

#### HOUSE BLOCKS

Note: House Blocks consist of roof (finished 4" x 12") and house (finished 10" x 12") units. Roof Units are the same for all Blocks, House Units are different for Blocks 1-9.

Roof Units: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) H 3-1/2" square. Place square, right sides together (RST), at a corner of (1) B 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal H corner triangle. Repeat with another H square at the opposite end of the same B rectangle to complete sewn unit.



Sew (2) B 1-1/2" squares to the opposite short sides of (1) H 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle, followed by (2) H 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.



**3.** Sew together units made in **Steps 1-2** to complete (1) **Roof Unit**, measuring 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" raw edge to raw edge. Make (2).



**4.** Make a total number of **Roof Units** using **H** and the following fabrics:


#### HOUSE UNIT 1

5. Block Center: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" C square. Place square, right sides together (RST), at a corner of (1) 5-1/2" F square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal C corner triangle. Repeat with (3) additional 3" C squares at the remaining corners of the same 5-1/2" F square to complete (1) block center. Unit should measure 5-1/2" square.





6. Flying Geese Units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3" F square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) 3" x 5-1/2" C rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal F corner triangle. Repeat with another 3" F square at the opposite corner of the same 3" x 5-1/2" C rectangle to complete (1) flying geese unit. Make a total of (4) flying geese units. Unit should measure 3" x 5-1/2".

House Unit 1

- **7.** Sew (1) flying geese unit to each side of block center to make a row unit, measuring 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" raw edge to raw edge.
- Sew (2) 3" C squares to the opposite short sides of (1) flying geese unit to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units, measuring 3" x 10-1/2" raw edge to raw edge.
- **9.** Sew together row units made in **Steps 7** and **8** to complete **House Unit 1**, measuring 10-1/2" square, raw edge to raw edge.

10. Block Center: Repeat Step 5 using (4) 3" E squares and (1) 5-1/2" B square. Unit measures 5-1/2" square.




11. Flying Geese Units: Repeat Step 6 using (2) 3" I squares and (1) 3" x 5-1/2" B rectangle.

12. HST Units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 3-1/2" I square. Place square, RST, on (1) 3-1/2" E square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) HST units. Align diagonal seam of HST units against 45-degree line on quilting ruler, square up HST units to measure 3" square, raw edge to raw edge. Make a total of (4) HST units.

- 13. Sew (1) flying geese unit to each side of block center to make a row unit, measuring 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" raw edge to raw edge.
- **14.** Sew (1) HST unit to each short side of (1) flying geese unit to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units, measuring  $3'' \times 10-1/2''$  raw edge to raw edge.
- **15.** Sew together row units to complete House Unit 2, measuring 10-1/2" square.

#### HOUSE UNIT 3

#### Subunit 1

- 16. Half-Square Triangle: Repeat Step 12 using (1) B and (1) M 6" squares. Square to 5-1/2".
- 17. Corner Triangle: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) B 3" square. Place square, RST, matching the corner of M side of the same HST unit. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal B corner triangle to complete Subunit 1, measuring 5-1/2" square. Make (2).



#### Subunit 2

- Half-Square Triangle: Repeat Step 12 using (1) B and (1) M 3-1/2" squares. HST units measure 3" square. Make (4).
- Arrange and sew together (2) 3" HST units and (2) M 3" squares, as shown below, to make Subunit 2, measuring 5-1/2" square. Make (2).
- 20. Arrange and sew together Subunits 1 and 2 to complete House Unit 3. Square to 10-1/2".



#### **HOUSE UNIT 4**

21. Corner Triangle: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) E 1-1/2" square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) I 3" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **E** corner triangle. Make (4).






23. Arrange and sew together Corner Triangle units and 3" B and E squares, as shown, to make (4) pieced rows.

#### **HOUSE UNIT 5**

#### Heart Block Center

- 25. Top Corner Triangles: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) M 1-1/2" square. Place square, RST, at a corner of (1) B 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **M** corner triangle. Repeat with another **M** square at the opposite corner, along the same short side of the same **B** rectangle. Make (2).
- 26. Bottom Corner Triangle: Similar to Step 25, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) M 2-1/2" square. Place marked M square, RST, at the bottom left corner of one of the previously sewn units. Repeat, using the other sewn unit, placing (1) M square at the bottom right corner to create a mirror-imaged unit. Sew both units together to complete (1) Heart Block Center, measuring 4-1/2" square, raw edge to raw edge.





#### Framing Heart Block Center

- 27. Sew (2) M 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides of Heart Block Center, followed by (2) M  $1-1/2'' \times 6-1/2''$  rectangles to the top and bottom of block center.
- 28. Sew (2) B1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides of block center, followed by (2) B 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom of block center.
- 29. Sew (2) F 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides of block center, followed by (2) F 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom of block center as shown below to complete House Unit 5.







#### House Unit 6

#### Block Quadrant

- **30.** Sew together along the long side (1) **E** 2" x 5-1/2" rectangle and (1) **B** 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangle.
- 31. Corner Triangle: Repeat Step 21 using (1) C 3" square and the sewn E/B unit. Place marked C square at the top right corner, noting orientation.
- **32.** Add (1) **C** 3" x 5-1/2" rectangle to the left of previously sewn unit to make (1) **Block Quadrant**. Make (4).
- **33.** Noting rotation of patches, sew **Quadrants** together to complete **House Unit 6**, measuring 10-1/2" square.






