#### PIECED BLOCKS

- Corner Triangles: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) L 1-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) B 4-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal L corner triangle. Repeat with (3) additional L squares for the remaining corners of the same B square to complete (1) dark Circle Block. Make (5).
- Repeat Step 1 using (4) B 1-1/2" squares and (1) L 4-1/2" square to make (1) light Circle Block. Make (4).

Draw diagonal line on wrong side of **L** square.


Sew on drawn line.



Trim 1/4" and open to reveal **L** corner triangle.




Repeat on remaining corners.





- 9-Patch Block: Arrange and sew together
  (3) Circle Block units to make (3) rows. Sew rows together to complete (1) pieced block, measuring 12-1/2" square unfinished. Make (3).
- Make (3) Pieced Blocks each using fabrics
  C-K for a total of (30) blocks.



Block measures 12-1/2" square unfinished.


#### QUILT ASSEMBLY

- Pieced Rows: Refer to quilt image on page 4 for block placement. Arrange and sew together
  (5) pieced blocks and (4) L 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles. Make (6). Row 1 is shown below.
  - Row 1



- 6. Sashing Rows: Sew together (5) L 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles and (4) K 1-1/2" squares. Make (5).
- 7. Sew together (6) pieced rows and (5) pieced sashing rows to complete quilt center.
- Inner Border: Sew (2) L 2-1/2" x 77-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) L 2-1/2" x 68-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
- 9. Outer Border (mitered): Sew (2) A 6" x 98" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, matching the strip center to quilt center. Begin and end seams 1/4" from each end. Repeat with (2) A 6" x 85" strips. Miter corners to finish. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press open to complete quilt top. Quilt top measures 79-1/2" x 92-1/2".





**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **M** 2-1/2" strips.
