


NOTE: Mark and store cutting pieces according to the block they have been assigned to. This will ease piecing. Read the entire pattern before you begin. Appliqué technique required.

Piece the remaining (3) strips and subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" strips.</p> <p>INNER BORDER 2 (26) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (416) 2-1/2" squares.</p> <p>INNER BORDER 3 (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" strips.</p>



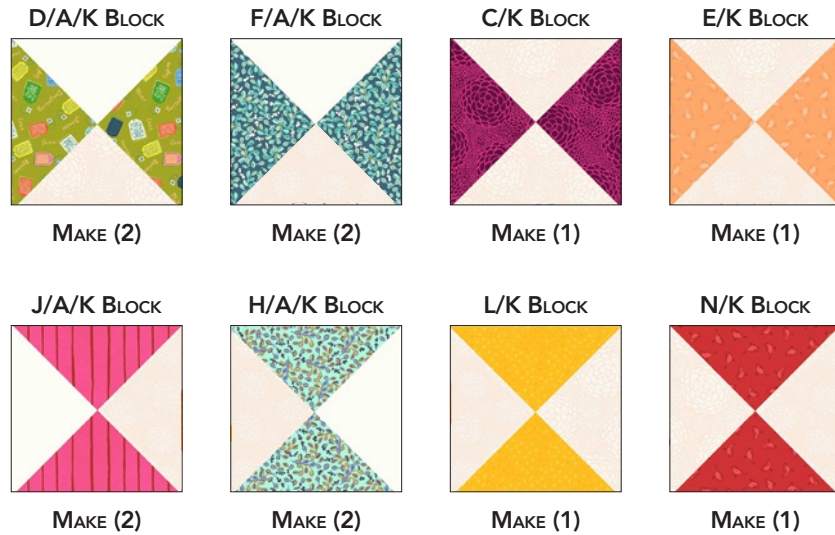

QUILT CENTER PIECED BLOCKS

1. Arrange and sew together (4) QST to complete (1) pieced block. Make a total number of blocks for each fabric combination, as shown. Square to 8-1/2".



INNER BORDER 2 PIECED BLOCKS

2. **Corner Triangles:** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2-1/2" **A** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) **F** 4-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat with (3) additional **A** 2-1/2" squares for the remaining corners of the same **F** square.



