

A		51689-1 White on White	2-3/8	Blocks: (2) 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (9) 5-1/2" squares. (29) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut (18) 2" x 17-1/2" pieces, (18) 2" x 14-1/2" pieces, (18) 2" x 11-1/2" pieces, and (18) 2" x 8-1/2" pieces. Sashing: (1) 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 5-1/2" squares, (2) 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" pieces and (4) 3-1/2" squares.
В		51691-3 Grey	7/8	Blocks: (11) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 2" x 14-1/2" pieces, (2) 2" x 13" pieces, (9) 2" x 11-1/2" pieces, (9) 2" x 8-1/2" piece, (3) 2" x 7" pieces, (12) 2" x 5-1/2" pieces, (1) 2" x 4-1/2" piece and (1) 1-1/4" x 2" piece.

Borders: (4) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew strips short ends together and subcut (1) 3-1/2" x 61-1/2" strip and (1) 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" strip.


KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
D		51963-3 Grey	2-1/3	Blocks, Borders and Binding: (2) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew strips short ends together and subcut (1) 6-1/2" x 66-1/2" strip. From remainder, subcut (2) 2" x 8-1/2" pieces, (1) 2" x 6-1/2" piece, and (2) 2" x 5-1/2" pieces. (3) 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (5) 5-1/2" x 17-1/2" pieces and (1) 4-1/2" x 17-1/2" piece. (2) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 17-1/2" pieces and (2) 2" x 14-1/2" pieces. (3) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew strips short ends together and subcut (1) 3-1/2" x 61-1/2" strip and (1) 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" strip. (1) 2" x WOF strip. Subcut (2) 2" x 11-1/2" pieces and (1) 2" x 10-1/2" piece. (8) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.


MAKE THE BLOCKS

Note: Blocks are assembled primarily using Couthouse Steps style piecing. Follow the steps for Block #1 as you assemble the remaining blocks, noting the labeled pieces on each block diagram. Feel free to improvise to add additional pieced sections as desired.

1. Sew **D** 2" x 5-1/2" pieces to opposite sides of (1) **A** 5-1/2" square. Sew **D** 2" x 8-1/2" pieces to the top and bottom. Sew **A** 2" x 8-1/2" pieces to the top and bottom and **A** 2" x 11-1/2" pieces to opposite sides.




2. Sew **D** 2" x 11-1/2" pieces to the top and bottom of the unit from step 1. Sew (1) **D** 2" x 14-1/2" piece to the left side and (1) pieced strip to the right side (noting piece sizes in diagram). Sew **A** 2" x 14-1/2" pieces to the top and bottom and **A** 2" x 17-1/2" pieces to opposite sides to complete the 17-1/2" square block #1.






3. Follow the diagrams below and on p. 5-10 to make the remaining (8) blocks, noting variation of piecing order in Blocks 7-9 and size of pieces used to make pieced strips.






Blocks 2, 3 and 4 (Make 3)











QUILT ASSEMBLY

- **4.** Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, lay out blocks 1, 2 and 3 alternating with (1) **D** 5-1/2" x 17-1/2" sashing strip and (1) **D** 4-1/2" x 17-1/2" sashing strip into block row #1. Sew into a row. In the same way, use blocks 4, 5 and 6 to make block row #2.
- **5.** Sew together blocks 7, 8 and 9 alternating with (1) **E** 5-1/2" \times 17-1/2" sashing strip and (1) **D** 4-1/2" \times 17-1/2" sashing strip to make row #3.
- **6.** Sew together sashing row #1 using (3) **D** 5-1/2" x 17-1/2" pieces, (1) **A** 5-1/2" square and (1) **A** 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" piece. Sew together sashing row #2 using (3) **E** 5-1/2" x 17-1/2" pieces, (1) **A** 5-1/2" square and (1) **A** 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" piece.
- 7. Sew the block rows and sashing rows together to complete the quilt center.
- **8.** Sew (1) **C** 3-1/2" \times 61-1/2" strip to the left side of the quilt center and (1) **D** 3-1/2" \times 61-1/2" strip to the right side.
