



A		35370S-1 White	1 3/4	For inner border/present blocks: (4) 1 1/2" x WOF. Subcut 18 (1 1/2" x 7 1/2") rectangles. (4) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (36) 2" x 2 1/2" and (18) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (1) 8 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (36) 1" x 8 1/2" rectangles. For inner border/star blocks: (1) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (16) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. (1) 4 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (16) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. For outer border (6) 3 1/2" x WOF. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3 1/2" x 54 1/2" and (2) 3 1/2" x 56 1/2" strips.

E		41641-2	1/4	For inner border/star block: (1) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (8) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. (1) 4 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square.
F		41642-2	1/4	For inner border/present blocks: (1) 5 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (8) 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles.

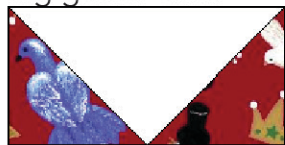


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J		41644-1	5/8	For inner border/present blocks: (1) 5 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (8) 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles. From remaining fabric, cut into 2 1/4" strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.
K		41644-2	1/8	For inner border/present blocks: (1) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (4) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares and (2) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles.
L		41644M-4	1/4	For inner border/present blocks: (1) 1 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (4) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles. (1) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (8) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.
M		41644-5	1/4	For inner border/present blocks: (1) 1 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (4) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles. (1) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (8) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.

Constructing star blocks (using D block as example)

1. Flying geese units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" **D** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" **A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **D** corner triangle. Repeat with (1) additional 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" **D** square at the other corner of the same **A** rectangle to complete 1 flying geese unit.



Repeat to make 4 flying geese units.

2. Sew 2 flying geese units to the opposite sides of (1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" **D** square to make 1 row.



Sew (2) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" **A** squares to the opposite sides of (1) flying geese unit to make a row. Repeat to make 2 rows.





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3. Sew rows together to make 1 star block. Square to 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.



4. Repeat to make a total number of star blocks in the following combinations:

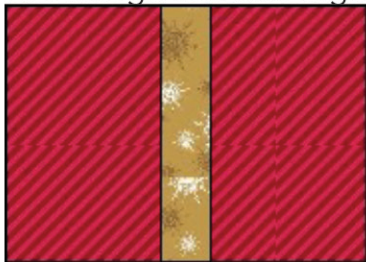
(1): **D/A, E/A, H/A, I/A**

Constructing present blocks (using H/J/A block as example)

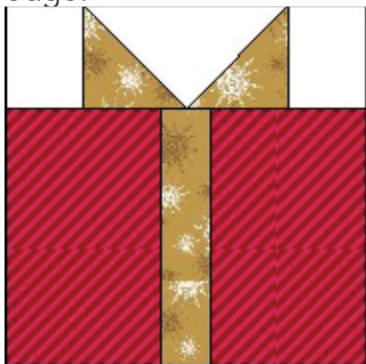
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" **H** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" **A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **H** corner triangle. Repeat with another 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" **H** square at the other end of the same 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" **A** rectangle to complete 1 flying geese unit. Sew (2) 2" x 2 1/2" **A** rectangles to the opposite short sides of the flying geese unit.



2. Arrange and sew together (2) 3 1/2" x 5 1/2" **J** and (1) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" **H** rectangles.



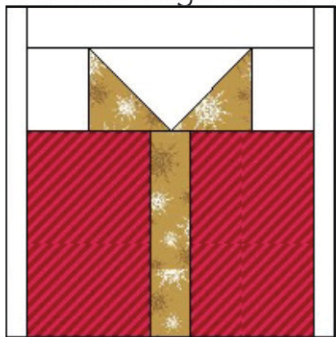
3. Sew sewn units made in steps 1 and 2 together. Square to 7 1/2" x 7 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.





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4. Add to the top of sewn unit made in step 3 (1) $1\frac{1}{2}'' \times 7\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** rectangle, followed by (2) $1'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ **A** rectangles on the left and right sides to complete 1 present block. Square to $8\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ raw edge to raw edge.



5. Repeat to make a total number of blocks in the following combinations:

(4) **H/J/A, M/C/A, G/F/A, L/I/A**

(2) **K/G/A**

Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner border #1. Arrange and sew together (5) present blocks to make a column. Repeat to make 2 identical columns, and add to the opposite long sides of panel center.

