## FRAMING THE PANELS

1. Sew K 1-1/2" $\times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to opposite sides of the $\mathbf{A}$ winter $13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew K 1-1/2" $\times 15-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom to complete a framed panel.
2. Repeat step 1 for the $\mathbf{A}$ spring rectangle using $\mathbf{N}$ strips, A summer rectangle using $\mathbf{Q}$ strips and $\mathbf{A}$ fall rectangle using J strips.


## PIECING THE BORDERS

3. Lay out the indicated (60) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares into (3) rows of (20) squares each. Sew into rows and join the rows to complete section 1 .

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

NOTE: Refer to the Layout Diagram on p. 5.
8. Sew together Sections 2, 3 and 4, alternating with the winter and spring framed panels to make a panel row. In the same way, sew together Sections 6, 7 and 8, alternating with the fall and summer framed panels.
9. Sew together Section 1, the winter/spring panel row, Section 5, the fall/summer panel row, and Section 9 to complete the quilt top.

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FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using the (6) L 2-1/2" strips.
