

B		3604Q-X Aqua	2/3	(7) 2" x WOF strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 2" x 62" borders, (2) 2" x 51-1/2" borders and (20) 2" squares. (16) Petal templates.
C		3605Q-X Sky	3/8	(4) Center templates and (16) Petal templates.
D		3606Q-X Rainbow	7/8	(6) 3-1/2" x WOF strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 56" borders and (2) 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" borders.
E		3608Q-X Pink	3/4	(1) 12-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (16) 12-1/2" x 2" strips. (5) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (15) 2" x 12-1/2" strips. (2) Center Templates.
F		3609Q-X Pink	1/4	(16) Petal Templates.
G		3610Q-X Pink	3/8	(32) Petal Templates.
H		3611Q-X Fuchsia	3/8	(32) Petal Templates.
I		3612Q-X Ultraviolet	1/2	(2) Center Templates and (32) Petal Templates.
J		3613Q-X Ultraviolet	1/4	(16) Petal Templates.
K		3613Q-X Ultraviolet	7/8	FOR BINDING: (6) 2-1/4" x WOF strips; sew short ends together. (32) Petal templates.

Thread to match fabrics

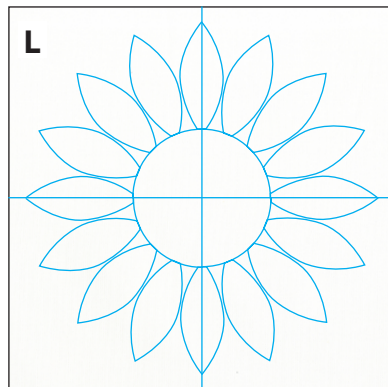
Optional: For turned under edge appliqué: freezer paper or other template paper.

For raw edge appliqué: paper backed fusible webbing.

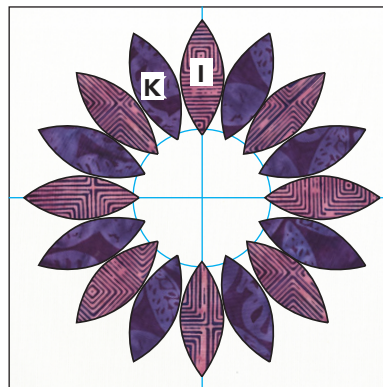
BLOCKS

1. Using your preferred appliqué method, prepare the appliqué pieces.
2. Using a water soluble marking pen, draw a vertical and horizontal line in the center of (1) **L** 12-1/2" square. Trace the appliqué pattern to the upper left quadrant of the block. Rotate the pattern and trace to the other 3 quadrants. Make (12).
3. Arrange (8) **I** Petals alternating with (8) **K** Petals in position on (1) **L** 12-1/2" square. Fuse, baste or pin the petals in place. Sew along the curved edges of the petals by hand or machine using matching thread.
4. Fuse, pin or baste (1) **A** center to position. Sew along the edge of center. by hand or machine using matching thread. Make (4).

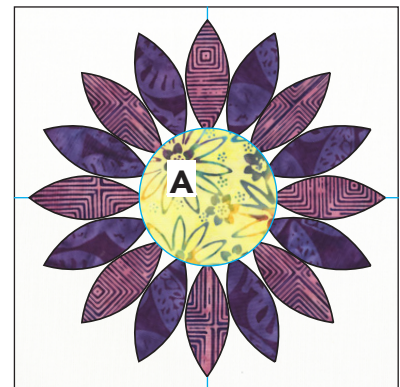

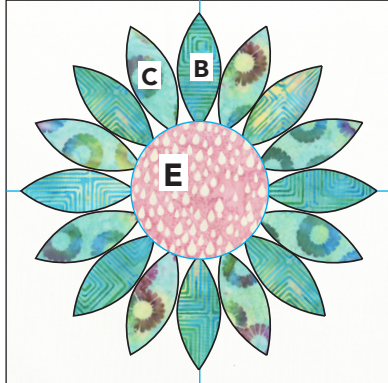

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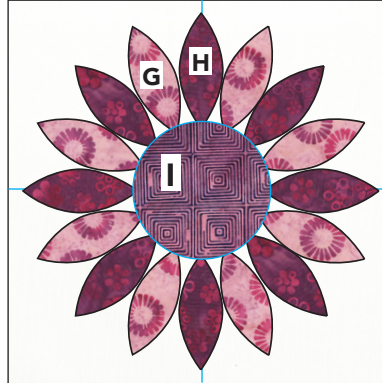
5. Following steps 2-4, make blocks using the fabrics shown. Make (2) of each block.

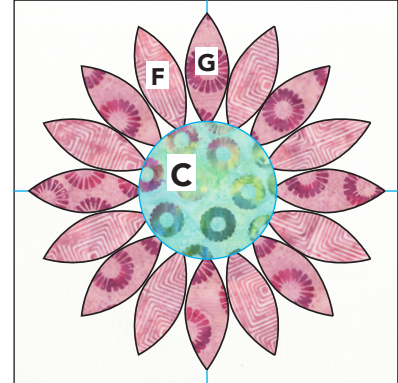

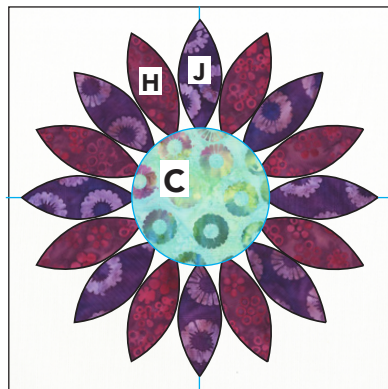

QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

6. Following the Quilt Layout on page 4, arrange the blocks in (4) rows of (3) blocks each. Sew together (4) **E** 12-1/2" x 2" strips alternating with (3) blocks to make the block rows. Note the orientation of print on the strips. Make (4).

