


KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
<b>A</b>		51583-5 Shell Pink	1	(2) 10" x WOF strips. Subcut (7) 10" squares and (3) 3" x 9-1/2" rectangles. (3) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (11) 3" x 9-1/2" rectangles.
<b>B</b>		51583-18 Ink	1 1/2	(4) 10" x WOF strips. Subcut (14) 10" squares and (6) 3" x 9-1/2" rectangles. (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 3" x 9-1/2" rectangles.
<b>C</b>		51583-26 Tumeric	3/4	(2) 10" x WOF strips. Subcut (7) 10" squares and (3) 3" x 9-1/2" rectangles. (1) 3" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 3" x 9-1/2" rectangles.
<b>D</b>		51583-3 Delphinium FOR BINDING	1/2	(6) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.
		Backing		57" x 72" piece of batting

**MAKING THE BLOCKS**

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (7) **A** 10" squares. Place a marked square right sides together with (1) **B** 10" square. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line and cut on the line. Press both units open. Trim to measure 9-1/2" square. Make (14) **A-B** units.



2. In the same way, use (7) **C** 10" squares and (7) **B** 10" squares to make (14) **B-C** units.






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## QUILT ASSEMBLY

3. Lay out (2) **A-B** units, (2) **B-C** units, (2) **A** 3" x 9-1/2" rectangles, (2) **B** 3" x 9-1/2" rectangles, and (1) **C** 3" x 9-1/2" rectangle into a row as shown. Sew the units and rectangles together to make a row. Make a total of (7) rows.

4. Sew the (7) rows together to complete the quilt top.

**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **D** 2-1/4" strips.