3. Repeat Step 2 to make the total number of pieced blocks indicated for the following <prints>:

(12) blocks: **E**

(11) blocks: **D, I, J**

(10) blocks: **F, H, O**

(9) blocks: **L, N**

(6) blocks: **C**

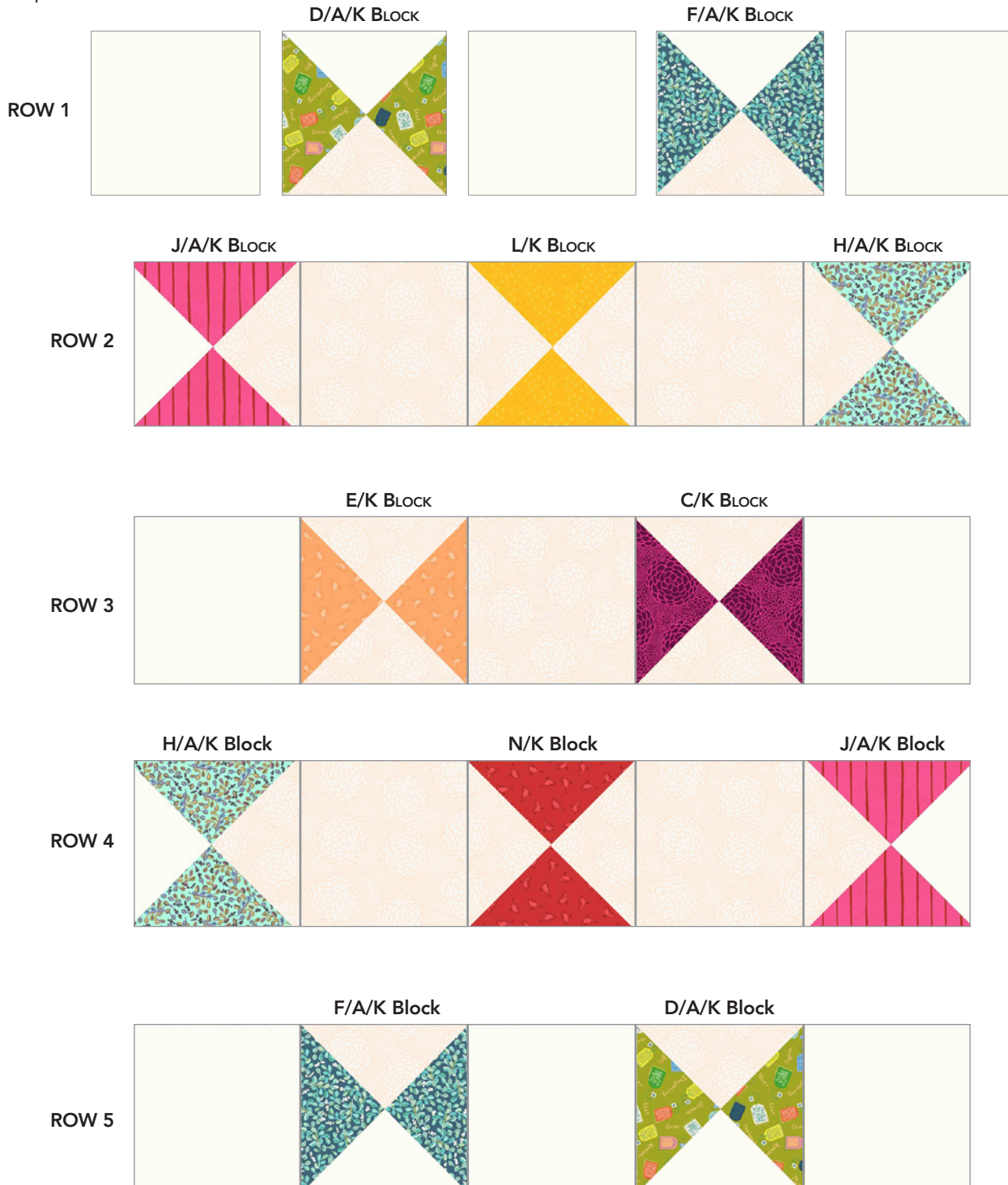
(5) blocks: **M**

QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

4. Pieced Rows: Arrange and sew together a total of (5) Blocks to make a pieced row (pieced and patch blocks, when appropriate). Make (5). Rows are shown below. Sew together pieced rows to complete quilt center.

5. Appliqué: Prepare appliqué pieces using method of choice. Refer to quilt image for placement guide, arrange teapot, teacup and flower appliqué pieces on quilt center and fuse in place. Once pieces are secure, sew pieces in place using appliqué method of choice. **Optional:** Freehand machine stitch the steam lines above both tea cups.



BORDERS

6. Inner Border 1: Sew (2) **A** 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **A** 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.

