FRAMING THE PANELS

- **1.** Sew **K** 1-1/2" x 18-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the **A** winter 13-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangle. Sew **K** 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" strips to the top and bottom to complete a framed panel.
- 2. Repeat step 1 for the A spring rectangle using N strips,A summer rectangle using Q strips and A fall rectangle using J strips.



PIECING THE BORDERS

3. Lay out the indicated (60) 3" squares into (3) rows of (20) squares each. Sew into rows and join the rows to complete section 1.





7. Lay out the indicated (60) 3" squares into (3) rows of (20) squares each. Sew into rows and join the rows to complete section 9.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

NOTE: Refer to the Layout Diagram on p. 5.

- **8.** Sew together Sections 2, 3 and 4, alternating with the winter and spring framed panels to make a panel row. In the same way, sew together Sections 6, 7 and 8, alternating with the fall and summer framed panels.
- **9.** Sew together Section 1, the winter/spring panel row, Section 5, the fall/summer panel row, and Section 9 to complete the quilt top.





FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using the (6) $\bf L$ 2-1/2" strips.
