

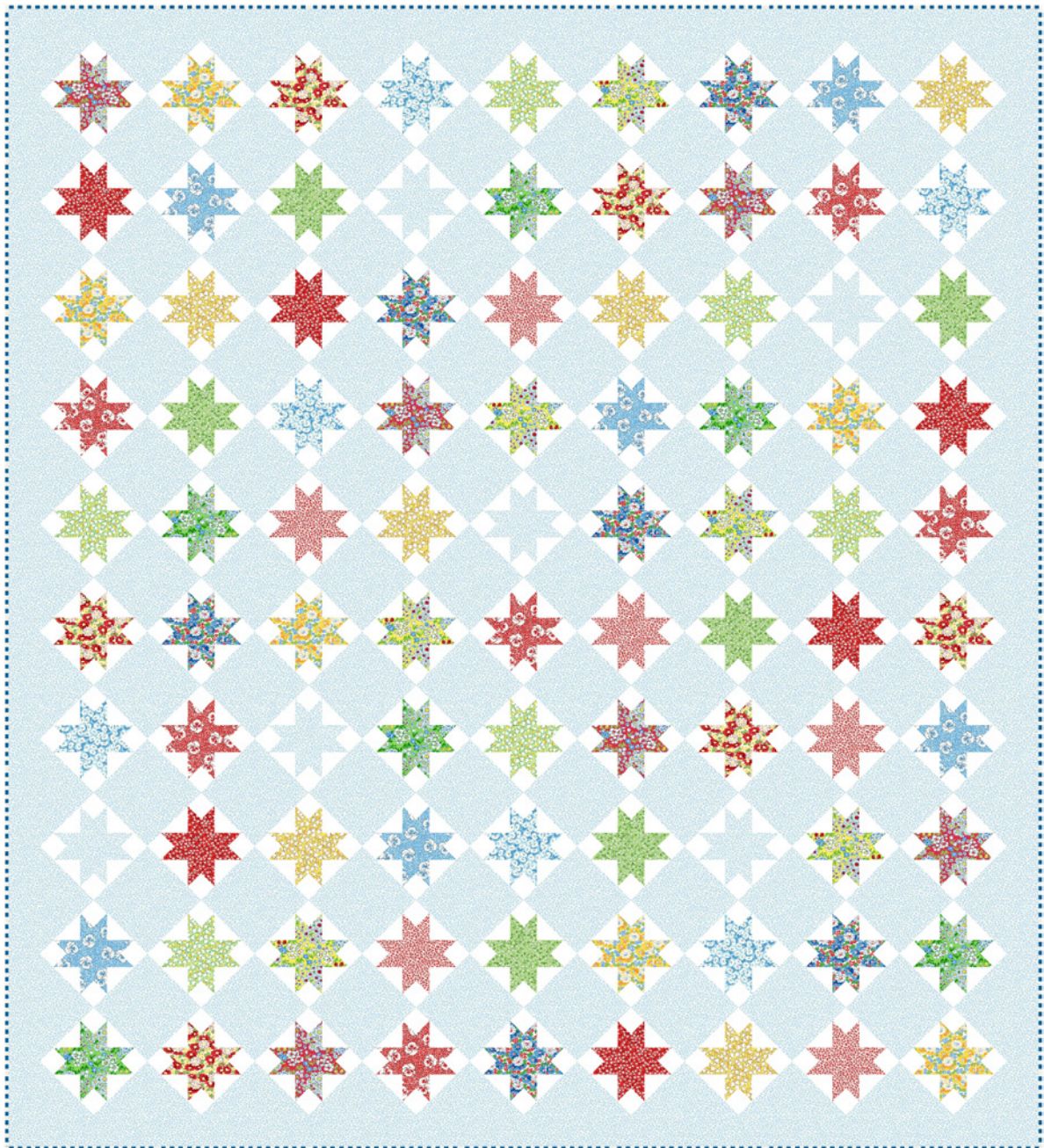

Subcut (72) 6-1/2" squares.</p> <p>TRIANGLES: (3) 9-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut (9) 9-3/4" and (2) 5-1/8" squares. Cut 9-3/4" squares diagonally twice to yield (36) triangles. Will use (34). Cut 5-1/8" squares diagonally once to yield (4) triangles.</p> <p>OUTER BORDER : (9) 3" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3" x 85-1/2" and (2) 3" x 82" strips.</p>

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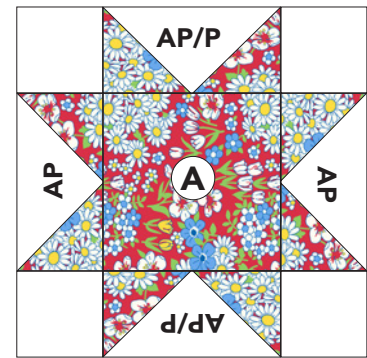
STAR BLOCKS

1. FLYING GEESSE UNITS: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) **A** 2" squares. Place (1) square, right side together (RST), at a corner of (1) **P** 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal (1) **A** corner triangle. Repeat with another **A** 2" square at the opposite corner of the same **P** rectangle. Make (4) **AP** Flying Geese Units.

