Piece strips and subcut <br> (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. <br> Inner Border 3 (Star Blocks) <br> (9) $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut (200) $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares. <br> (9) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut (200) $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. <br> Inner Border 4 <br> (8) $4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut <br> (2) $4^{\prime \prime} \times 67-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and (2) $4^{\prime \prime} \times 75-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |

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Additional Materials: Template plastic or poster board for template and fusible web for appliqué.

## BOOT BLOCK

1. Refer to your favorite quilting source for appliqué method. Arrange boot and spur appliqué pieces on (1) L 10" $\times 13^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. After appliquéing and securing with a decorative stitch, trim block to measure $9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ raw to raw edge.

Note: (5) boots are reversed. Refer to cutting instructions and quilt diagram for boot orientation.
2. Make a total of (25) Boot Blocks in the following fabric and $\mathbf{L}$ combinations:

Make (3) of each.

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Make (1) and (1) reverse of each.



Make (2) and (1) reverse of each.


## STAR BLOCKS

3. Flying Geese Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $\mathbf{D} 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place $\mathbf{D}$ square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $\mathbf{L} 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from sewn line. Open and press $\mathbf{D}$ triangle. Repeat with another $\mathbf{D}$ square for opposite right corner. Make (20).

4. Noting rotation, sew (2) Flying Geese Units to the opposite sides of (1) D 3" square as shown.
5. Sew (2) $\mathbf{L} 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares to the opposite short sides of the (1) Flying Geese Units. Make (2).
6. Sew row units made in Steps 4-5, as shown, to complete a 5-1/2" square Star Block. Make (5).

7. Repeats Steps 3-6 to make a total of (50) blocks in the following fabric and $\mathbf{L}$ combinations:

## QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

8. Pieced Rows: Arrange and sew together (5) Boot Blocks to make a pieced row. Make (5). Sew pieced rows together to complete quilt center.


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## BORDERS

9. Inner Border 1: Sew (2) B 1-1/2" $\times 60-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) B 1-1/2" $\times 47-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
10. Inner Border 2: Sew $\mathbf{L}(2) 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) L $2^{\prime \prime} \times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
11. Inner Border 3: Refer to quilt image for placement guide of Star Blocks.

Pieced Column: Arrange and sew together (13) Star Blocks. Make (2) columns. Sew columns to the opposite long sides of quilt center.

Pieced Row: Arrange and sew together (12) Star Blocks. Make (2) rows.
Sew rows to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
12. Inner Border 4: Sew (2) $\mathbf{L} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 75-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) L 4" $\times 67-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
13. Outer Border: Sew (2) J 4-1/2" $\times 82-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) J 4-1/2" $\times 75-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the remaining opposite long sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

Quilt Assembly


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using C 2-1/4" strips.
