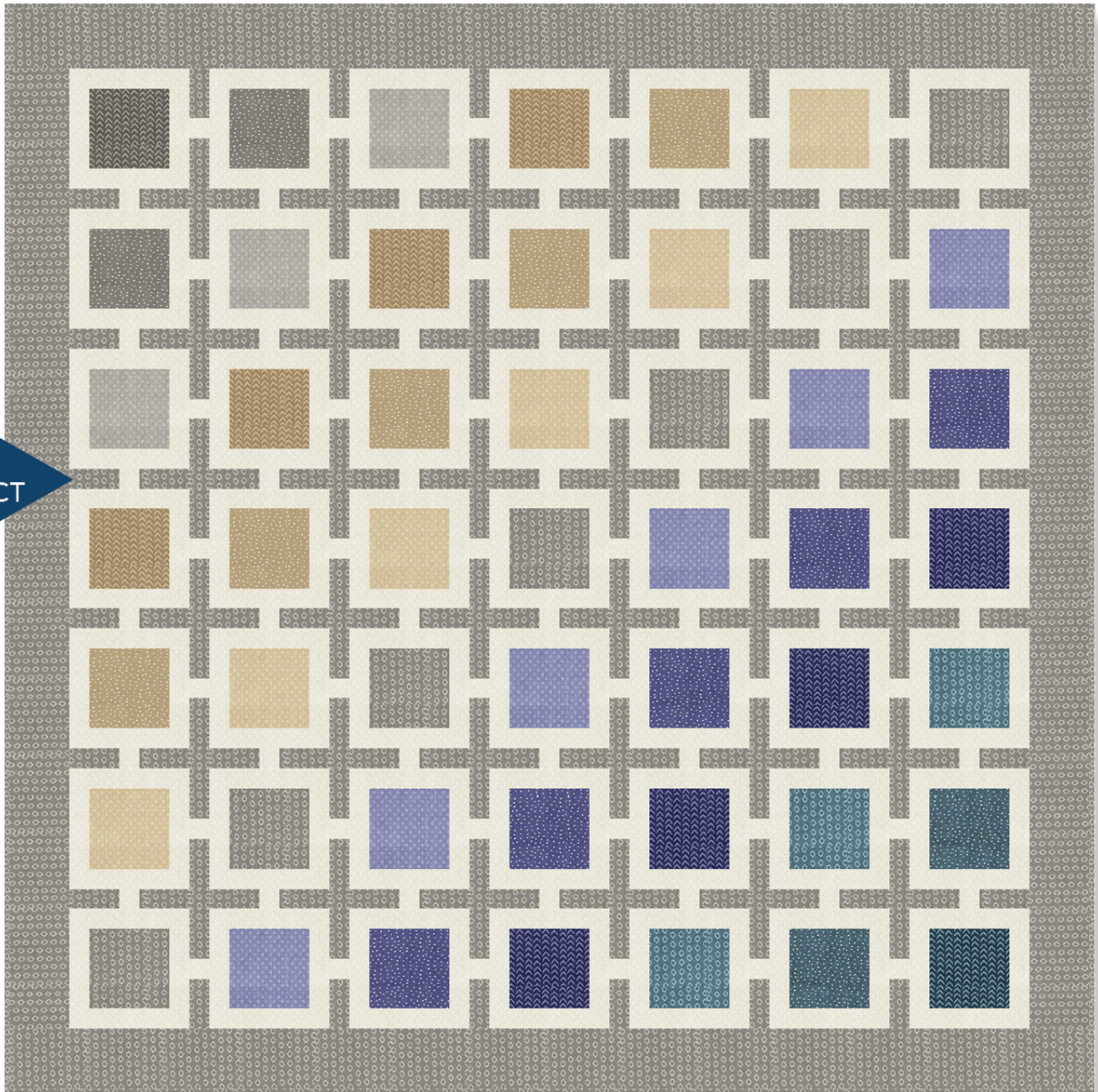

A		42299-4 Taupe	1 1/2	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 4 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 98 (1 1/2" x 4 1/2") rectangles. Widthwise, 4 (6 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 98 (1 1/2" x 6 1/2") rectangles. Sashing blocks Widthwise, widthwise, 3 (1 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 84 (1 1/2" x 1 1/2") squares.
B		42296-6 Steel	1/4	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 1 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.
C		42296-3 Acid Washed	1/4	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 1 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.
D		42300-6 Steel	1/4	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 2 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.
E		42300-3 Acid Washed	1/4	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 2 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.
F		42299-6 Steel	1/4	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 3 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.
G		42297-3 Acid Washed	1/4	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 3 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.
H		42296-5 Khaki	1/4	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 4 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.
J		42296-1 Indigo	1/4	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 4 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.
K		42300-5 Khaki	1/4	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 5 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.

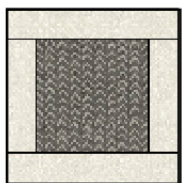

M		42299-5 Khaki	1/4	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 6 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.