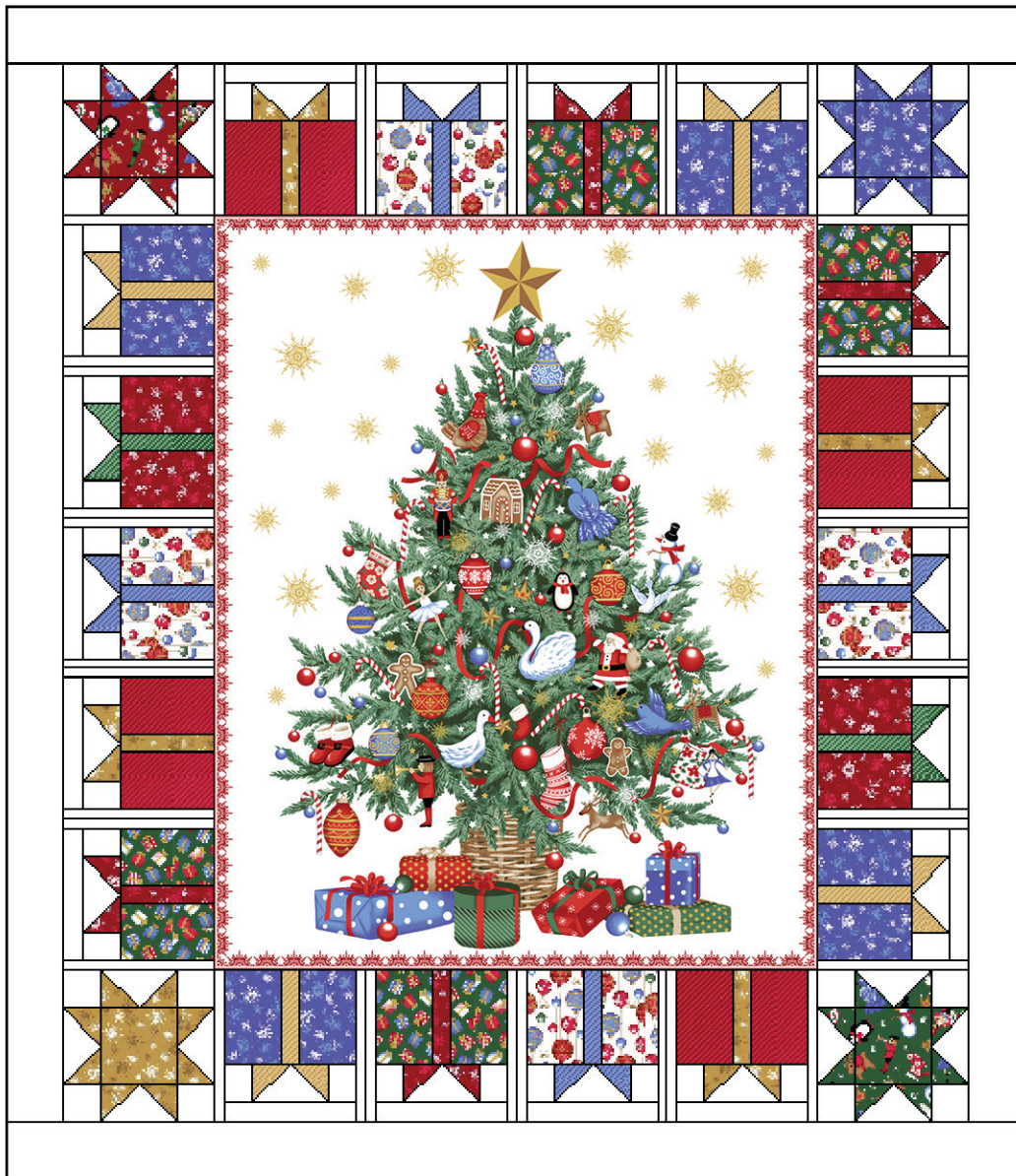


Arrange and sew together (4) present blocks to make a row, followed by (2) star blocks at the opposite short ends. Refer to the following diagram for placement of star blocks. Make a total of 2 pieced rows, and add to the remaining opposite short sides of panel quilt center.



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2. Outer border. Sew (2) 3 1/2" x 56 1/2" **A** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3 1/2" x 54 1/2" **A** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Quilting Instructions

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
