Fabric Picture	Quantity	Fabric Number	Placement of Fabric	Cutting
	2 yards	40064-1 Navy	Outer Border Blocks	Cut four 7" <u>lengthwise</u> strips. Recut into two 65 7/8" for sides and two 64" for top and bottom. Fussy cut six 7 7/8" squares.
	3/4 yard	40067-3 Coral	Inner Border	Cut six 3 ½" strips. Make two 51" long pieces for sides and two 59 7/8" pieces for top and bottom.
	1/2 yard	40064-2 Aqua	Block Centers	Fussy cut six 7 7/8" squares.
	1/2 yard	40065-1 Navy	Block Corners	Cut two 6 1/8" strips. Recut into twelve squares. Cut diagonally once.
	1/2 yard	40065-2 Aqua	Block Corners	Cut two 6 1/8" strips. Recut into twelve squares. Cut diagonally once.
			Background	Cut two 11" strips. Recut into six squares.
6.2.8	2 yards	40068-3 Coral	Large Setting Triangles	Cut three 16" strips. Recut into five 16" squares. Cut diagonally once.
			Small Setting Corners	From remainder cut two 8 1/4" squares. Cut once diagonally.
	5/8 yard	40066-2 Aqua	Binding	Cut seven 2 ¹ /4" strips. Sew together with diagonal seams.
	4 yards	40066-1 Navy	Backing	Make two 2 yard pieces. Sew together at selvages. Seam will run horizontal to the quilt top.



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Before You Start

- Success with this pattern starts with reading the directions through to the end!
- If you have any questions about the processes suggested here, check first with your local quilt shop. Look on line for helpful videos.
- Cut fabric strips across the width of the fabric unless otherwise indicated.
- Now is the time to accurately cut, sew with a ¹/₄" seam allowance, press diligently and be patient and enjoy each step in the creation of this design.
- This pattern may have some fabric leftover. (Not always a bad thing!)
- Flannel fabrics are thick. We suggest pressing seams open to avoid bulky intersections!
- To minimize stretching of the diagonal cuts of the coral setting triangles we use spray starch before cutting.

Assembly Directions

- Fussy cut all block centers. Sew a block corner to each side to make an 11" unfinished block. Refer to picture for correct fabric placement.
- 2. We will make diagonal rows alternating a pieced block with a coral background square. They will begin with either a small corner triangle or a large setting triangle. It will help you to use a design wall for correct placement. Lay out the entire quilt before sewing a row together.
- 3. Join the rows together to make quilt top center.
- 4. Sew the side inner border pieces to the quilt top. Then add the top and bottom inner border pieces.
- 5. Sew the side outer border pieces to the quilt top. Then add the top and bottom outer border pieces.
- 6. Make quilt sandwich and quilt as desired, bind and cuddle up!

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
