Fabric Requirements:

39011-X Multi: 5/8 yard 39014-1 Red: 5/8 yard

Additional Requirements:

3/4 yard red pompom trim 5/8 yard fusible fleece

Cutting:

Join the pieces of the templates on the last pages to make the stocking pattern.

Cut (2) stockings for stocking outside

39014-1 Red

Cut (2) stockings for lining

Cut (2) 16 3/4" x 5" rectangles for top cuff

Cut 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strip for loop

Fusible Fleece


Cut (2)stocking templates

Cut (1) 16 3/4" x 5" rectangle for top cuff

Assembly:

All seam allowances are 1/4"

1. Fuse the fleece to wrong side of the stocking outside following the manufacturer's recommended instructions. Repeat for the other side.

2. With right sides together, stitch the stocking outside pieces together leaving the top open. Clip Curves. Turn stocking to the right side and press. Pic 1

- 3. Join the stocking lining pieces together same as for the outside.
- 4. With wrong sides together, slide the lining into the stocking outside and baste the top edge closed.
- 5. Fold the loop strip in half lengthwise and sew on long edge. Turn and press flat. Fold in half and stitch open end closed. Pic 2

6. On inside, pin loop to upper ege of stocking covering back seam.

Baste in place. Pic 3










- 8. Turn rectangle with right side facing up and pin the pompom tape to the end with pompoms facing away from the edge. Stitch in place. Pic 5
- 9. Stitch short end closed. Pic 6

10.Take the other side and close the short end. Then with right sides together, sew the edge with the pompom tape being careful not to catch a pompom in the seam. Turn and press. Stitch open end closed. Pic 7

11.Pin the cuff to the WRONG side of the stocking, matchin the seam at the back. Stitch the opening edge together easing fullness where necessary. Turn the cuff to the outside and press.




