## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLES: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 10 " square. Place A square right sides together to (1) B 10" square. Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the drawn line and cut on the line. Press both units open to yield (2) $\mathbf{A B}$ half-square triangle units. Square units to $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Make (14) AB units.
2. Similar to $A B$ unit assembly, make (14) BC half-square triangle units. Square units to 9-1/2".

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

3. Sew together (2) $\mathbf{A B}$ units, (2) $\mathbf{B C}$ units, (2) $\mathbf{A}$, (2) $\mathbf{B}$ and (1) $\mathbf{C} 3^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles into (7) rows as shown. Note proper rotation and placement of $\mathbf{A B}$ and $\mathbf{B C}$ units.
4. Sew the (7) rows together to complete the quilt top. Note proper rotation of rows.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich.
Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using D 2-1/4" strips.
