
BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- **1.** Trace the Large Butterfly Placement Pattern to (6) **G** 7-1/2" squares. Trace the Large Butterfly Placement Pattern reversed to (6) **G** 7-1/2" squares.
- **2.** Trace the Small Butterfly Placement Pattern to (7) **E** 7-1/2" squares. Trace the Small Butterfly Placement Pattern reversed to (5) **E** 7-1/2" squares.











- 3. Using your preferred method of appliqué, prepare the appliqué pieces.
- **4.** Pin, baste or fuse (1) **D** Large Hind Wing and (1) **D** Large Hind Wing reversed to position on (1) **G** 7-1/2" square. Sew in place along the outer edges.
- **5.** Pin, baste or fuse (1) **C** Large Fore Wing and (1) **C** Large Fore Wing reversed to position. Sew in place along the outer edges.
- **6.** Pin, baste or fuse (1) **M** body between the wings. Sew in place along the edge. Embroider the antennae using matching thread or embroidery floss to make (1) large butterfly block 1. Make 2.
- 7. Following steps 4-6, make 2 large butterfy blocks using (2) G 7-1/2" squares with pattern reversed.




8. Following steps 4-7, make large butterfly blocks using the fabrics shown. Make the number indicated.





- **9.** Pin, baste or fuse (1) **B** Small Hind Wing, (1) **B** Small Hind Wing, (1) **I** Small Hind Wing and (1) **I** Small Hind Wing, reversed to position on (1) **E** 7-1/2" square. Sew in place along the outer edges.
- **10.** Pin, baste or fuse (1) I Small Fore Wing, (1) I Small Fore Wing reversed, (1) H Small Fore Wing and (1) I Small Fore Wing reversed to position. Sew in place along the outer edges.
- **11.** Pin, baste or fuse (1) **L** body between the wings of the lower butterfly and (1) **M** body between the wings of the upper butterfly. Sew in place along the edge. Embroider the antennae using matching thread or embroidery floss to make (1) small butterfly block 1. Make 3.






12. Following steps 9-11, make make small butterfly blocks and butterfly blocks reversed using the fabrics shown. Make the number indicated.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

- **13.** Following the Quilt Layout on page 5, arrange (6) large butterfly blocks, (6) large butterfly blocks reversed, (7) small butterfly blocks and (5) small butterfly blocks reversed in (4) vertical rows of (5) blocks each. Sew the blocks in each row together. Make 4.
- **14.** Sew together (5) \mathbf{F} 2" x 42-1/2" strips alternating with (4) block rows. Sew (2) \mathbf{F} 2" x 36" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.
- **15.** Sew (1) **J** 1-1/2" \times 45-1/2" border to each side of the quilt. Sew (2) **J** 1-1/2" \times 38" borders to top and bottom of the quilt.
- **16.** Sew (1) **A** 4" x 47-1/2" border to each side of the quilt. Sew (2) **A** 4" x 45" borders to top and bottom of the quilt.




17. Sew (1) **G** 2" \times 54-1/2" border to each side of the quilt. Sew (2) **G** 2" \times 49-1/2" borders to top and bottom of the quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **D** 2-1/4" strips.






