KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A		51398-1 tan	1/4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (1) 6-1/2" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 6-1/2" squares.
B		51403-3 charcoal	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (4) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips. • (6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. • (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 52-1/2" strips. • (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43-1/2" strips.
C		51400-5 black	1/2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (2) 5-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (15) 5-1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (60) 5-1/4" triangles.
D		51402-2 grey	1/2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (2) 5-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 5-1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) 5-1/4" triangles [only (62) of the triangles will be used.]
E		51400-6 cream	1/2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (2) 5-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 5-1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) 5-1/4" triangles.
F		51399-1 tan	3/8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (2) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into (10) 4-1/2" squares.
G		51402-1 tan	1/2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (2) 5-1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (16) 5-1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) 5-1/4" triangles [only (62) of the triangles will be used.]
H		51401-5 black	3/8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (2) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (10) 4-1/2" squares.
I		51398-4 red	1/4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 6-1/2" squares.
J		51397-1 tan	1-2/3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (2) 4-1/2" x 55-1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips. • From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 4-1/2" x 43-1/2" WOF strips, piecing as needed.
K		51401-4 red	1/4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (1) 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (4) 4-1/2" squares.
L		40171-62 red-orange	1/2	<p>Binding</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

Block Assembly:

1. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **A** 6-1/2" square. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **A** square to make (1) **Block One** square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) **Block One** squares total.

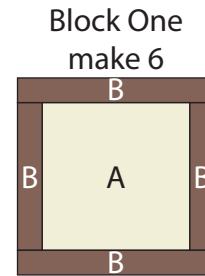

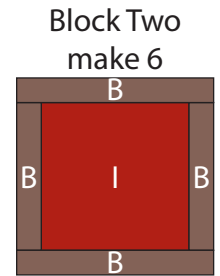

2. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **I** 6-1/2" square. Sew (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **I** square to make (1) **Block Two** square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) **Block Two** squares total.

3. Sew (1) **G** 5-1/4" triangle and (1) **C** 5-1/4" triangle together. Sew (1) **E** 5-1/4" triangle and (1) **D** 5-1/4" triangle together. Sew the (2) new triangles together on the long side to make (1) **Unit 1** square (Fig. 3). The unit should measure 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make (28) **Unit 1** squares total.

4. Repeat **Step 3** and refer to **Figures 4-8** for fabric identification and placement to make (28) 4-1/2" **Unit 2** squares, (2) 4-1/2" **Unit 3** squares, (2) 4-1/2" **Unit 4** squares, (1) 4-1/2" **Unit 5** square and (1) 4-1/2" **Unit 6** square.

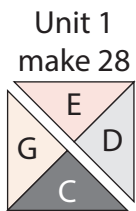

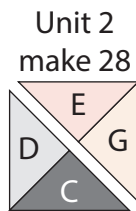

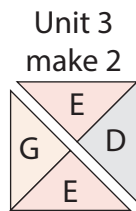

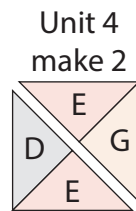

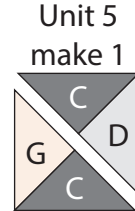

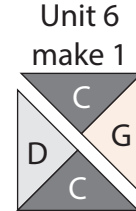

5. Sew (1) **Unit 1** square to the left side of (1) **Unit 2** square along the **D** side to make (1) **Unit 7** strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (28) **Unit 7** strips total.

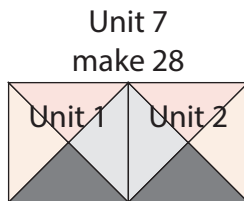

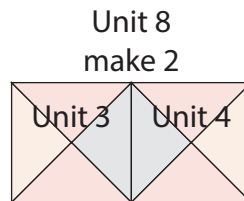

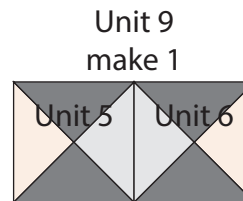

6. Sew (1) **Unit 3** square to the left side of (1) **Unit 4** square along the **D** side to make (1) **Unit 8** strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second **Unit 8** strip.

