

Α		50252-1 Pink		Cut 4 strips 2 ½" x WOF, subcut 56 – 2 ½" squares. Templates B, C, F, H, I, K
В	7.5	50250-2 White		Fussy cut 4 squares into 3 ½" x 3 ½" (border corners).
С		50253-5 Aqua		Cut 5 strips 3 3/8" x WOF, subcut 112 – 1 ¾" x 3 3/8" rectangles. Cut 2 strips 6 ¾" x WOF, subcut 28 – 1 ½" x 6 ¾" rectangles. Cut 3 strips 2 ¼" x WOF, binding.





- 1. Make 6 copies of the paper piecing pattern, using the 1" square reference to make sure your copy is the correct size. Use the extra copies for practice.
- 2. (Knowledge of paper piecing techniques will be helpful.) Follow diagrams and steps below to create 14 paper pieced units. Each unit will finish at 3 ½" x 6 ½" after trimming.





- **A** Begin by placing a 2 1/2" square on the bottom triangle of the UNPRINTED side of the paper piecing pattern. Pin in place. Fold back on the stitching line and trim a 1/4" seam allowance with the Add A Quarter ruler. Repeat on the other side of the triangle.
- ${\bf B}$  Lining up the edge of a green 1 3/4" x 3 3/8" patch along the edge of the pink triangle. Pin in place. Turn paper to PRINTED side and stitch along the line.
- **C** Finger press (or iron press without steam) to side as shown.
- **D** Fold on lines at side and top and trim seam allowance as shown.













- **E** It should look like this now.
- **F** Repeat on the other side of the triangle.
- **G** Place the next 2 1/2" square along the top of the sewn section as shown. Turn paper over to printed side and stitch along the line. Fold and trim as you did on the first triangle. Repeat the above until all triangles are stitched.
- **H** Line up a 6 3/4" x 1 1/2" rectangle along the edge of the triangle section as shown. Turn paper over and sew along line. Repeat on the other side. Carefully press the block. Turn pieced unit over to the printed side and trim on the outer printed line. Unit should measure 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Trim along the CUT LINE to finish the block.


It should look like the finished block shown below. Make 14.






- 3. Sew 2 sets of 4 border blocks together short end to short end and 2 sets of 3 border blocks together short end to short end. Be sure to make all the arrows go in the same direction!
- 4. The 4 set unit should measure 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". The 3 set unit should measure 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 5. Do the same with each of the 3 sets.
- 6. Add 1-  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " fussy cut square to each end of the 4 set units. Note the direction of the arrows before adding the squares.
- 7. Prepare fabrics for applique using a lightweight double sided fusible if you use the raw edge applique method. For the needle turn applique method cut the templates out of the fabric and add a ¼" seam allowance around each applique template.
- 8. Center the applique on the 26" x 20" Fabric E rectangle. Finish the edges using your chosen method of applique. Trim rectangle to  $24 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $18 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 9. Sew 1 3 set border unit to each side of the applique center noting the direction of the pieced arrows.
- 10. Sew 1 4 set, fussy cut border unit to the top and bottom of applique center noting the direction of the pieced arrows.
- 11. Baste top, batting and backing together and guilt as desired. Trim and bind.