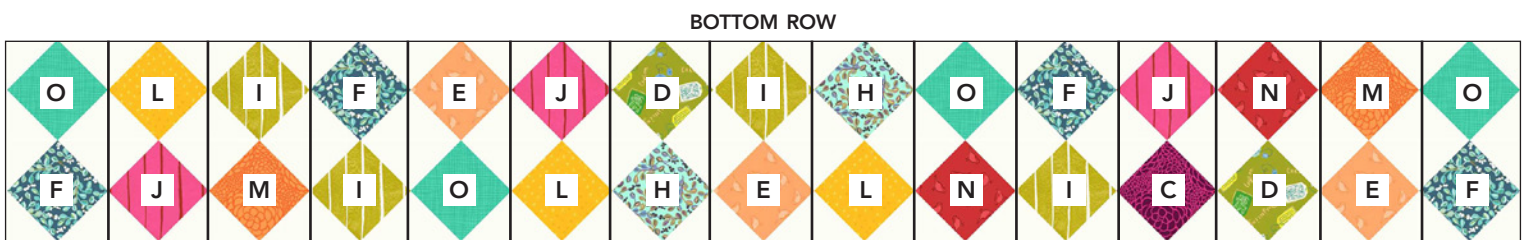
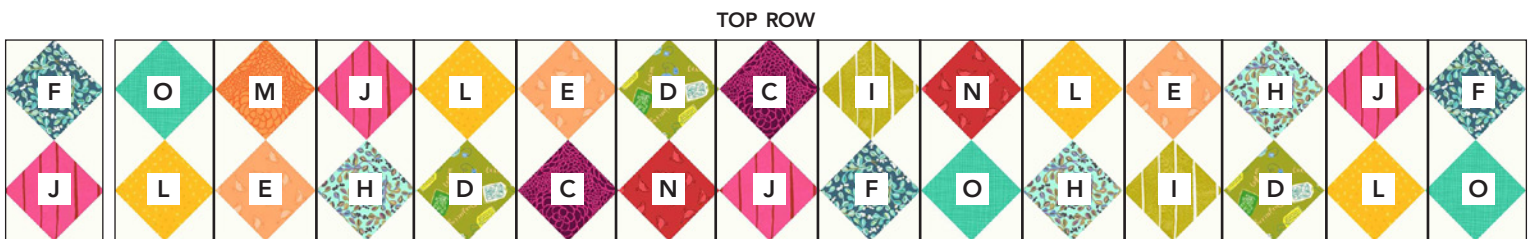
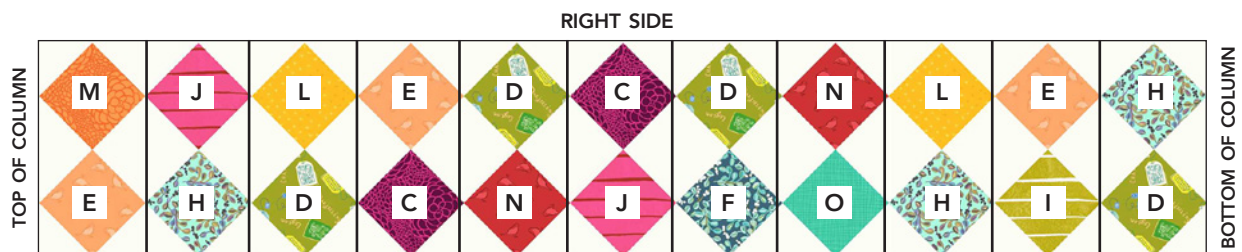
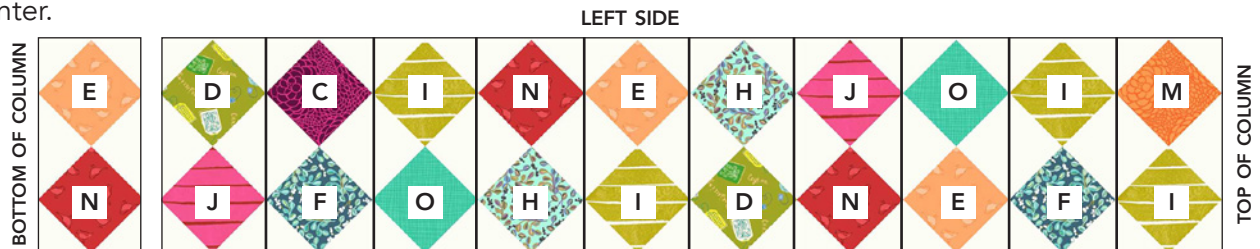

7. Inner Border 2: Arrange and sew together (22) pieced blocks to make a pieced 2x11 column unit. Make (2) column units and sew to the left and right sides of quilt center. Then, arrange and sew together (30) pieced blocks to make a pieced 2x15 row unit. Make (2) row units and sew to top and bottom of quilt center.

