A		37098-56 Cloud	6-1/4	CORNER UNIT IN PIECED BLOCKS: (11) 3-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (120) 3-1/2" squares. (12) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (240) 2" squares. (11) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (120) 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles. MIDDLE UNITS IN PIECED BLOCKS: (12) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (240) 2" squares. BLOCK CENTERS IN PIECED BLOCKS: (3) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (60) 2" squares. (8) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (60) 2" x 5" rectangles. SASHING RECTANGLES: (2) 14" x WOF strips; subcut (24) 2-1/2" x 14" rectangles. SASHING STRIPS: (10) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips together in pairs and subcut (5) 2-1/2" x 76" strips. OUTER BORDER: (9) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips together and subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 91-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 82" strips.

CORNER UNITS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) A 3-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together (RST), on (1) 3-1/2" x 5" **print** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat using (1) A 2" square at the diagonally opposite corner of the same **print** rectangle.











2. Similar to Step 1, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" **print** square. Place square, RST, on (1) A 2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **print** corner triangle. Add (1) A 2" square to the left of the sewn unit.






3. Sew units made in **Steps 1-2** as shown below to complete (1) **Corner Unit**. Make (2). Repeat to make (2) mirror-image corner units. Square to 5".



Make (2) of each

MIDDLE UNITS

4. In the same manner as in Step 1 add (2) each A and B 2" squares to (1) 5" print square, noting color placement, to complete (1) snowball middle unit. Make (4), squaring to 5".




BLOCK CENTER

5. Repeat Step 1 using (2) 2" print squares and (1) A 2" x 5" rectangle to complete (1) row unit, as shown below. Make (2).




6. Sew (2) A 2" squares to the opposite sides of (1) 2" print square to make a Square Row Unit.






7. Sew together Row Units made in Steps 5 and 6 to complete Block Center. Square to 5".



8. Sew (2) Middle Units to the opposite sides of Block Center to make a row.

Sew (2) Corner Units to the opposite sides of (1) Middle Unit to make a row. Make (2) rows.

Sew all (3) rows together to complete (1) block, measuring 14" square.



REFER TO QUILT DIAGRAM ON PAGE 5 FOR PLACEMENT.

9. Make (3) Blocks each in the following fabric combinations:


G/D, C/F, L/G, D/H, F/J, I/K, H/C, J/E, K/I and E/L.

QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

10. Pieced Row: Arrange and sew (5) pieced blocks and (4) A 2-1/2" x 14" Sashing Rectangles to make a pieced row, as shown on page 5. Make a total of (6) pieced rows.



11. Sew together pieced rows and (5) A 2-1/2" x 76" Sashing Rectangles to complete Quilt Center. Use Quilt Diagram on page 6 as reference.




BORDER

12. Sew (2) A 3-1/2" x 91-1/2" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) A 3-1/2" x 82" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete Quilt Top.



QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **L** 2-1/4" strips.
