Cutting Note: It is very important to mark and store the cut pieces according to size, as this will make it much easier when you start piecing.

A		50472-3 Charcoal	1 3/4	(2) 2 ½" x 42" strips; cut into (20) 2 ½" squares. (3) 9 ¼" x 42" strips; cut (20) Templates A and (20) Templates B. (6) 1 ½" x 42" strips, Sew end to end and cut into (2) 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips and (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips. (7) 2 ½" x 42" binding strips.
В		50474-3 Charcoal	3/4	(4) 2 ½" x 42" strips; cut into (20) 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles. (5) 2 ½" x 42" strips; cut into (20) 2 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles.
С		50473-5 Grey	1 1/8	(3) 9 ¼" x 42" strips; cut (20) Templates A and (20) Templates B. (2) 4 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (10) 4 7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal.
D		50472-1 Rose	1 3/4	(2) 4 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (10) 4 7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal. (4) 2 ½" x 42" strips; cut into (60) 2 ½" squares. (5) 4 ½" x 42" strips. Sew end to end and cut (2) 4 ½" x 62 ½" strips and (2) 4 ½" x 58 ½" strips.
E		50478-3 Charcoal	1/2	(5) 2 ½" x 42" strips; cut into (80) 2 ½" squares.
F		50475-3 Charcoal	1/4	(2) 2 ½" x 42" strips; cut into (20) 2 ½" squares.
		Backing	3 3/4	60" x 72" piece of batting.



Block Assembly

Nos-Gay Block:

1. Sew the long sides of a Fabric $\bf A$ and $\bf C$ Template A together to make Rectangle A as shown. Square up to 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Set aside.





2. Sew the long sides of a Fabric **A** and **C** Template B together to make Rectangle B as shown. Square up to $4 \frac{1}{2} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Set aside.

Rectangle B



3. Sew a Fabric **D** 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to both sides of a Fabric **E** 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square as shown. Square up to 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



4. Sew a Fabric **E** 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to both sides of a Fabric **F** 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square as shown. Square up to 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



5. Sew a Fabric **A** 2 ½" square to the left side of a Fabric **E** 2 ½" square. Sew a Fabric **D** 2 ½" square to the rights side of the unit. Square up to 6 ½" \times 2 ½".



6. Sew the unit is Step 4 to the bottom of the unit in Step 3. Sew the unit in Step 5 to the bottom of the unit in Step 4 to complete a 9 Patch Unit. Square up to 6 ½".

7. Sew a Fabric **B** 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the right side of the 9 Patch Unit as shown. Square up to 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



8. Sew a Fabric **B** 2 ½" x 8 ½" rectangle to the top of the unit in Step 7. Square up to 8 ½".



9. Sew a Rectangle A to the left side of the unit in Step 8. Square up to 12 ½" x 8 ½". Set aside.



10. Sew the long sides of a Fabric $\bf C$ and $\bf D$ triangle together to make a Half Square Triangle (HST). Square up to 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



11. Sew the HST in Step 10 to the left end of a Rectangle B as shown. Square up to 12 1/2" x 2 1/2".



12. Sew the unit in Step 11 to the bottom of the unit in Step 9 to complete the Nos-Gay Block.

Square up to 12 1/2". Make 20.




Nos-Gay Block

Assembly of Rows

The quilt center is made of 5 horizontal rows of 4 blocks each, with every other block rotated. Following the diagrams for placement and rotation of each block, sew each row as shown from left to right.


13. Row 1: Sew 4 Nos-Gay Block in a row, starting with the rotation shown in Step 12, then








14. Row 2: Sew 4 Nos-Gay Block in a row, starting with a rotated block, alternating with the block rotation shown in Step 12. Make 2 rows.



15. Sew the rows together working from top to bottom in this order: Row 1, Row 2, Row 1, Row 2 and last row on the bottom of the quilt is a Row 1. See Diagram below.





Inner Border

16. Sew the Fabric **A** 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the Fabric **A** 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Outer Border

- 17. Sew the Fabric **D** 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the Fabric **D** 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- 18. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; quilt as desired. Using the Fabric **A** 2 ½" strips bind the edges to finish.
