## PANEL BLOCK B

1. Sew (2) H 1-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the left and right sides of (1) B 6-1/2" square to make a row unit.
2. Sew (2) $\mathbf{J} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to the opposite short sides of (1) $\mathbf{H} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to make a row unit. Make (2), and sew to the top and bottom of $\mathbf{B}$ square.
3. Sew (2) H 1-1/2" $\times 8$-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides of Step 2 unit.
4. Sew (2) J 1-1/2" squares to the opposite short sides of (1) H 1-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to make a row unit. Make (2), and sew to the top and bottom of Step 3 unit to complete (1) block. Block measures 10-1/2" square unfinished. Make (3) Panel Block B.
5. Repeat Steps $1-4$ to make an additional (6) Panel Block B using (8) I 1-1/2" squares.

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PANEL BLOCK C
6. Sew (2) I 1-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the left and right sides of (1) C 6-1/2" square to make a row unit.
7. Sew (2) G 1-1/2" squares to the opposite short sides of (1) I $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to make a row unit. Make (2), and sew to the top and bottom of $\mathbf{C}$ square.
8. Sew (2) H $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the left and right sides of Step 7 unit to make a row unit.
9. Sew (2) G 1-1/2" squares to the opposite short sides of (1) $\mathbf{H} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to make a row unit. Make (2) row units and sew to the top and bottom of Step 8 unit to complete (1) Panel Block C, measuring 10-1/2" square unfinished. Make (6).
10. Repeat Steps 6-9 to make an additional (3) Panel Blocks C using (8) J 1-1/2" squares

## HOUSE BLOCKS

11. Sew (3) H 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (2) J 1-1/2" squares to make a row unit.

12. Corner Triangles: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $\mathbf{H} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place marked square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) J 2-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal H corner triangle. Repeat with another H 2-1/2" square at the opposite corner of the same $\mathbf{J}$ rectangle.


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13. Sew (1) F $1^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top and (1) $\mathbf{F} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the bottom of (1) H 1-1/2" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Then add (1) F 1-1/2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to each of the long sides. Make (2).

14. Sew (1) F $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top of (1) H 2-1/2" $\times 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Then sew Step 13 units to the opposite long sides.

15. Sew units from Steps 11,12 , and 14 together to complete house unit. Unit measures $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square unfinished. Add (2) H 1-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the left and right sides of house unit, followed by (2) H 1-1/2" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to the top and bottom of house unit to complete (1) house block. Block measures 10-1/2" square unfinished.


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16. Repeat Steps 11-15 to make (9) House Blocks using fabrics E, G and $\mathbf{H}$

## QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

17. Pieced Rows: Refer to quilt image for block placement guide. Arrange and sew together (5) pieced blocks to make a pieced row. Make (7).

Row 1, 3, 5, 7: (2) House Blocks 1, (3) Panel Blocks
Row 2, 4, 6: (3) House Blocks 2, (2) Panel Blocks
Sew together pieced rows to complete quilt center.

## BORDERS

18. Inner Border 1: Sew (2) H 2" $\times 70-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) H 2" $\times 53-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
19. Inner Border 2: Sew (2) A $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 73-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) A 1-1/2" $\times 55-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
20. Outer Border: Sew (2) D $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 75-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) D 3-1/2" $\times 61-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides to complete quilt top.

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Quilt Top Assembly


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using J 2-1/2" strips.
