





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Fabric Picture	Quantity	Fabric Number	Placement of Fabric	Cutting
	1 5/8 yards	40789-X Multi	Center Square Outer Border	Fussy cut one 11" square. Cut six 7" strips. Make into two 7" x 42" rectangles and two 7" x 55" rectangles.
	3/8 yard	40791-1 Linen	Border Three	Cut two 4" strips. Recut into eight 4" x 11" rectangles.
	1/2 yard	40791-2 Black	Border Triangles Border Corner Posts	Cut two 4 3/8" strips. Recut into sixteen 4 3/8" squares. Cut each square once diagonal to make 32 triangles. Cut four 7" squares.
	3/8 yard	40793-1 Linen	Border Two Borders for Napkins	Cut two 4" strips. Recut into eight 4" x 7 1/2" rectangles. Napkins: cut four pieces 2" x 9 1/2" and four pieces 2" x 12 1/2".
	1 yard	40793-2 Black	Center Star Points Narrow Border Four Binding Borders for Napkins	Cut two 4 1/4" strips. Recut into sixteen 4 1/4" squares. Refer to Cutting diagrams to cut out triangles. Cut four 2" strips. Recut into two 2" x 39" and two 2" x 42". Cut six 2 1/4 or 2 1/2" strips. Napkins: cut four pieces 2" x 9 1/2" and four pieces 2" x 12 1/2".
	1/2 yard	40794-X Multi	Corner Squares Napkin Centers	Fussy cut on the diagonal eight 4 3/8" squares. Napkins: cut four 9 1/2" squares.



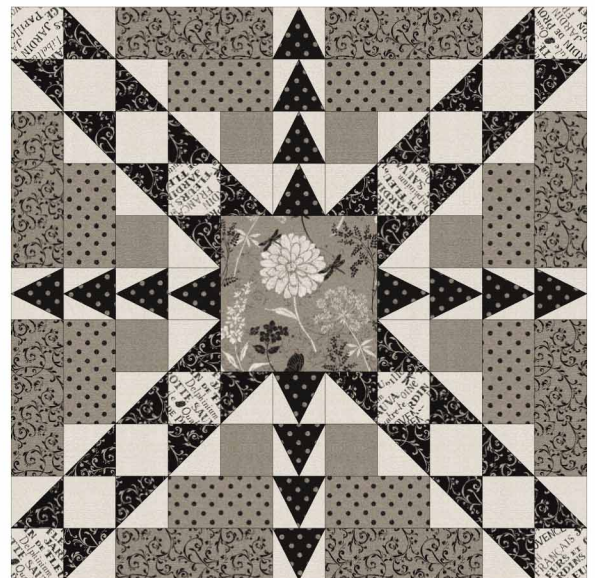
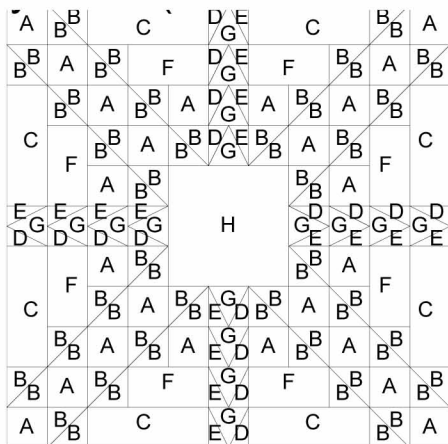
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	1/4 yard	40796-1 Linen	Border One	Cut one 4" strip. Recut into eight 4" squares.
	3/4 yard	40796-3 Cream	Border Triangles Center Star Point Background Border Squares	Cut two 4 3/8" strips. Recut into sixteen 4 3/8" squares. Cut each square once diagonal to make 32 triangles. Cut two 2 3/8" strips. Recut into sixteen 2 3/8" x 4 3/4" rectangles. Refer to cutting diagram for diagonal cutting. Cut one 4" strip. Recut into eight 4" squares.
	3 1/2 yards	40790-1 Linen	Napkin Backing Topper Backing	Cut two 1 2/3 yards pieces. From one of the pieces cut parallel to the selvage a 12 1/2" strip for the napkin backing. Cut four 12 1/2" squares. Join together the two remaining pieces and trim to 60" square

