ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

12" x 22" Pillow inserts

CUTTING:

51111P-X Multi
Cut center panels 12 1/2" high by 21 1/2" wide

Note: in the center you can cut between the panels sections but when you are sewing the pillow together some of the leaves and part of fox tail will be cut off. This does not effect the overall look of the pillow.

51112-1 Persimmon and 51112-2 Pine
Cut (1) each print 16 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle for upper backing
Cut (1) each print 11 1/4" x 12 1/2" rectangle for under backing
Cut (2) each print 1" x 12 1/2" strips for front sides of pillow

SPECIAL NOTE:

Seam allowances are 1/4" except where specified.

ASSEMBLY:

Pillow Face

1. With right sides together, take (1) 1" strip of the print and line up with one end of front pillow panel. Machine stitch, press seams flat toward side. Repeat for the other end. Set aside. Diagram A
Width of pillow face should be 22 1/2".

Back

2. Take 16 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangle of the backing and on one shorter end, fold fabric toward the wrong side 1/4" and press flat. Fold an additional 1" and press flat. Edge stitch open edge. Diagram B
3. Take 11 1/4" x 12 1/2" rectangle and on one short end, fold fabric toward the wrong side 1/4" and press flat. Fold an additional 1/4" and press flat. Edge stitch open edge.
4. With right sides facing down, overlap the small piece on top of the larger piece so that the final length is 22 1/2". Pin the sides together to hold in place. The overlap is approximately 3".
5. Add an edge stitch on each end to hold the overlaped sections in place. Diagram C
6. With right sides together, sew all around the outside. Clip seam allowance at corners, turn and press.
7. Insert pillow stuffer and repeat for the other pillow.

Special Note: Since you are using the center of the panel and not the blocks around the outside, please see our mini mat pattern and make some cute table accessories to go with your pillows.
