PIECED BLOCKS

1. Half-Square Triangle (HST): Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) **B** 7" squares. Place a marked square, right sides together, on (1) **A** 7" square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Square to 6-1/2". Make (16).

2. Sew together (1) **B** and **C** 3-1/2" strips lengthwise. Press toward **C**. Make (2). Cross cut a total of (22) **B/C** units, as shown.





Cut (22) units.

- 3. Sew (1) each B and C 3-1/2" squares together to make (2) additional B/C units.
- **4.** Four-Patch Unit: Sew (2) B/C units together to form a four-patch and press seam in either direction. Make (12).

5. Arrange (2) **HST** and (2) **Four-Patch** units as shown. Sew units together and press to complete (1) block, measuring 12-1/2" square. Make (4).

Set aside remaining HST and Four-Patch Units.


















- Appliqué Block 1: Sew (1) D 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle to each side of (1) E 8-1/2" square.
 Press toward D. Sew (1) D 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle to top and bottom of unit. Press toward
 D to complete appliqué block #1. Block measures 12-1/2" square. Make (4).
- 7. Appliqué Block 2: Repeat Step 6 using (2) F 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles, (2) F 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles, and (1) G 8-1/2" square.









Make 4 of each.

CENTER BLOCK - NOTE ROTATION OF UNITS.

8. From the remaining HST units, sew (2) HSTs together and press. Make (2). Sew units to the left and right sides of (1) K 12-1/2" square.









9. Sew together (2) of each HST and Four-Patch units, as shown. Make (2) and sew to the top and bottom of the Step 8 unit to complete center block. Block measures 24-1/2" square. Make (1).

10. Refer to your favorite quilting source for appliqué method. Refer to images below for coffee mug and pot placement and orientation on Blocks 1, 2 and Center Block. Secure with a decorative stitch of your choice.

11. Top / Bottom Rows: Noting placement of blocks, arrange and sew together (2) Pieced Blocks, (1) Block 1 and (1) Block 2 as shown below. Make (2).



12. Left / Right Columns: Noting placement of blocks, arrange and sew together (1) of each Block 1 and Block 2 as shown below. Make (2).





13. Sew left/right columns to the sides of quilt center, followed by the top and bottom rows.

BORDERS

- 14. Sew (2) A 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" borders to sides of quilt center and press toward borders.
- **15.** Sew (1) **C** 3-1/2" square to each end of the (2) remaining **A** 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" borders and press toward borders. Sew pieced borders to top and bottom of quilt center and press to finish quilt top.




QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **K** 2-1/2" strips.