N		42299-1 Indigo	1/4	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 6 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares.
P		42297-6 Steel	2	Pieced blocks Widthwise, 1 (4 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 7 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") squares. Sashing blocks Widthwise, 4 (3" x WOF). Subcut 96 (1 1/2" x 3") rectangles. Widthwise, 2 (6 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 36 (1 1/2" x 6 1/2") rectangles. Outer border Widthwise, 6 (3 1/2" x WOF). Piece strips and subcut 2 (3 1/2" x 48 1/2") and 2 (3 1/2" x 54 1/2") strips. Binding: 1/2 yd cut into 2 1/4" bias strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.

Constructing Pieced Blocks

1. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 4 1/2") **A** rectangles to the left and right sides of 1 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") **B** square.
2. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 6 1/2") **A** rectangles to the remaining top and bottom sides of **B** square to complete 1 block.

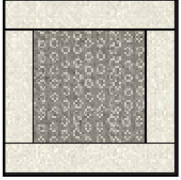




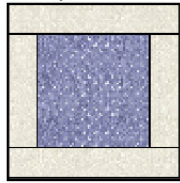
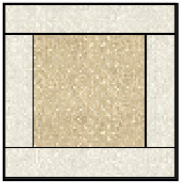
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3. Repeat to make a total number of blocks in the following color ways and orientations

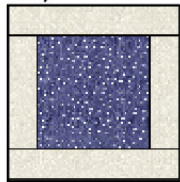
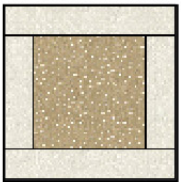

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Constructing vertical sashing blocks

1. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 3") **P** rectangles to the opposite sides of 1 (1 1/2" x 1 1/2") **A** block.

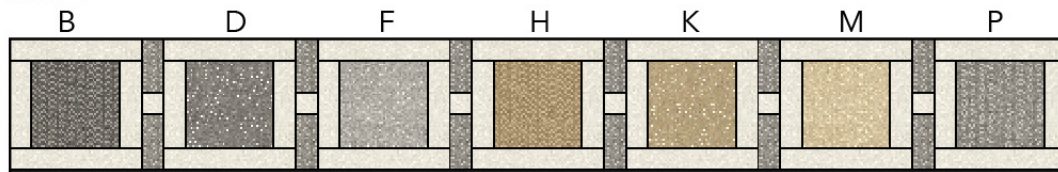


2. Repeat to make a total of 42 vertical sashing blocks.

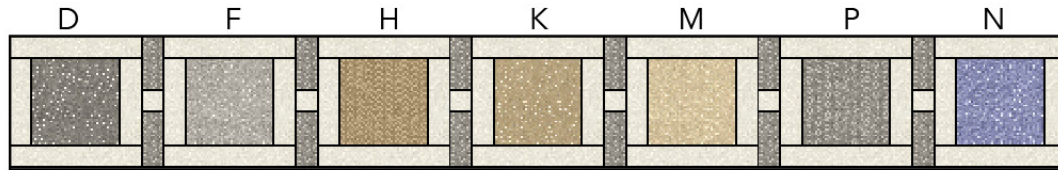
Quilt Top Assembly

1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew 7 pieced blocks and 6 vertical sashing blocks to make a row.