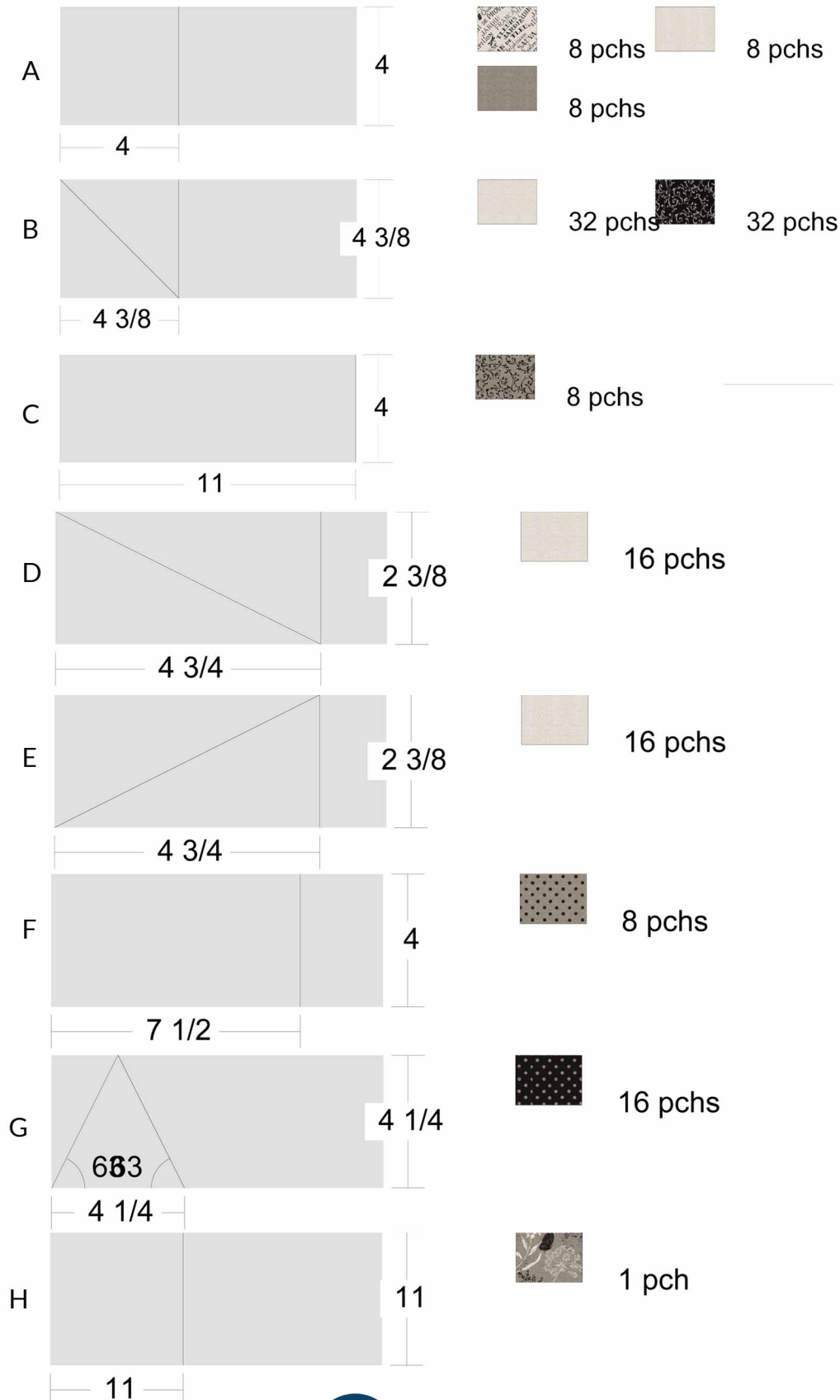
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Cutting Diagram

Patch Count



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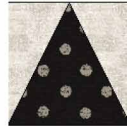
Assembly Directions

1. Make 32 half square triangles using the Border Triangle fabrics.

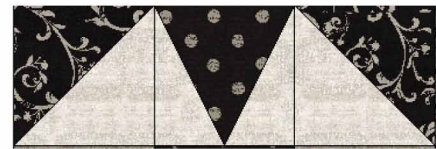
Press seams toward darker fabric.



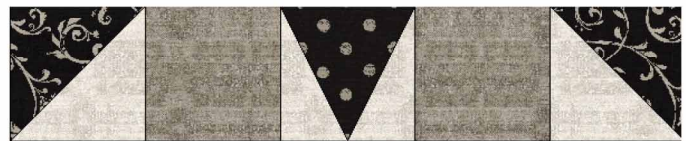
2. Make 16 Center Star Point blocks, press seams open.



3. Star Points: Make four units as shown, pressing seams open. Sew one to each side of the Center Square. Add the Corner Squares to the other two units and add to the top and bottom to make the Center Star. Make sure the words are as pictured on Topper.



4. First Border: Make four units as shown, pressing seams open. Sew one to each side of the Center Star. Add the Corner Squares to the other two units and add to the top and bottom to make the Center Star with First Border.



5. Second Border: Make four units as shown, pressing seams open. Sew one to each side of the Center Unit. Add the Corner Squares to the other two units and add to the top and bottom to make the Center Star with Second Border.



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6. Third Border: Make four units as shown, pressing seams open. Sew one to each side of the Center Unit. Add the Corner Squares to the other two units and add to the top and bottom to make the Center Star with Third Border. Picture shows positioning of the word fabric.



7. Border Four: Add Narrow Border Four to sides and then the top and bottom. Press seams away from quilt top center.
8. Outer Border: Sew the two shorter Border Strips to the sides of the top. Add the Corner Posts to each end of the two remaining Border Strips and sew to the top and bottom. Press all seams away from the quilt top.
9. Make quilt sandwich and quilt and bind as desired. Tea anyone?

Making Tea Time Napkins

1. Referring to the napkin picture, join the shorter Border strips first then add the longer Border strips, press all seams away from the center.
2. With the napkin backing and the napkin fronts right sides together stitch a 1/4" away from the outside edges, leaving a four inch opening. Trim the four outside corners, turn right side out and press well. Stitch the opening closed by machine or by hand. Top stitching in the ditch of the napkin border will keep the napkins shapely and top stitching 1/4" away from the edge will make them crisp. Enjoy!

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
