## PIECED BLOCK

1. Half-Square Triangles (HST): Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (200) A $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Place (1) A square, right sides together, on (1) B 3" square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HSTs. Open and press. Make (400). Each HST unit measures 2-1/2" square unfinished.


Draw diagonal line on wrong side of $\mathbf{A}$.


Place $\mathbf{A}$ on $\mathbf{B}$, right sides together.


Sew a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from both sides of solid line. Cut along solid line.


Open and press. Yield (2) HSTs. Make (400) A/B units, measuring 2-1/2" square unfinished.

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NOTE ROTATION AND PLACEMENT OF UNITS.
2. Arrange and sew (3) A/B HST units, followed by (1) B 3" HST.
3. Repeat Step 2 using (2) A/B HST units, followed by (1) B $3^{\prime \prime}$ HST.
4. Sew (1) B 5" HST to the left of Step 3 unit, as shown, followed by Step 2 unit on top.


## QUILT ASSEMBLY

6. Noting rotation and placement, arrange (8) Pieced Blocks to make a row. Make (10).
7. Sew the (10) rows together, using pins to align and nestle seams. Press seams downward. Once complete, the quilt top should measure 64-1/2" x 80-1/2" unfinished.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using C 2-1/4" strips.