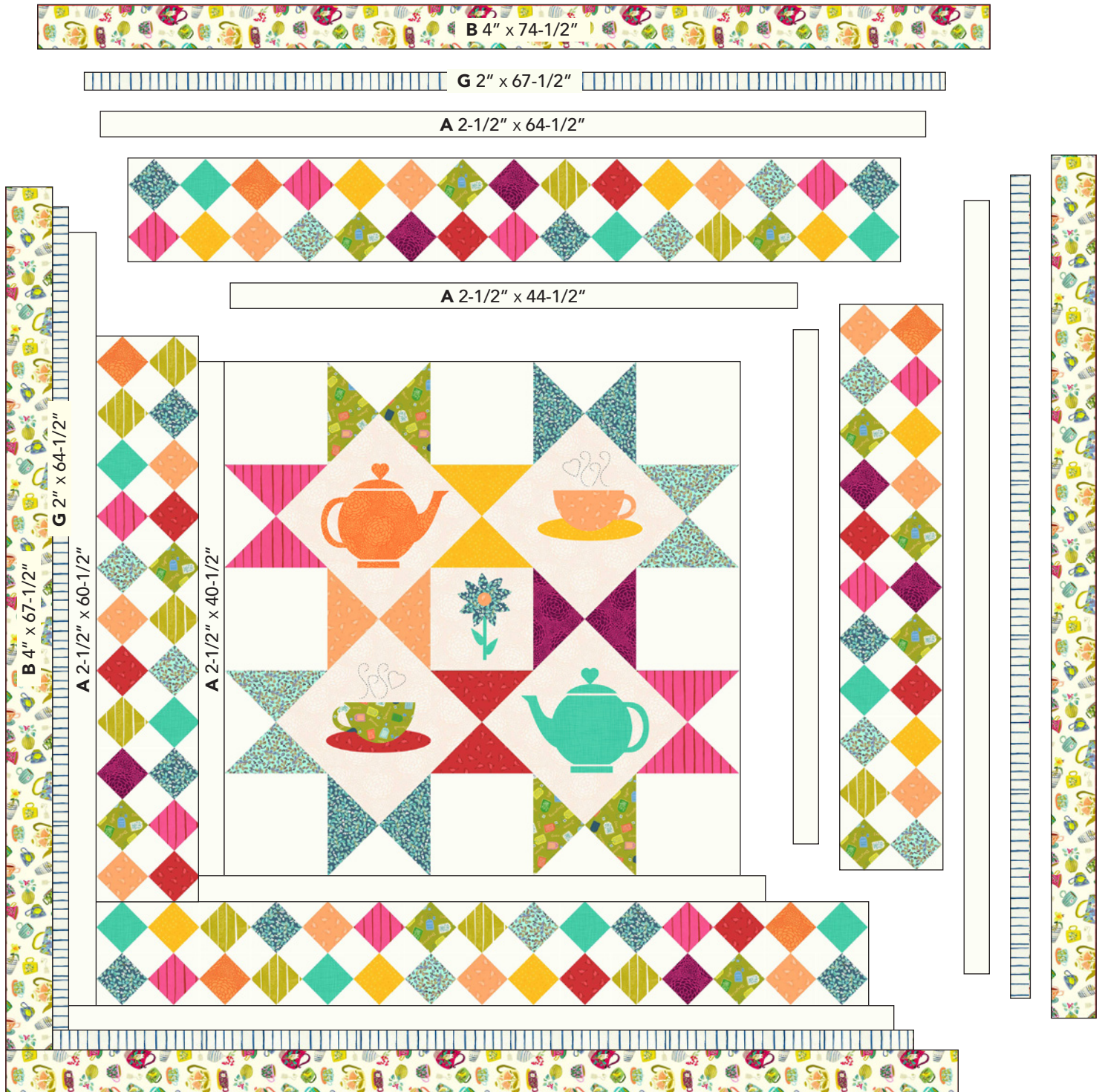


8. Inner Border 3: Sew (2) **A** 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **A** 2-1/2" x 64-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
9. Inner Border 4: Sew (2) **G** 2" x 64-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **G** 2" x 67-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
10. Outer Border: Sew (2) **B** 4" x 67-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **B** 4" x 74-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

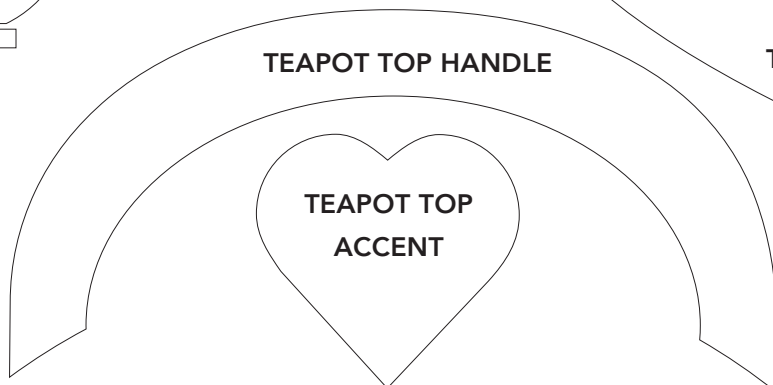

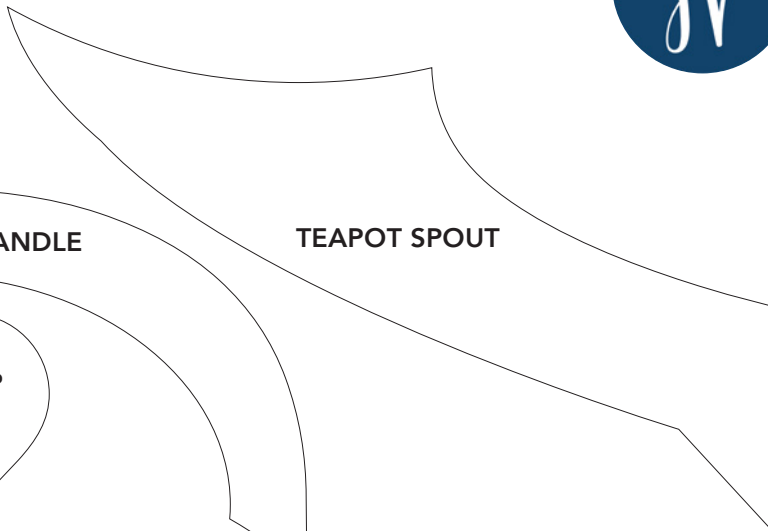
QUILT ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **N 2-1/4"** strips.