#### House Unit 7

34. HST Units: Repeat Step 12 using (1) E and M 3" square. HST units measure 2-1/2" square. Make (4) of E/M and (8) of B/M units.










- 35. Pieced Rows [NOTE ROTATION OF UNITS]
  - Rows 1, 5: (2) E/M HSTs, (2) B/M HSTs, and (1) M 2-1/2" square.
  - Rows 2, 4: (2) B/M HSTs, (2) M 2-1/2" squares, and (1) F 2-1/2" square.
  - **Row 3:** (2) **M** 2-1/2" squares and (1) **F** 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle.

Sew together pieced rows to complete House Unit 7, measuring 10-1/2" square.

#### House Unit 8

- 36. Flying Geese Unit: Repeat Step 6 using
  (2) C 2-1/2" squares and (1) B 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle. Make (4) of B/C and (1) of C/E units.
- 37. Pieced Rows Sew the following rows:
  - **Row 1:** (1) **B/C** unit and (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle.
  - **Row 2:** (1) **B/C** unit, (1) **C** 2-1/2" square and (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.
  - **Row 3:** (1) **B/C** unit, (1) **C** 2-1/2" square and (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle.
  - **Row 4:** (1) **B/C** unit and (1) **C** 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle.
  - **Row 5:** (1) **C/E** unit and (2) **C** 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.

Sew rows together as shown to complete House Unit 8, measuring 10-1/2" square.

#### House Unit 9

- 38. HST Units: Repeat Step 12 using (1) E and (1) K 3" square. measuring 2-1/2" square. Make (4) of E/I and (8) F/I HSTs, will use only (3) and (7) respectively.
- **39.** Sew the following rows:

Row 1: (2) E/I units and (2) F/I units.

Row 2: (1) E/I unit, (2) F/I units and (1) I 2-7/8" HST.


Row 3: (2) F/I units and (1) I 2-7/8" HST.

- Row 4: (1) F/I unit and (1) I 2-7/8" HST.
- 40. Sew the row units together, and add (1) E 6-7/8" HST, followed by (1) I 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle to the right of previously sewn unit.



**41.** Sew together (1) **E** and (1) I 2-7/8" HSTs, followed by (1) I 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle to the left of sewn HST unit, and add to the bottom of unit made in Step 40, as shown below, to complete House Unit 9, measuring 10-1/2" square.


















42. Sew (2) H 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides of a House Unit.

43. Refer to Quilt Diagram on Page 16 to match roof unit fabric and sew to the top of appropriate House Unit. Followed by (1) K 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle to the bottom of house unit to complete (1) House Block, measuring 12-1/2" x 16-1/2" raw edge to raw edge. Make (9) House Blocks.




**44.** Sew (2) 1-1/2" x WOF L strips to the opposite long sides of (1) 1-1/2" x WOF H strip. Make (2) strip sets. Subcut strip set at 1-1/2" intervals to make (32) L-H-L units.



**45.** Sew (2) 1-1/2" x WOF **H** strips to the opposite long sides of (1) 1-1/2" x WOF **L** strip. Subcut strip set at 1-1/2" intervals to make (16) **H-L-H** units.



**46.** Sew together (2) **L-H-L** units and (1) **H-L-H** unit to make (1) cornerstone, measuring 3-1/2" square raw edge to raw edge. Make a total of (16) cornerstones.


#### SASHING BLOCKS

47. Sew (2) 1-1/2" x WOF H strips to the opposite long sides of (1) 1-1/2" x WOF L strip. Repeat for a total of (10) strip sets. Cut strip sets at 16-1/2" intervals to yield a total of (12) Vertical Sashing Blocks, and then 12-1/2" intervals to yield a total of (12) Horizontal Sashing Blocks.

#### QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

**48. Pieced Rows.** Arrange and sew together (3) **House Blocks** and (4) **Vertical Sashing Blocks** to make a pieced row.





**49. Pieced Sashing Rows.** Sew together (4) **Cornerstones** and (3) **Horizontal Sashing Blocks** to make (1) **Pieced Sashing Row**. Make a total of (4) Pieced Sashing Rows.



**50.** Sew together **Pieced Rows** and **Pieced Sashing Rows** as shown in Quilt Diagram on **Page 16** to complete the Quilt Center.

#### QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

- Use Quilt Diagram on Page 16 as reference.
- 51. Inner Border 1: Sew (1) H 2" x 60-1/2" strip to each side of Quilt Center, followed by (1) H 2" x 51-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of Quilt Center.
- 52. Inner Border 2: Sew (1) E 1-1/2" x 63-1/2" strip to each side of Quilt Center, followed by (1) E 1-1/2" x 53-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of Quilt Center.
- **53.** Outer Border: Sew (1) A 4" x 65-1/2" strip to each side of Quilt Center, followed by (1) A 4" x 60-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of Quilt Center to complete Quilt Top.



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **L** 2-1/4" strips.