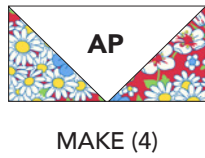
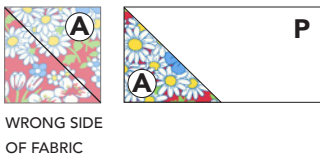
2. Add (1) **P** 2" square to each side of (1) **AP** Flying Geese Unit. Make 2, set aside.

3. Sew (1) **AP** Flying Geese Unit to the opposite sides of (1) **A** 3-1/2" square to make center row. *Note proper rotation of Flying Geese Units.* Add **AP/P** unit to top and bottom of Center Row. Trim block to 6-1/2" square.

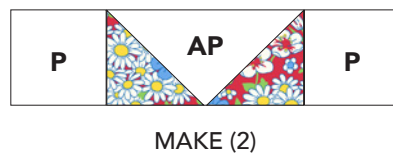
3. AP STAR BLOCK



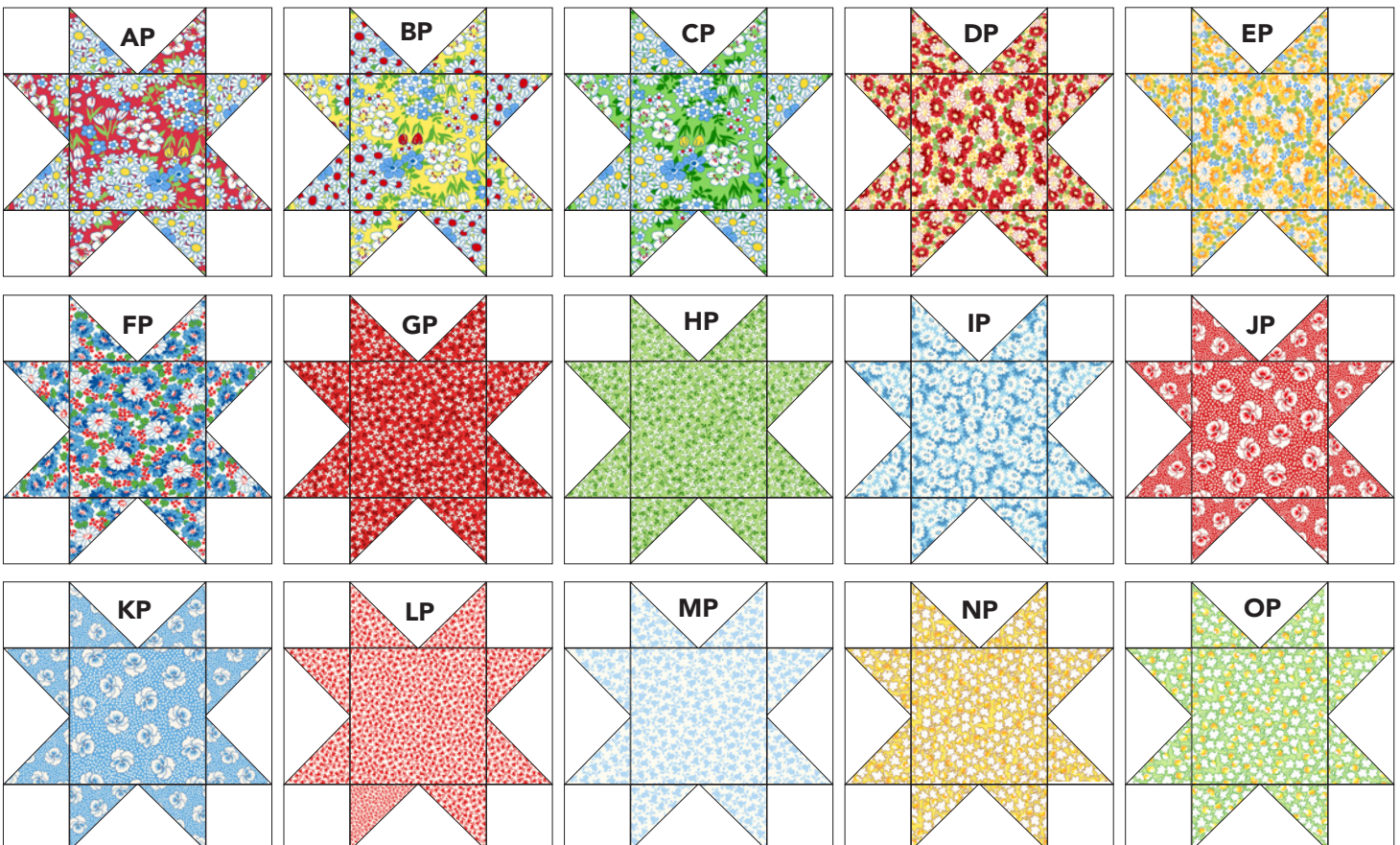