7. Sew together (4) **B** 2" squares alternating with (3) **E** 2" x 12-1/2" strips to make the sashing rows. Note the orientation of print on the strips. Make (5).

8. Sew together (5) sashing rows alternating with (4) block rows matching the seams to make the quilt center.

BORDERS

9. Sew (1) **D** 3-1/2" x 56" border to each side of the quilt center. Sew (2) **D** 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" borders to top and bottom of the quilt.

10. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 62" border to each side of the quilt. Sew (2) **B** 2" x 51-1/2" borders to top and bottom of the quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **K** 2-1/4" strips.

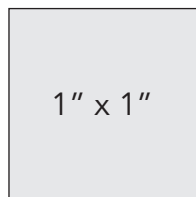
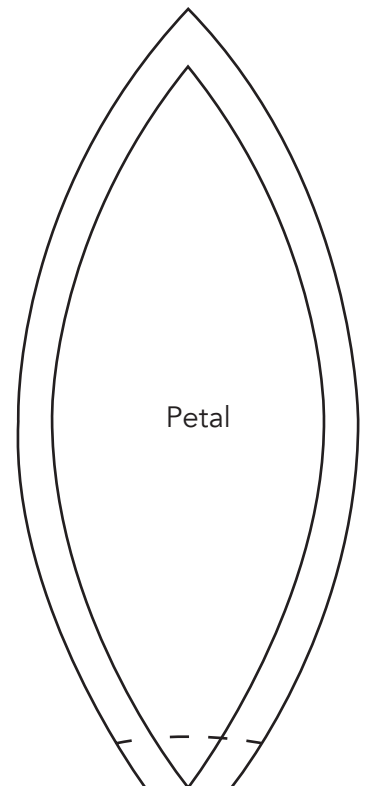
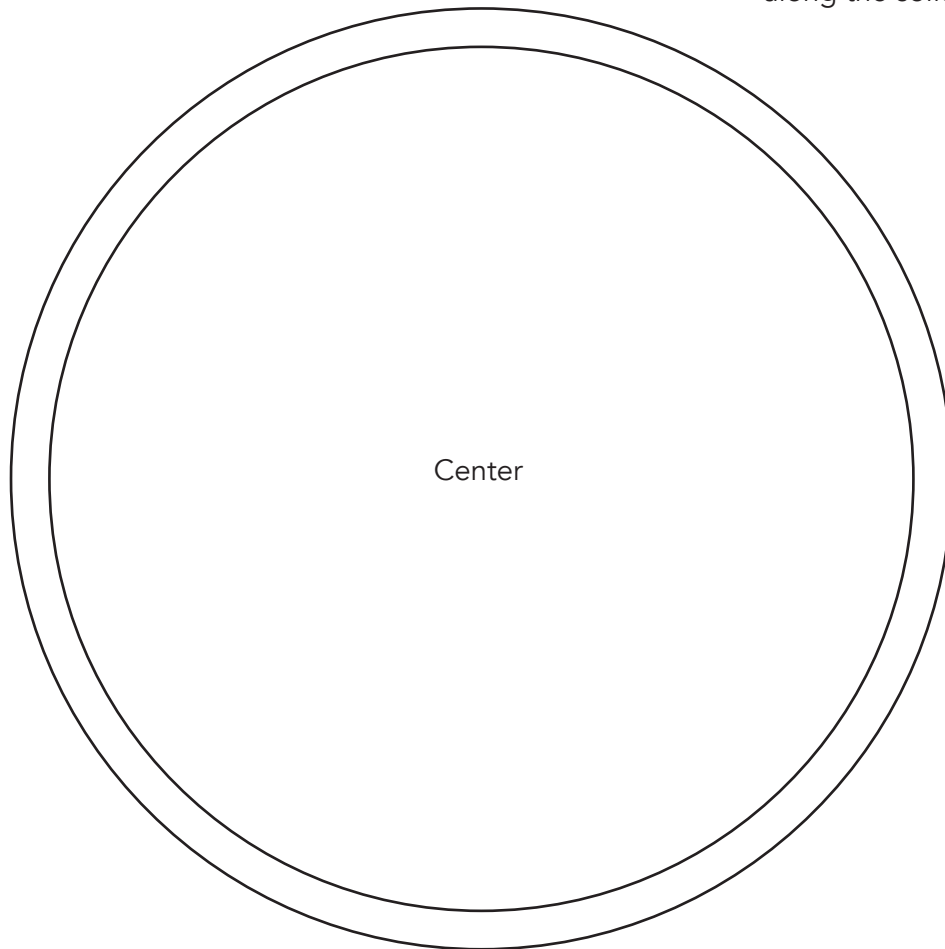


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DAISY TEMPLATES