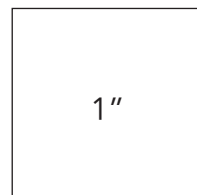
TEAPOT SPOUT



FIVE O'CLOCK TEA TEMPLATE 1

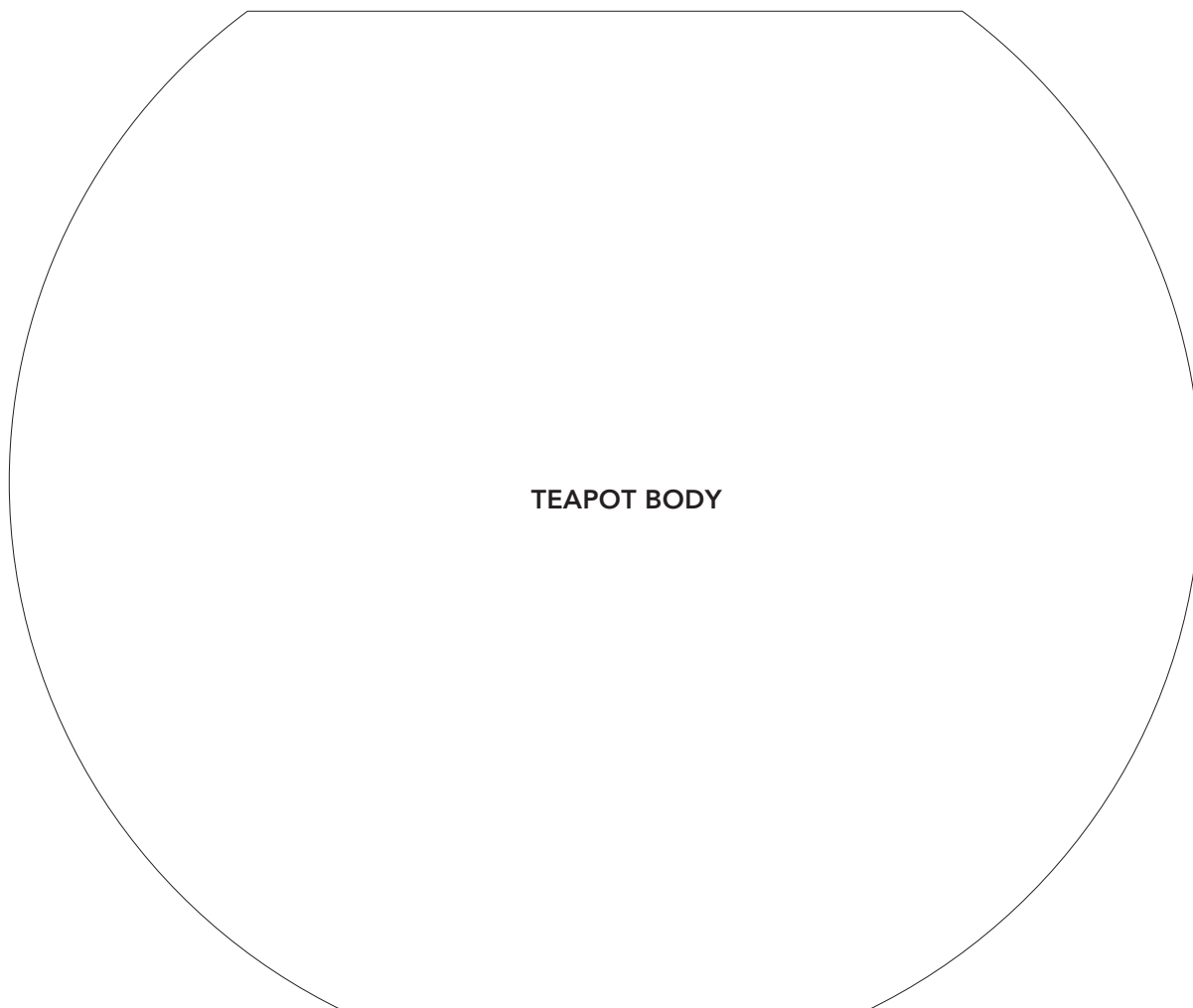


TEAPOT TOP
