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## Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A: Red

- Cut two 2" $x$ width of fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-five 2" squares.

Fabric B: Vine - Yellow/White

- Cut four $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric C: Tossed Daisies - Green

- Cut six $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into seven $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric D: Dot Flowers - Lilac

- Cut eight $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric E: Tossed Daisies - Blue

- Cut nine $1 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $4 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric F: Vine - Blue/White

- Cut four $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-four $1 \frac{1}{1 \prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric G: Tossed Daisies - Lilac

- Cut five $1 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-four $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into six $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric H: Vine - Green/White

- Cut seven $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-four $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into seven $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric I: Large Bouquet - Yellow

- Cut nine $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-four $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric J: Large Bouquet - Red

- Cut one $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric K: Flower Clusters - Yellow

- Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.


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## Cutting Instructions - Continued:

Fabric L: Flower Clusters - Lilac

- Cut one $4 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into four $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric M: Dot Flowers - Red

- Cut one $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric N: Flower Clusters - Red

- Cut one $4 \underline{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric O: Packed Flowers - Blue

- Cut one $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric P: Large Bouquet - Blue

- Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric Q: Vine - Red/White

- Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric R: Dot Flowers - Yellow

- Cut one $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into three $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric S: White

- Cut four $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 67^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut three $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut fourteen $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into seventy $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut ten $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into seventy $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut seven $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into seventy $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut four $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2 \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into seventy $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.


## Fabric T: Dark Blue

- Cut seven $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

Backing: Dot Flowers - Blue
-Cut two $88 "$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to $68 " \times 88^{\prime \prime}$ for the pieced back.

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## Block Assembly:

1. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $S$ strip to each side of one $2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $B$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make one AB block (Fig. 1).
2. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $S$ strip to each side of the $A B$ block. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the AB block (Fig. 2).
3. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $S$ strip to each side of the $A B$ block. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the AB block (Fig. 3).
4. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $S$ strip to each side of the $A B$ block. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $E$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the AB block (Fig. 4) to make one Block One.
5. Repeat Steps 1-4 to make eighteen Block Ones total.

6. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $S$ strip to each side of one $2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A square. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make one AF block (Fig. 5).
7. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $S$ strip to each side of the AF block. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the AF block (Fig. 6).

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8. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $S$ strip to each side of the AF block. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the AF block (Fig. 7).
9. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $S$ strip to each side of the AF block. Sew one $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the AF block (Fig. 8) to make one Block Two.
10. Repeat Steps 6-9 to make seventeen Block Twos total.

## Quilt Assembly - Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top:

11. Sew three Block Ones and two Block Twos together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three, Five and Seven. Pay attention to the orientation of the blocks.
12. Sew three Block Twos and two Block Ones together, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Rows Four and Six. Pay attention to the orientation of the blocks.
13. Sew the seven rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
14. Sew one $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 67^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $S$ strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $S$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
15. Sew eighteen assorted $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares together to make one strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top.
16. Sew fifteen assorted $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares together to make one strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
17. Layer and quilt as desired.

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18. Sew the seven $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric T strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
19. Bind as desired.