1. AP FLYING GEESSE UNIT

4. Repeat steps 1-3 to make (6) of each Star Block below, using **A-O** 2" squares:

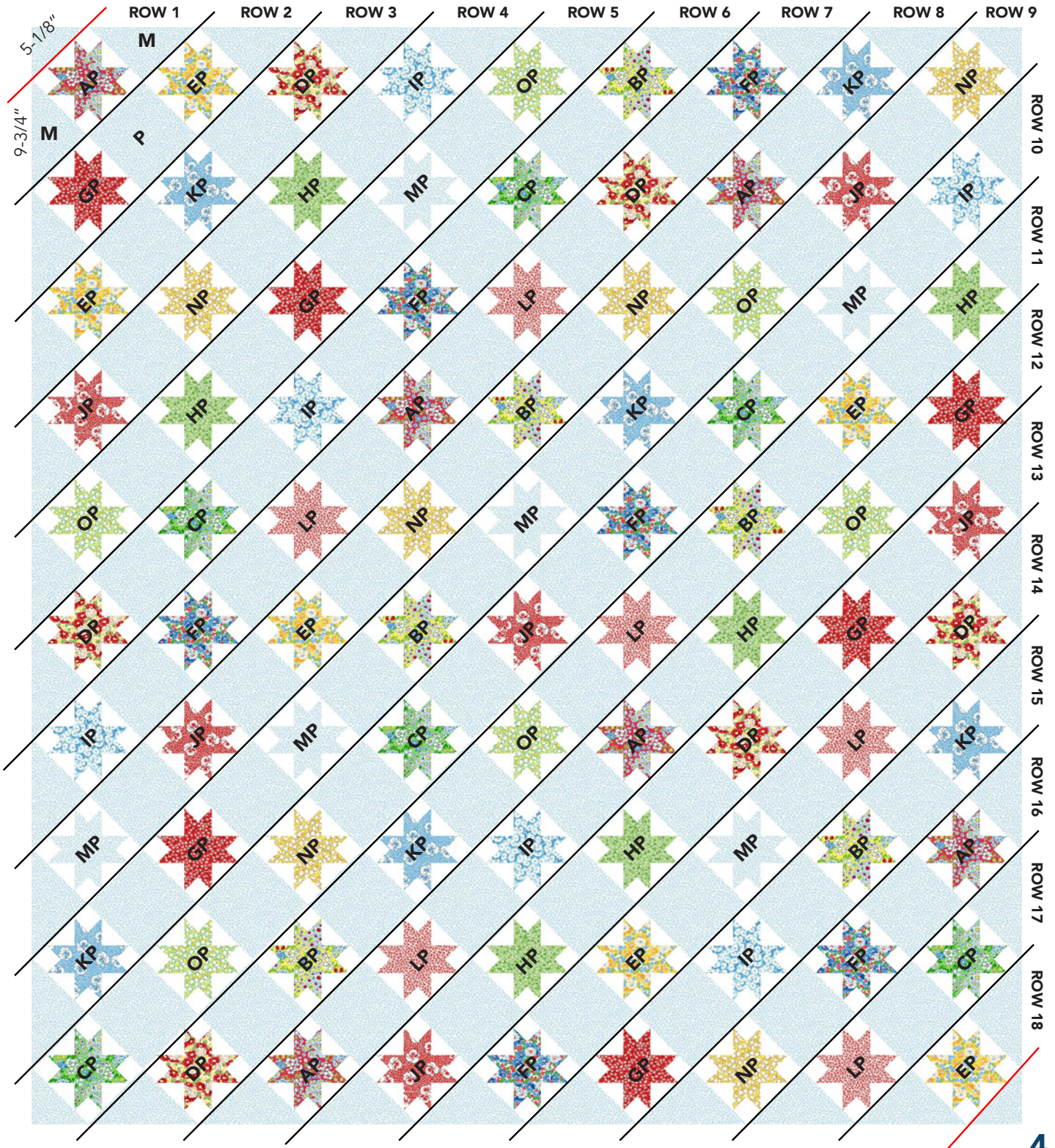




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QUILT ASSEMBLY

5. Follow *Quilt Diagram* to assemble **AP-OP** Star Blocks, **M** 6-1/2" squares, **M** 9-3/4" Side Setting Triangles and **M** 5-1/8" Corner Triangles into diagonal rows to complete quilt center. Quilt Top should measure around 76-7/8" x 85-3/8" from raw edge to raw edge.

