## STAR BLOCKS

1. Flying Geese Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) C $3-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square. Align marked C, RST, on a corner of (1) G 3-1/4" $\times 6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew along drawn line. Trim to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance and open to reveal $\mathbf{C}$ corner triangle. Repeat on opposite corner of $\mathbf{G}$ rectangle to complete (1) Flying Geese Unit. Make (4).

Flying Geese Unit


Make (4) C/G units.
Measures 3-1/4" x 6"
2. Noting rotation, sew (2) Flying Geese Units to the opposite sides of (1) C 6" square.
3. Sew (2) C $3-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares to the opposite short sides of (1) $3-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ Flying Geese Unit to make a row unit. Make (2).
4. Sew together row units to complete (1) Star Block. Square to 11-1/2".

## Star Unit

6. Flying Geese Unit: Repeat Step 1 using (2) G 1-3/4" squares and (1) F 1-3/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Make (4).
7. Sew (2) Flying Geese Units to the opposite sides of (1) G $3^{\prime \prime}$ square to make a row unit.
8. Sew (1) F 1-3/4" square to each side of (1) Flying Geese Unit to make a row unit. Make (2).
9. Sew together row units to complete (1) Star Unit, measuring 5-1/2" square. Make (28).


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## Stripe Unit

10. Sew together (3) D and (2) G 1-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles as shown, measuring $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
11. Sew Stripe Unit to the right of Star Unit. Unit should measure $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
12. Sew together (3) D and (3) G 1-1/2" $\times 11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.

13. Add to the bottom of previously sewn section (Step 11) to complete (1) Flag Block. Make (14). Square to 11-1/2".
14. Repeat Steps $10-13$ to make (14) Flag Blocks using fabrics I and G.


## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Use Quilt Diagram on Page 6 as a reference.
15. Rows 1, 3, 5, 7: Arrange and sew together (4) Flag Blocks and (3) Star Blocks as shown.
16. Rows 2, 4, 6, 8: Arrange and sew together (4) Star Blocks and (3) Flag Blocks as shown.
17. Sew pieced rows together to complete quilt top.
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## QUILT DIAGRAM



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using J 2-1/4" strips.