7. Sew (1) **Unit 5** square to the left side of (1) **Unit 6** square along the **D** side to make (1) **Unit 9** strip (Fig. 11).

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Diagram while assembling the quilt top.)

8. Sew together (1) **F** 4-1/2" square, (1) **Unit 7** strip, (1) **H** 4-1/2" square, (1) **Unit 7** strip, (1) **F** 4-1/2" square, (1) **Unit 7** strip and (1) **H** 4-1/2" square in that order to make **Row One (Fig. 12)**.

9. Repeat **Step 8** and refer to **Figure 12** for component identification, placement and orientation to make **Row Two** through **Row Nine**.

10. Sew the (9) rows together, in numerical order, to make the **Center Block (Fig. 12)**.

11. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 52-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 43-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

12. Sew (1) **J** 4-1/2" x 55-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **K** 4-1/2" square to each end of (1) **J** 4-1/2" x 43-1/2" strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

Finishing

13. Layer and quilt as desired.

14. Sew the (6) **L** 2-1/2" x WOF strips together end-to-end with 45-degree seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

15. Bind as desired.

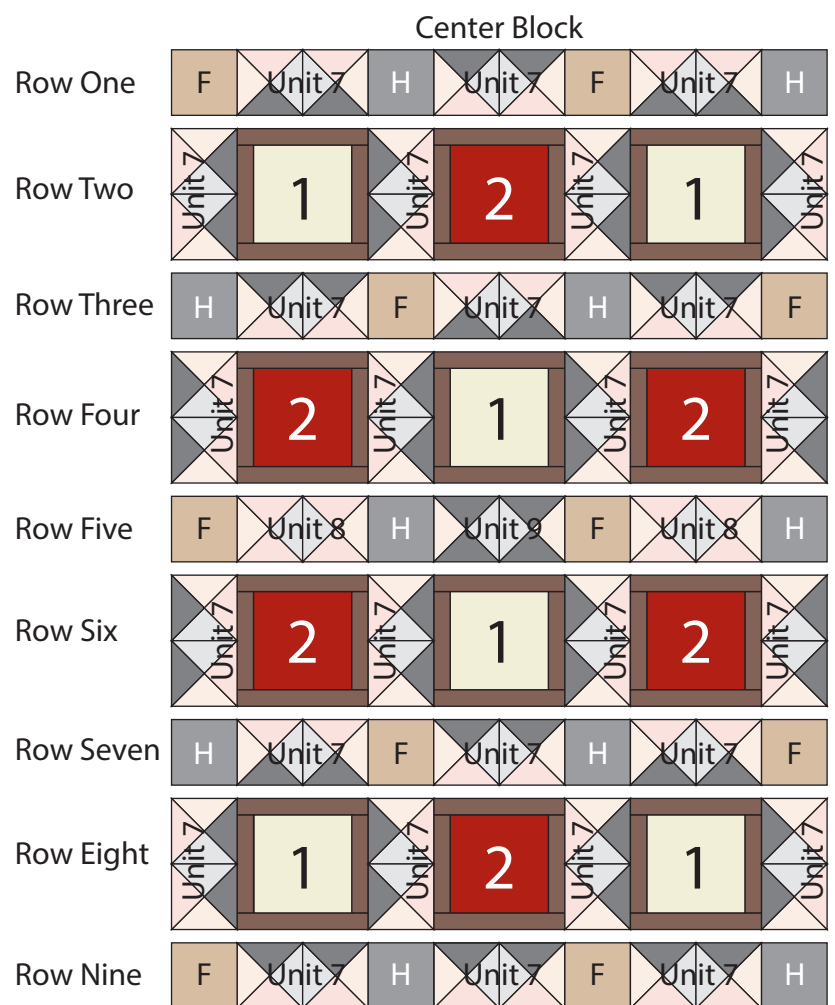