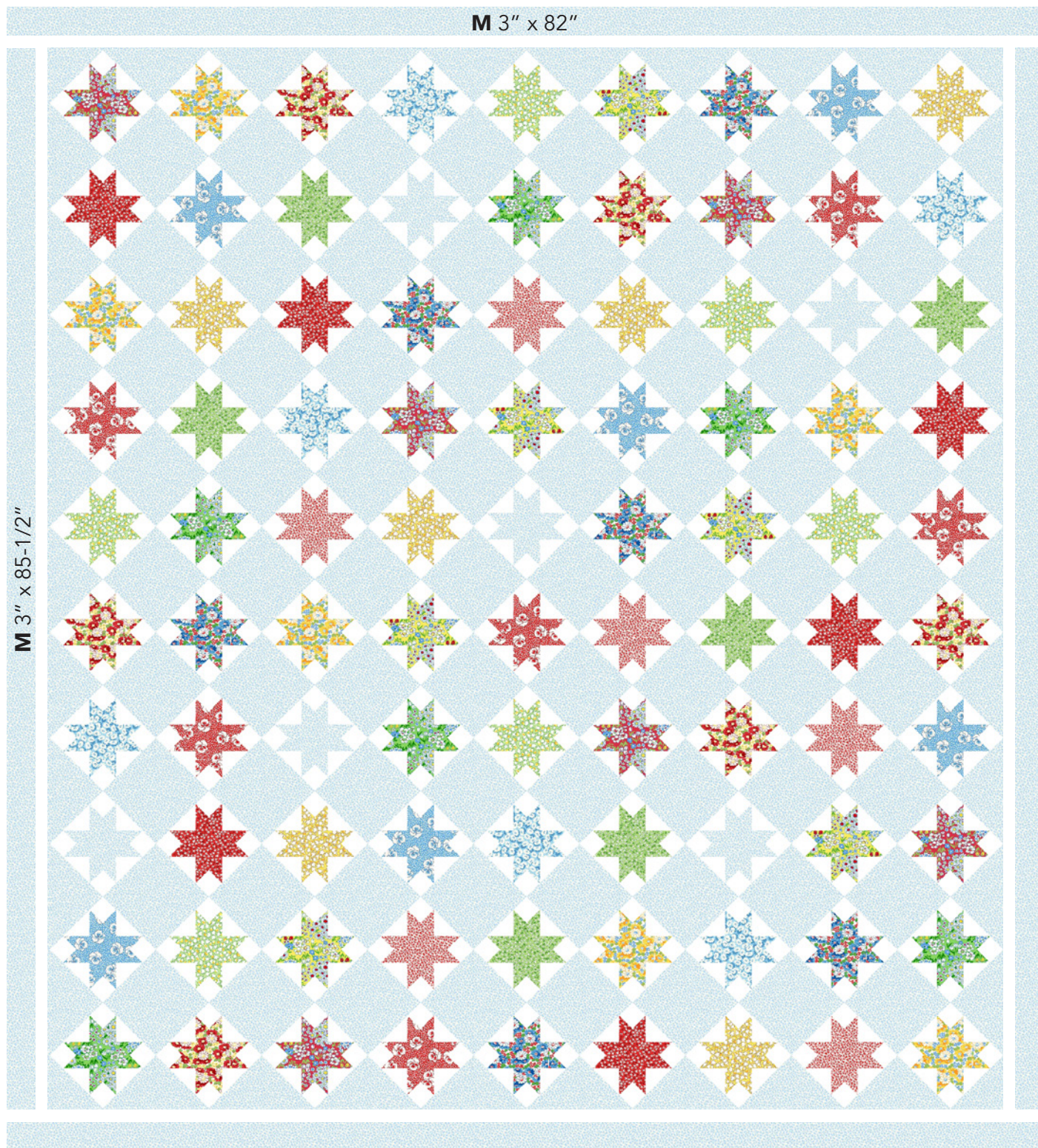




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BORDER ASSEMBLY

6. Sew (1) **M** 3" x 85-1/2" strip to the opposite long sides of quilt center (*trimming excess if necessary*), followed by (1) **M** 3" x 82" strip to top and bottom of quilt center (*trimming excess if necessary*).



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **Q** 2-1/4" strips.
