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## STAR BLOCKS

1. FLYING GEESE UNITS: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) A $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Place (1) square, right side together (RST), at a corner of (1) P $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal (1) A corner triangle. Repeat with another A 2" square at the opposite corner of the same P rectangle. Make (4) AP Flying Geese Units.
2. Add (1) P 2" square to each side of (1) AP Flying Geese Unit. Make 2, set aside.
3. Sew (1) AP Flying Geese Unit to the opposite sides of (1) A 3-1/2" square to make center row. Note proper rotation of Flying Geese Units. Add AP/P unit to top and bottom of Center Row. Trim block to 6-1/2" square.
4. AP STAR BLOCK
5. AP FLYING GEESE UNIT

4. Repeat steps 1-3 to make (6) of each Star Block below, using A-O 2" squares:


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## QUILT ASSEMBLY

5. Follow Quilt Diagram to assemble AP-OP Star Blocks, M 6-1/2" squares, M 9-3/4" Side Setting Triangles and $\mathbf{M} 5-1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Corner Triangles into diagonal rows to complete quilt center. Quilt Top should measure around $76-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 85-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ from raw edge to raw edge.


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## BORDER ASSEMBLY

6. Sew (1) M $3^{\prime \prime} \times 85-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the opposite long sides of quilt center (trimming excess if necessary), followed by (1) M 3" $\times 82^{\prime \prime}$ strip to top and bottom of quilt center (trimming excess if necessary).


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
