
- **1.** Block A is assembled using log cabin techniques. When piecing Block A, press all seams outward toward the last sewn rectangle. Begin piecing Block A using the Block A diagrams shown and the fabric and size order listed below and on Page 3:
- **a.** Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** rectangle and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric F** rectangle together lengthwise.
- **b.** (1) 2½" x 4½" **Fabric F** rectangle
- **c.** (1) 2½" x 10½" **Fabric A** rectangle
- **d.** (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** rectangle
- **e.** (1) 2½" x 12½" **Fabric G** rectangle
- **f.** (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric G** rectangle
- **g.** (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** rectangle
- **h.** (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** rectangle
- i. (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H rectangle



- **3.** Block B is assembled using log cabin techniques. When piecing Block B, press all seams inward toward the small rectangles (2½" x 4½" **Fabric A** rectangles and 2½" x 8½" **Fabric C** rectangles). Begin piecing Block B using the Block B diagrams shown and the fabric and size order listed below and in the diagram on Page 4:
- a. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** rectangle and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric C** rectangle together lengthwise.
- **b.** (1) 21/2" x 41/2" **Fabric A** rectangle
- **c.** (1) 2½" x 10½" **Fabric D** rectangle
- **d.** (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric D** rectangle
- **e.** (1) 2½" x 12½" **Fabric A** rectangle
- **f.** (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** rectangle
- g. (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E rectangle
- **h.** (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric E** rectangle





Quilt Assembly

5. The quilt top is assembled in a 2 x 2 block grid. Sew together the quilt top, according to the Quilt Layout Diagram on Page 5, alternating between Blocks A and B. Before sewing, ensure that blocks are oriented correctly.

Finishing

- **6.** With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich.
- 7. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired.
- 8. Bind with Fabric H to finish quilt.
