

Cutting Instructions

From the gold cut 58 - 27/8" squares for Half Square Triangles

From each of the 12 fabrics, cut:

- 1-2.7/8" strip; cut into 5-2.7/8" squares for Half Square Triangles.
- $2 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips

Plan the order of your gray strips. The cutting will depend on the strip's location.

Beginning with Row 1 at the top, cut the 2 ½" strip into the following lengths:

- Row 1: 4 1/2" 14 1/2" 14 1/2"
- Row 2: 2 1/2" 4 1/2" 8 1/2" 4 1/2" 8 1/2" 2 1/2"
- Row 3: 8 1/2" 4 1/2" 8 1/2" 4 1/2" 4 1/2"
- Row 4: 2 ½" 8 ½" 4 ½" 8 ½" 4 ½" 2 ½"
- Row 5: 4 1/2" 4 1/2" 8 1/2" 4 1/2" 8 1/2"
- Row 6: see row 2
- Row 7: see row 3
- Row 8: see row 4
- Row 9: see row 5
- Row 10: see row 2
- Row 11: see row 3
- Row 12: see row 4
- Row 13: see row 5
- Row 14: see row 2
- Row 15: see row 3
- Row 16: see row 4
- Row 17: see row 5
- Row 18: see row 2
- Row 19: see row 3

From the Border 1 fabric, cut $5 - 1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Border 2 fabric, cut $5 - 1\frac{1}{4}$ " strips.

From the Border 3 fabric, cut $4 - 4\frac{1}{2}$ " LENTHWISE strips.


From binding cut $6 - 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.





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Piecing Instructions

Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of all your gold 2 7/8" squares. Pair each of them with a gray 2 7/8" square. Make Half Square Triangles by sewing 1/4" on both sides of your drawn line. Cut on drawn line and press triangles toward the gray.







Half Square Triangles should measure 2 ½" unfinished. Trim if needed.

Using the photo and the listed rows from cutting, piece your Half Square Triangles and gray strips, matching the gray in each row. Press seams away from the Half Square Triangles.

Sew rows together to complete quilt center.

I suggest sewing all three borders together into one pieced strip and mitering the whole thing at once. If you prefer to do them individually that is ok but making the strip set first saves a lot of time.

Cut one of your Border 1 strips into 4 equal lengths. Sew one piece to the end of each of the other 4 Border 1 strips.

Cut one of your Border 2 strips into 4 equal lengths. Repeat the process above to make 4 Border 2 strips.

Make 4 strip sets of a Border 1, Border 2 and Border 3 strips. Center the shorter strips on the longer ones.

Using your preferred method, attach the borders to your quilt center, mitering the corners and matching the seam lines.

Quilt as desired, bind and enjoy!
