## Block Assembly:

1. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" $\times 6$-1/2" strip to each side of (1) A 6-1/2" square. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the $\mathbf{A}$ square to make (1) Block One square
(Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.
2. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" $\times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of (1) $\mathbf{I}$ - $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the I square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

3. Sew (1) G 5-1/4" triangle and (1) C 5-1/4" triangle together. Sew (1) E 5-1/4" triangle and (1) D 5-1/4" triangle together. Sew the (2) new triangles together on the long side to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 3). The unit should measure 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make (28) Unit 1 squares total.
4. Repeat Step $\mathbf{3}$ and refer to Figures $\mathbf{4 - 8}$ for fabric identification and placement to make (28) 4-1/2" Unit 2 squares, (2) 4-1/2" Unit 3 squares, (2) 4-1/2" Unit 4 squares, (1) 4-1/2" Unit 5 square and (1) 4-1/2" Unit 6 square.

5. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square along the $\mathbf{D}$ side to make (1) Unit $\mathbf{7}$ strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (28) Unit 7 strips total.
6. Sew (1) Unit $\mathbf{3}$ square to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square along the $\mathbf{D}$ side to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Unit 8 strip.
7. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to the left side of (1) Unit 6 square along the $\mathbf{D}$ side to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 11).

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Diagram while assembling the quilt top.)
8. Sew together (1) F 4-1/2" square, (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) H 4-1/2" square, (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) F $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, (1) Unit 7 strip and (1) H 4-1/2" square in that order to make Row One (Fig. 12).
9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figure 12 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Nine.
10. Sew the (9) rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block (Fig. 12).
11. Sew (1) B $2^{\prime \prime} \times 52-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) B 2" $\times 43-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) J 4-1/2" $\times 55-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) K 4-1/2" square to each end of (1) J 4-1/2" $\times 43-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
