## CENTER STAR

1. Referring to the diagram for fabric placement guide, make (4) Center Star Quadrants by joining pieces in diagonal rows. Square up to 18-1/2" square, trimming off B triangle sides and leaving 1/4" past star points. CENTER STAR QUADRANT (FABRIC)

2. Arrange and sew (4) Center Star Quadrants to complete the Center Star.

It measures 36-1/2" square.

## INNER BORDER 4 (Star Blocks)

3. Referring to the following diagram for fabric placement guide, construct (4) Star Quadrants.

4. Arrange and sew (4) Star Quadrants to complete (1) Star Block, measuring 10-1/2" square. Make (3) of C/D/J.

5. Using J for the background, make the total number of Star Blocks in the following fabric combinations:

## INNER BORDER 8 (Square Blocks)

6. Block Center: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) I 2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) J 3-1/2" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal I corner triangle. Repeat with additional (3) I 2" squares on the remaining corners of the same $\mathbf{J}$ square, as shown, to complete block center.


Draw diagonal line on wrong side of I square.


Sew on drawn line and trim 1/4" away from sewn line.


Open and press to reveal I corner triangle.


Add three more corner triangles.
7. Flying Geese Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) J $2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) I $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal $\mathbf{J}$ corner triangle. Repeat with another $\mathbf{J}$ square on the opposite corner of the same I rectangle. Make (4).


Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" and open to reveal J corner triangle.

Flying Geese Unit


Make (4) of I/J. Repeat on opposite corner.
8. Half-Square Triangle (HST): Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) J 2-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together on (1) I $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HST units. Open and press. Square to 2" square. Make (4).



Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line.


Make (4) I/J HST units.
Square to $2^{\prime \prime}$
Yields (2)

9. Sew (2) Flying Geese Units to the opposite sides of Block Center to make a row.
10. Sew (2) HSTs to the opposite short sides of (1) Flying Geese Unit to make a row. Make (2) rows.

11. Sew all rows together to complete (1) Square Block as shown below. Square to 6-1/2". Make (5).

12. Using J, make the total number of Square Blocks in the following fabrics:

## BORDERS

13. Inner Border 1: Sew (1) F $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right of quilt center, followed by (1) F $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 38-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the bottom of quilt center.
14. Inner Border 2: Sew (1) E $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 38-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right of quilt center, followed by (1) E 1-1/2" $\times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the bottom of quilt center.
15. Inner Border 3: Sew (1) A $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 39-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right of quilt center, followed by (1) A 1-1/2" $\times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the bottom of quilt center.
16. Inner Border 4 (Star Blocks): Arrange and sew (4) Star Blocks to make a column, and add to the right of quilt center. Arrange and sew (5) Star Blocks to make a row, and add to the bottom of quilt center.

17. Inner Border 5: Sew (1) A 1-1/2" $\times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right of quilt center, followed by (1) A $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the bottom of quilt center.
18. Inner Border 6: Sew (1) E 1-1/2" $\times 51-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right of quilt center, followed by (1) E $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the bottom of quilt center.

19. Inner border 7 : Sew (1) $\mathbf{J} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right of quilt center, followed by (1) $\mathbf{J} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the bottom of quilt center.
20. Inner Border 8 (Square Blocks): Arrange and sew together (9) Square Blocks to make a column. Sew to the right of quilt center. Arrange and sew together (10) Square Blocks to make a row. Sew to the bottom of quilt center.
21. Inner Border 9: Sew (1) $\mathbf{J} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right of quilt center, followed by (1) J $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the bottom of quilt center.
22. Inner Border 10: Sew (1) E 1-1/2" $\times 62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right of quilt center, followed by (1) E $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 63-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the bottom of quilt center.
23. Outer Border: Sew (1) P 7-1/2" $\times 63-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the right of quilt center, followed by (1) $\mathbf{P} 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 70-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using $\mathbf{Q} 2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
