
MAKING THE BLOCKS

NOTE: Use your preferred combinations of lavender and light strips to make each strip set.

1. Sew 2-1/2" x WOF light strips lengthwise to opposite sides of (1) 2-1/2" x WOF lavender strip to create a light-lavender-light strip set. Align the 45-degree line on a ruler along the top edge of the strip set and cut a diagonal line, starting at the strip set bottom corner.



2. Rotate the ruler so the 45-degree line on the ruler is along the top edge of the strip set and cut, creating a triangle as shown.



3. Continue rotating the ruler to cut a total of (6) light-lavender-light triangles as shown.

4. In the same way, make (1) lavender-light-lavender strip set and cut (6) lavender-light-lavender triangles.




5. In the same way, make (2) light-lavender-light-lavender strip sets and cut (4) light-lavender-light-lavender triangles and (4) lavender-light-lavender-light triangles.



6. In the same way, make (2) lavender-light-lavender-light-lavender strip sets and cut (4) lavender-light-lavender-light-lavender triangles.




7. In the same way, make (2) light-lavender-light-lavender-light strip sets and cut (4) light-lavender-light-lavender-light triangles.

8. Lay out (2) each 5-strip triangles from steps 6 and 7, alternating triangles. Join together in pairs, pinning heavily to prevent stretching. Sew the pairs together using a scant 1/4" seam allowance to complete (1) large block, measuring approximately 20-1/4" square. Make (2).

9. In the same way, join 4-strip triangles from step 5 to make a medium block, measuring approximately 16-1/4" square. Make (2).

10. In the same way, join 3-strip triangles from steps 3 and 4 to make a small block, measuring approximately 12-1/4" square. Make (3).








ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

11. Sew (1) each **F** and **J** 2-1/2" \times 16-1/4" strips to the bottom of (1) medium block, noting orientation of the block. Trim strip ends as needed. Sew (1) each **C** and **I** 2-1/2" \times 20-1/4" strips to the left side to complete Section 1. Trim strip ends as needed.






12. Sew (1) each **F** and **J** 2-1/2" x 16-1/4" strips to the bottom of (1) medium block, noting orientation of the block. Trim strip ends as needed. Sew (1) each **C** and **I** 2-1/2" x 20-1/4" strips to the right side to complete Section 2. Trim strip ends as needed.

- **13.** Referring to the Quilt Layout Diagram on p. 6, sew together (3) small blocks, (1) **D** 2-3/4" x 12-1/4" strip and (1) **H** 2-1/2" x 12-1/4" strip to make Row 3. Trim strip ends as needed.
- **14.** Sew together (1) Large Block and Section 1 to make Row 1. Sew together Section 2 and (1) Large Block to make Row 2. Sew Row 3 to the bottom to complete the quilt top.





Quilt Layout

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using the (5) **D** 2-1/2" strips.