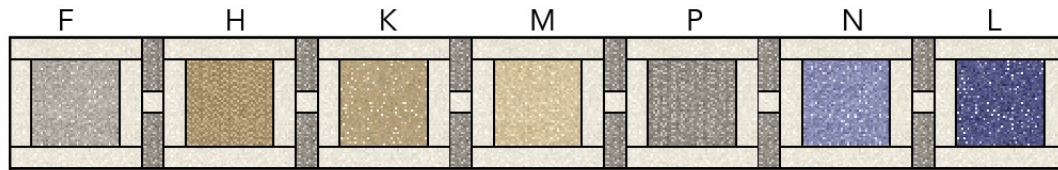

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2. Pieced sashing rows. Sew together 7 (1 1/2" x 1 1/2") **A** squares, 6 (1 1/2" x 6 1/2") **P** rectangles. Make 6 rows.

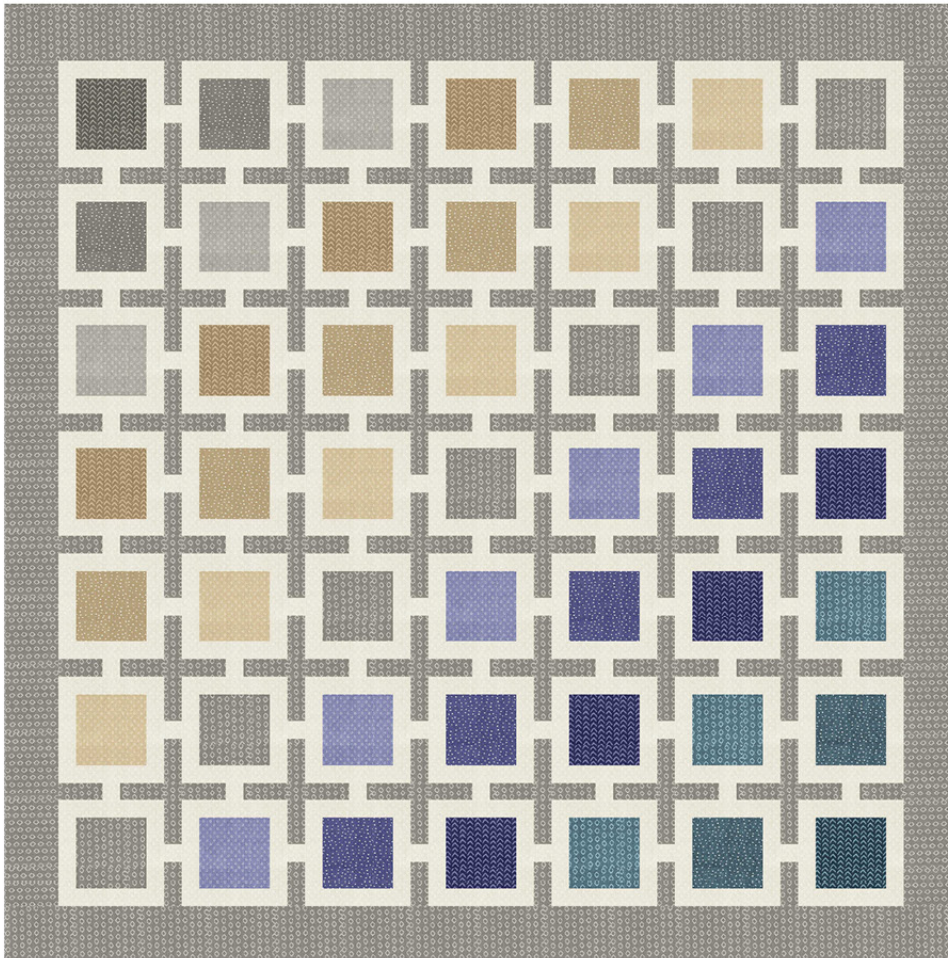


Add 2 (1 1/2" x 3") **P** rectangles to the opposite short sides to complete 1 pieced sashing row.



3. Sew pieced rows and pieced sashing rows together to complete quilt center.

4. Outer border. Sew 2 (3 1/2" x 48 1/2") **P** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (3 1/2" x 54 1/2") **P** strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Quilting Instructions:

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
