


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### **Estimated Fabric Requirements:**

1 yard – 42619-X Multi 1 yard – 42620-X Multi

5 yards - 37098-1 Black



### **Cutting Instructions:**

Fabric A: Golf/Tennis/Baseball – Multi

- Cut one 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square from the golf section (A-1).
- Cut one 16 ½" square from the tennis section A-2).
- Cut one 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square from the yellow baseball section A-3).
- Cut one 16 ½" square from the white baseball section (A-4)

#### Fabric B: Volleyball/Football/Basketball/Soccer – Multi

- Cut one 16 ½" square from the volleyball section (B-1).
- Cut one 16 ½" square from the basketball section (B-2)
- Cut one 16 ½" square from the football section (B-3).
- Cut one 16 ½" square from the soccer section (B-4).

#### Fabric C: Palette – Black

- Cut eight 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 1 ½" x 16 ½" strips.
- Cut eight 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 1 ½" x 18 ½" strips.
- Cut eight 12" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into sixteen 12" x 18 1/2" strips.
- See instructions to cut the assorted letters for the words on the pillows. You will need sixty letters total.



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### Pillow Assembly:

- 1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 3. Refer to Figure 1 to arrange and press the Fabric C letters that spell "SLAM DUNK" onto the  $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B-2 square.
- 4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the B-2 pillow top (Fig. 1).
- 5. Sew one 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the B-2 pillow top. Sew one 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the B-2 pillow top to make the Basketball pillow top (Fig. 2).





- 6. To make the back envelope flaps, turn under the 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ " edge of 12" x 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C piece approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", press, repeat and stitch to make a finished edge on one edge of the 12" x 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C piece. Repeat with a second 12" x 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C piece.
- 7. Position and pin the each back envelope flap, right sides together with the pillow front, overlapping the finished edges in the middle and aligning the raw edges with the pillow front (Fig. 3). Stitch around the pillow front and back to complete the Basketball pillow.

- 8. Turn the pillow right side out.
- 9. Fill the pillow.



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10. Repeat Steps 3-9 and use Figures 4-10 for fabric identification and location to make the remaining seven pillow tops.




