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**Cutting Notes:** Materials are to make (4) pillows. Be sure to read the entire pattern before you begin.

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## MAKING THE PILLOWS

**Note:** Seam allowance is  $\frac{1}{2}$ " to allow for zipper closing.


**1.** Take one 19" **Fabric A** square and adhere the 19" square of fusible to the wrong side of the fabric following the manufacturer's recommended instructions. Repeat for the matching **Fabric A** square. *[Note: The fusible gives nice body and structure to your pillow.]*

**2.** Determine the bottom of your pillow. Place the (2) 19" **Fabric A** squares from Step 1 right sides together. Measure in  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " from the right edge of the bottom of the pillow and mark. Repeat for the left edge. Using a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance, sew from the edge of the pillow stopping at the  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " mark. Repeat for remaining edge. This will leave a 16" opening for your zipper. Lay out and place the right sides of the pillow onto an ironing surface. Press the seam allowance open all across the pillow (sewn and unsewn section).



**3.** Following manufacturer's instructions or following a YouTube Tutorial, center the right side of the zipper to the open seam. Pin and sew down each side of the zipper and across the top and bottom.

**4.** With the zipper at least halfway open and the right sides of the pillow facing each other, sew the remaining 3 sides closed to complete the pillow.



**5.** Clip the corners and stitch around the three sides again using a straight stitch or a zig-zag stitch to reinforce the seam. Turn the pillow right side out and insert the pillow!

**6.** Repeat steps 1-5 to make (3) additional pillows.
