В		51403-3 charcoal	1	<ul> <li>(4) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips.</li> <li>(6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (24) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.</li> <li>(3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 52-1/2" strips.</li> <li>(3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43-1/2" strips.</li> </ul>


#### Block Assembly:

Sew (1) B 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to each side of (1) A 6-1/2" square. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

Sew (1) B 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strip to each side of (1) I 6-1/2" square. Sew (1) B 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the I square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

3. Sew (1) G 5-1/4" triangle and (1) C 5-1/4" triangle together. Sew (1) E 5-1/4" triangle and (1)
D 5-1/4" triangle together. Sew the (2) new triangles together on the long side to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 3). The unit should measure 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make (28) Unit 1 squares total.


**4.** Repeat **Step 3** and refer to **Figures 4-8** for fabric identification and placement to make (28) 4-1/2" Unit 2 squares, (2) 4-1/2" **Unit 3** squares, (2) 4-1/2" **Unit 4** squares, (1) 4-1/2" **Unit 5** square and (1) 4-1/2" **Unit 6** square.




5. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square along the D side to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (28) Unit 7 strips total.

6. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square along the D side to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Unit 8 strip.

7. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to the left side of (1) Unit 6 square along the D side to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 11).


#### Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Diagram while assembling the quilt top.)

**8.** Sew together (1) **F** 4-1/2" square, (1) **Unit 7** strip, (1) **H** 4-1/2" square, (1) **Unit 7** strip, (1) **F** 4-1/2" square, (1) **Unit 7** strip and (1) **H** 4-1/2" square in that order to make **Row One (Fig. 12)**.

**9.** Repeat **Step 8** and refer to **Figure 12** for component identification, placement and orientation to make **Row Two** through **Row Nine**.

10. Sew the (9) rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block (Fig. 12).
