Sewing:

1. Piece the four alternate blocks as shown in Diagram 1 using the four 5-1/2" print squares and the red and green 1-1/2" strips.




Diagram 1: Make 4

2. Use remaining fabrics to foundation piece the coffee cups. Machine applique the coffee cup handles last. Blocks measure 7-1/2" unfinished. Diagrams 2-5 show the number of blocks to make using the various patterns.




Diagram 2: Make 1




Diagram 3: Make 2




Diagram 4: Make 1






- 3. Join the four Alternate Blocks and the five Coffee Cups blocks into the quilt center as shown in the quilt picture. They are sewn block to block. Press seams open for reduced bulk.
- 4. Sew the triple sashings using the gold and cream 1-1/2" x 21-1/2" strips. Sew the four 9 Patch corner blocks using the red and gold 1-1/2" squares. Sew the 9 Patch blocks to the short ends of two border strips. See Quilt Assembly for placement.
- 5. Quilt Center now measures 27-1/2" x 27-1/2". Measure and cut four 4-1/2" border strips to this width and join two to quilt center. Sew a 9 Patch block to a short end of each of the two remaining border strips and add last two borders to quilt.

Finishing:

- 6. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.
- 7. Sew the four 2-1/4" strips of the **H** fabric together into one long strips and use to bind quilt.






Quilt Assembly Diagram

IMPORTANT NOTE: Keep the cup handle free as you TRIM Patch #5 and also as you ADD Patch #10. And make sure, if using fusible webbing, you don't accidently fuse it the entire width of Patch #5 before adding Patch #10. Believe me, I learned this the hard way and still had trouble remembering with each block!
