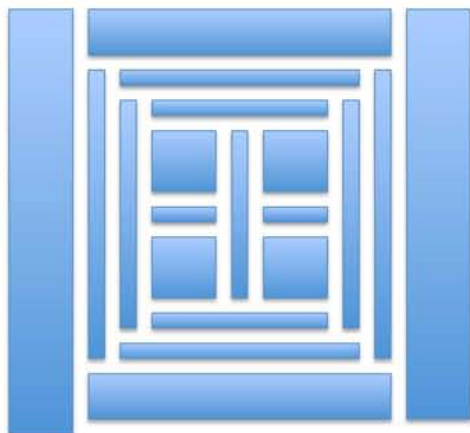
Trim each block down to 11 inches.

Star Blocks:

Make the star block in the same way that you did the shoo fly, except for each of the fancy segments piece 2 triangles onto the background square. Press and trim each segment and assemble as you would a 9 patch. After block assembled trim to 11 inches.



Make 2 star blocks



Assemble quilt as shown and quilt as desired.
