- C. Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric unless otherwise noted.



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Piecing Instructions: (Refer to block diagrams and images for proper placement)


Block 1:

- 1. Sew (1) F 5" square and (1) G 5" square together to create FG Unit, make (14).
- 2. Sew (2) FG Units together to create Block 1. Square to 9-1/2", make (7).


Block 2:

- 3. Sew (1) H 5" square and (1) J 5" square together to create HJ Unit, make (12).
- 4. Sew (2) HJ units together to create Block 2. Square to 9-1/2", make (6).














Assembly Instructions: (Refer to cover image for proper block placement and rotation)

Quilt Assembly:

5. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

Row 1: E - A - 1 - C - 2 - B

Row 2: 2 - C - B - D - E - 1

Row 3: D -1 - E - 2 - A - C

Row 4: E - C - A - E - 1 - D

Row 5: 1 - B - D - C - A - E

Row 6: C - 2 - A - 1 - D - B

Row 7: A - D - E - B - 2 - C

Row 8: 2 - C - 1 - D - E - A

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
