


Please note: Fabrics B, C and D are directional. Refer to the cutting diagrams on pg 2 to ensure you cut the pieces correctly








Piecing Instructions

Layer a **B** and **E** 5" x 7" rectangle right sides up and cut in half diagonally from lower left to upper right. Sew a **B** and **E** triangle together along the cut line and press seam toward the brown. Repeat with the remaining B and E rectangles, cutting from upper left to lower right to create a mirror image unit. Trim units to measure $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ ".



Using the 3" squares of **J** and **C**, make 1 Pinwheel Block. Noting orientation of the stripe, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a **C** square from lower left to upper right. Pair with a **J** square, right sides together, and sew ¼" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line and press seams toward the J fabric. Repeat with the remaining **J** and **C** squares, drawing a diagonal line from upper left to lower right. Trim HSTs to measure 2 ½" square. Noting orientation of the **C** fabric, sew the HSTs into 2 pairs and press seams open. Sew pairs together, matching center seam, and press seam open to complete the Pinwheel Block.



From the **B** $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and 2 of the **E** $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares, make 1 Flying Geese Block. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of both **E** squares. Lay one square on one end of the **B** rectangle, right sides together. Sew on the drawn line, then trim corner off, approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ " away from seam. Press triangle out.




Repeat for other side.





Repeat this process for the smaller Flying Geese block, using the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **B** rectangle and the (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **E** squares.


To assemble your barn, begin by sewing the **D** 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top of **C** 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Then sew the 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **D** rectangles to either side to make the barn bottom. Press away from center.



Assemble the roof and sky by first, sewing the $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " **B** rectangle to the bottom of the Pinwheel Block. Then add the $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " **B** rectangles to both sides.

Sew then, to both sides of this unit, the **B** and **E** pieced rectangles.

Sew the $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " **E** squares and the large Flying Geese block into a row. Sew this row to the top of the previous unit.



Sew the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **E** rectangle to the top of the small Flying Geese block. Attach this unit to the top of the 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " **D** rectangle.


Sew this unit to the right side of the barn to complete the quilt center.

Add the 1 ½" **H** strips to the sides, then top and bottom for the first border.

Next, sew 2 rows of 6 $\bf J$ and 6 $\bf l$ 2 1/2" squares, alternating colors.

Sew these to the sides of the quilt with the **J** at the top. Then sew a row of 7 **I** and 6 **J** for the top and a row of 7 **J** and 6 **I** for the bottom. Sew to quilt.






Add the **B** borders, starting with the $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $28 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the sides and the then the $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $30 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the top and bottom. Your quilt should now be square.

To make the blocks, begin by making HSTs using the (24) 2" $\bf C$ square and the 2" $\bf H$, $\bf I$ and $\bf J$ squares. Using the same method as for the Pinwheel Block HSTs, draw a diagonal line from lower $\bf 5$



left to upper right on (12) **C** squares and from upper left to lower right on the remaining (12) **C** squares. Pair (4) of each H, I and J squares with marked squares from lower left to upper right, and (4) each with the marked squares from upper left to lower right.



Match the fabrics for Blocks as follows:

G: **H** Half Square Triangles A: I Half Square Triangles F: J Half Square Triangles



Sew a 1 ½" x 4 ½" C rectangle to opposite sides of the 4 ½" focal print, noting orientation of the C stripes as shown.

Sew HSTs to both ends of (2) 1 ½" x 4 ½" C rectangles, noting orientation of the C stripes in all pieces.



Sew to previous unit to make blocks. Blocks should measure 6 1/2". Make 12 blocks total.



Arrange blocks around quilt center as desired, alternating with the 6 ½" light background

squares. Sew into rows for the sides:



And for the top and bottom:



Sew these rows to the sides first, then the top and bottom.



Sew the (3) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 36" lengthwise **B** strips short ends together into one long strip (stripe on fabric should run length of strip). Measure the quilt from top to bottom and cut (2) strips to this length. Sew to the sides of the quilt. Sew the (3) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 31" **B** strips short ends together into one long strip (stripe on fabric should run width of strip). Measure the quilt from side top side, including the borders just added. Cut (2) strips to this length and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Repeat this process with the A 5 ½" x WOF Outer Border strips.

Quilt and bind using (6) 2 ½" x WOF J strips.
